Something to Consider

Pets are a big part of some people's lives, especially empty nesters. They provide companionship, purpose and emotional comfort. Some people do not like having a pet or being bothered by pets, and that is their right and perfectly fine. The Cove has a pet section and a non-pet section, both being established many years ago. Our culture is changing. More people are desiring to have a pet, perhaps even after moving into the non-pet section, and the law recognizes their right to have a comfort pet. Understandably, this is difficult for residents choosing to live in the non-pet section because they do not like pets.

Regardless of how we individually feel about having a pet or others having a pet, pet popularity is growing and it appears that pets are here to stay. I have heard several comments by residents both for and against pets, which compelled me to write this article with the sole purpose and hope of creating greater peace between pet owners and non-pet owners. So what can we do as Cove residents to coexist more peacefully. After all, isn't that what we all want?

Pet owners can obey the park rules:

- Always pick up after your dog.
- Use a 6-foot leash so that you have control of your dog and it is kept close to you.
- Carry a flashlight when walking your dog at night.
- Don't allow your dog to be a nuisance to your neighbors by barking excessively.
- Keep your cat indoors or on a leash.

And always be considerate of those that do not enjoy pets.

Non-pet owners can:

- Try to understand that some people benefit greatly from having a pet, and that the law recognizes this.
- Accept that things do change, such as the growth in pet popularity and the creation of comfort pet laws.
- Look at pet owners as Cove neighbors moreso than pet owners.
- Talk to the pet owner or report them to park management if they are consistently breaking the park rules.

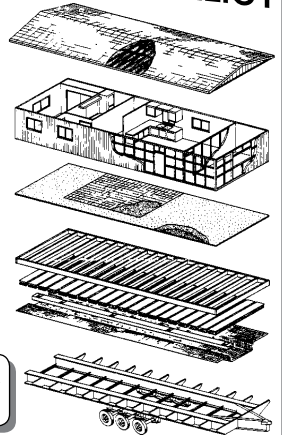

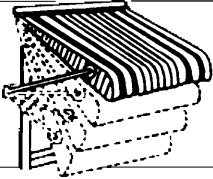

The study tracked the health - and lifetime exercise patterns - of more than 315,000 people who were members of AARP. The investigators found that folks who'd exercised all their lives had a 36 percent lower risk of dying during the study period, compared to people who'd never exercised.

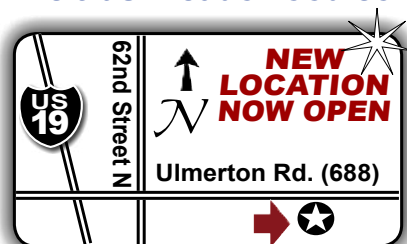

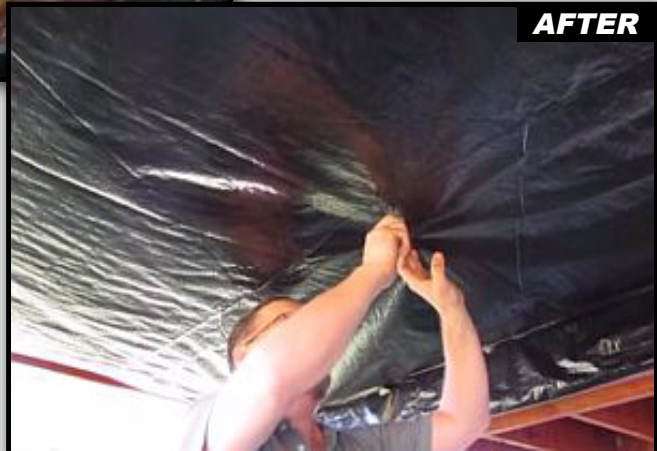

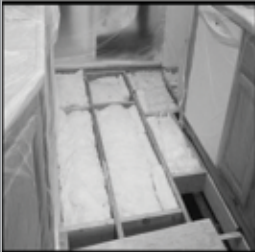
