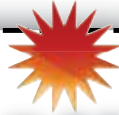

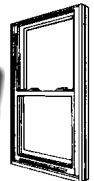

At a recent meeting of the Board of Directors, two topics were discussed seeking shareholder input. We ask you to submit your comments by July 31, 2015.

2. Review of Governing documents - an Attorney has been contracted to review our governing documents established in 1994. Letter from the Manager

Happy Birthday USA- The business office will be closed on July 3rd in celebration of the July 4th holiday. The maintenance department will be called to address emergencies only.

Phone Service – The business office has a new phone system. If you call the office to speak with me and I am not available, you will be asked if you would like to leave a voice mail message. There is only so much information the office staff can write on the small phone message notes; voice mail will now allow you to leave a detailed message. There is a good chance that by leaving a voice mail message I will receive your message sooner than if one of the office staff writes down your message. All office and sales staff now have voice mail boxes.

Rules Reminder – Guests are permitted to visit for 15 days, twice a year. Anyone staying longer than that must complete an application for residency and pay an application fee. We need to perform background check on ALL residents.

Document Review – The board of directors has taken on the task of having the governing documents reviewed. There are a number of items that are no longer valid and some items are in conflict with the current Statutes that govern Cooperatives. At the June 3rd Board of Directors Meeting, residents were asked to provide any input on items they feel should be changed, in writing.

Parking Lot Entrance – The office has received numerous complaints regarding the safety at the clubhouse parking lot entrance. As you enter, you find you must drive right through one of the handicap parking spaces. George F. Young, the engineering firm that is designing the potable water line project, has been asked to incorporate improvements to the clubhouse entrance to provide for safer access.

Gardener – In April Americana Cove hired a part time gardener. His name is Ben Brown; residents that are here now have probably seen him planting flowers and improving our common area shrubs. Ben has a passion for plants and flowers, his enhancements are adding to our curb appeal!

Irrigation – Most residents know Angel; he picks up our trash twice a week and helps out in maintenance on the other days. Angel has shown an interest in irrigation and learned a good deal from Matthews' crew so we will be assigning future irrigation work to Angel. He is excited about taking on new responsibilities and eager to learn more about irrigation and plumbing.

Standards Review – I would like a few volunteers to assist with reviewing Americana Cove's maintenance standards. Once the Rules and Regulations have been reviewed by the attorney and the state, they will be mailed to all residents. Ninety days following that, the new Rules and Regulations will go into effect. Prior to that date, during that 90 day waiting period, anyone that has something that may be considered a violation (more than 4 garden ornaments), should submit a written request for a variance to the office. The volunteers will work with me to determine if a variance should or should not be granted. This will be important because the new rules allow us to set fines for violations that are not corrected during the time given in a first notice of violation.

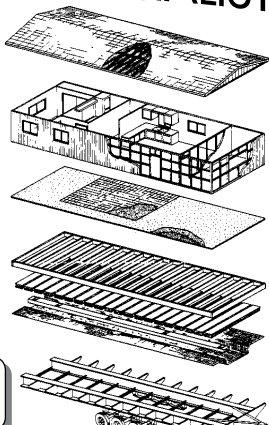

ALBIN AND CARL (this is a two part story)

In this world where it seems that everyone is striving for money, fame, and power, it is not very often that one hears a story of someone famous who alters that perception. This is the true account of one U.S. Olympic star at the top of this game, who took the time, and made the effort to create and sustain a friendship with a handicapped boy who lived thousands of miles across the globe.

In June of 1988, I travelled to Copenhagen, Denmark with David Bergers, a student associate of mine at the time. Six years before, David was an exchange student in Malmo, Sweden, where he learned to speak Swedish both quickly and fluently. While we were in Copenhagen, he insisted that I accompany him on a visit with Kristina and Lars Danielson, David's Swedish host family. Not wanting to intrude, I was reluctant to go with him, so I suggested that I stay in Copenhagen while he enjoyed a reunion with the Danielson's. He would not accept "no" for an answer, and I am forever grateful he didn't.

The Danielson's turned out to be everything David had said they would be. This attractive and charming couple's family consisted of 2 girls and 2 boys. Their youngest son, Albin, was born anon May 16, 1974. He had been diagnosed with the Duchenne form of Muscular Dystrophy, a disease that involves the gradual wasting away of skeletal muscles, with the onset usually before 5 years of age. In Albin's case, he was 4 years old when the condition was diagnosed after his parents observed that he couldn't get up after falling. Three years later at the age of 7, Albin was confined to a wheelchair where he remained for the rest of his young life. As his condition worsened over the years, it was not only necessary for him to be in a wheelchair, but he also needed a respirator so he could breathe, and a transport table so that he could attend school.

The thing that amazed me most about Alvin was not only his maturity, but also his courageous attitude. He never sought sympathy, and he blended well among children and adults alike. He was extremely witty, a good listener, and a joy to be around. We all became engulfed by the effortless flow of conversations with the young boy. Not only did I forget that Albin was 14, but I also forgot that he had a disability.

Being with Albin brought home something in me that I believe that all of us have in common, but never want to admit to anyone. Whenever we are in the presence of a person with a disability, it seems that all we see is a wheelchair, brace, hearing aid, or that the person had a speech impediment, or so on. We fail to realize that this is a human begin with feelings, ideas, and dreams. To compensate for our own insecurity, we extend sympathy or charity, when in reality, what a disabled person wants is what we all want – genuine acceptance.

For the next few days of our visit, my relationship with Albin became increasingly closer. At the time, I had a daughter who was just three months younger than he, and a son who was nine years old. The last day I was there, I mentioned to Albin that David and I were raising funds for the Shriner's – Burns Hospital in Boston. Because of our association with the hospital, we had contact with a number of agents in the entertainment field. I asked Albin if there were some movie star or entertainer whose autograph he might like to have. "Carl Lewis" was Albin's immediate and definite response. At first I was confused because I couldn't place Carl Lewis as an entertainer. I rather embarrassingly asked who he was. As I studied Albin's look

of disbelief, the name finally registered with me. “You mean the Olympic runner!” I asked. Albin told me that in 1983, he had watched Carl on television as he launched his career at the world competition in Helsinki, Finland, by winning the hundred meters, four hundred meter relay, and long jump. The next year was every more exciting as Albin and the world watched Carl win four Olympic gold medals in the 100 meter, 1200 meter, 400 meter relay and the long jump. It was at this time that Albin became a huge fan of Carl’s.

I tried to explain to Albin that athletes and their agents were a unique breed, possessing obscenely large egos. I figured that it would be next to impossible to get the attention of Carl Lewis, who was in the prime of his career. I noticed that Albin had a kind of grin on his face as much as to say, “You’re the one playing the “big man” role – it is Carl Lewis or no one!” I got the message and assured him that one way or another, the autograph would be from Carol Lewis. On the flight back to the U.S., I recalled thinking to myself that I should keep my mouth shut from now on. I didn’t think that I would ever get anything from Carl Lewis. Never the less, I felt that there was something so remarkable about a boy confined to a wheelchair, but yet was fascinated by the world’s fastest runner. At this moment I made a promise to myself that I would never have to write a note to Albin stating, “I am dreadfully sorry, I tried my best.” Upon returning home, Davis and I started researching Carl and discovered that he was a student at the University of Houston. Their athletic department informed us that he was in Santa Monica with his agent, Joe Douglas. I vividly remember the feeling of fear that came over me the day I called Joe. I have never been one to suffer from embarrassment over calling anyone for anything, and rejection never bothered me for very long. I had probably been turned down more than a bed sheet! But this was different. This time I wasn’t calling for me, but for Albin. I couldn’t help but wonder that I would do if he brushed me off, which is really what I expected to happen.

Joe Douglas’ secretary, Rose turned out to be a loving, compassionate woman with a great deal of empathy. She listened intently to the reason I was calling. Rose ensured me that as soon as Joe returned, she would have him return my call. For some inexplicable reason, and certainly not based on past experiences, I believed her. Sure enough, within an hour, Joe called me back. Joe mentioned that Carl happened to be in town and that they would, indeed, cooperate. He offered to have Carl put the autograph on a pair of running shoes, but since we didn’t know Albin’s size, it was safer for Carl to autograph a tee-shirt. Carl did just that promising to send it within a day. Joe kept his promise, and upon receipt of the shirt, we mailed it to Albin. Kristina, Albin’s mother, confided that Albin was usually embarrassed about receiving gifts, as he felt that people were doing it only because of his disability. However, he was never embarrassed about this tee-shirt gift and had his picture taken by the local newspaper wearing it. Albin sent us a thank-you note, included along with an eggshell cutter. Because of the progressive deterioration of Albin’s muscles and the fact that English was not his primary language, it took him well over an hour to form the letters of this brief note:

Hello Tom

Thank you for the tee-shirt. I was happy when I got it. I saw Carl Lewis on TV the same day I got it. He had the same shirt when he ran. We have found an egg-shell cutter for you. Have a nice egg-shell-cutting day. Send my love to Dave.

Your friend, Albin

I our research of Carl Lewis, we discovered that he and Florence Griffith-Joyner would be running in a meet in, of all places, Albin’s hometown of Malmo, Sweden. I again called Joe Douglas and asked him if Carl could just spare a few moments to call Albin while in Malmo.



Unbeknownst to us, Albin's father had already contacted the manager of the Malmo Track and Field Club where the two athletes were scheduled to run, telling the manager about Albin's admiration for Carl Lewis, and making the same request as I. During their first meeting in Malmo, the stadium manager brought up the fact that there was a little boy in town who was suffering from Muscular Dystrophy who happened to be a big fan of Carl's. Joe Douglas stunned everyone, when he replied that if it were Albin, he had already made a promise to Tom Wallace that Carol would see him. Due to the efforts of the stadium manager, arrangements were made. On August 8, 1988, Albin and his parents met with Carl Lewis, Florence Griffith-Joyner, and her husband, Al. David and I recall the joy of receiving a rather large envelope that was filled with pictures of Albin proudly sitting in his wheelchair with Carl's arm around him, and another picture of Florence and Al's arm around him. Renting Your Home: What Are Your Options?

Residents at Americana Cove are permitted to rent their homes; however, the community rules specify the following:

- If renting your home, you must inform management of your intent to rent, and your renter must have a background check and be approved before moving in.
- You must rent your home a minimum of two months.

In addition to the community's rules, renters are required to pay Florida sales tax and the Tourist Development Tax if the rental will be for less than six months. The Tourist Development Tax is collected by each county in Florida. In Pinellas County, 5% is collected for this tax along with a 7% sales tax for a total of 12% tax that should be paid by the renter and collected and remitted by the owner to the state. There are penalties involved for non-payment of the tax, so homeowners need to be careful if they are not remitting the tax to the state.

Because some homeowners may decide not to rent believing it will be too difficult to collect and remit the taxes, Barefoot Realty does offer a rental service and will collect and remit the taxes on your behalf.

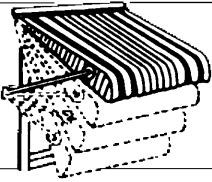
