

If you call, Animal Services will come out, free of charge, to pick up an animal. Any questions, please call Rose Kalp at 459-4808. We have sent quite a few animals to animal services.

PLEASE BE a responsible owner and have your animal fixed. This service is very low cost through animal services.

#### **Snowbirds [and Vacationers]:** Before you leave:

- 1. Please make sure you have someone doing your weeds, trees, etc., and keep mobile clean on the outside during the summer.
  - 2. Make sure anything that can be pitched around with the wind is put away.
  - 3. If you have a change of address, please make sure you notify the office.

#### All Residents: Rules commonly broken:

- 1. Parking overnight on street and/or every day.
- 2. If you have someone living with you, make sure you have registered in the office.
- 3. Do not pile garbage in front of garbage bins. When you throw garbage, throw it to the back so when you open the door, it doesn't fall out and there is space.
- 4. Check mobile for cleaning, trim, awnings, driveway and/or painting. We will have someone out soon checking your mobile.

#### Still relevant announcements Cliff made this year at Koffee Klatch:

- 1. Keep the dumpster area neat, especially on the weekends. If the dumpster is full, please put extras neatly beside it.
  - 2. Parking on the grass or sidewalk is against the rules. If necessary, park on the road.



They sell for about 160 each. After you get the boxes con-nected you will receive over 500 channels including many premium movies. The monthly fee is 25 dollars, plus the cost of WIFI. It would probably be wise to find out what Spectrum's WIFI price is.

We saw a demonstration and the picture was really clear. The downside is you lose local channels, but you still get all the national showings of the networks, so no local programming.

In the long run you should save money with this plan. BTW, this company is trying to include internet in the future but have a couple hurdles to overcome first as Spectrum has exclusive rights right now at Bay Ranch. That being said, I have a few misgivings myself. First of all they offer premium channels at no extra charge. I won-der if HBO, Cinemax, etc, are aware of this. Also they are planning on offering the major networks ABC, NBC, etc. Now the local stations have contracts with these networks and I am sure they would not appreciate losing the advertising dollars they generate. I am not saying this is not a legitimate deal, but I always was always taught, "If it looks too good to be true, it probably isn't." Bottom line, more research is need-ed.

The security company I worked for has been replaced by another company, and I now am again unemployed and retired for the 4th time, "LOL". I plan to visit my kids and grandkids some time in a few weeks, so it probably is a good thing.



Been a bit since I gave you some new places to try. I have three that I hope you will like. First is a special pizza place, pick-up or delivery only, Rosati's Pizza, Chicago style. Next is a great seafood place with atmosphere, Frenchy's Outpost Bar and Grill. Last is a great southern food staple, Johnny Grits.

First, as a kid from Chicago, I want a real Chicago pan pizza and it is hard to find. Over the years places have come and gone. And now we have Rosati's Pizza at 10443 Ulmerton Rd, Unit 7, Largo. It is in the Home Depot plaza between Home Depot and Publix.

The Rosati family is from Chicago and has made pizza for a while. Everyone has their favorite in Chicago, but theirs is right on top of the list. I know it is not dine in, but they deliver to our park, or you can pick it up if you are out.

When you order, just keep it simple: Chicago Deep Dish, cheese, sausage, maybe mushrooms or/and green pepper. This is a true pie, so knife and fork are needed. For me, it takes me home back to Chicago--. almost want to carve my initials in the table, but I am afraid Janice would kill me. Don't forget, this pizza deserves beer if you are able. Chianti works as well. Order a small for 2 people and you will have leftovers. Be advised, these take a bit to cook, so it is not 30min or less.

Next we get a little place near the beach, Frenchy's Outpost Bar and Grill, 466 Causeway Blvd, Dunedin. This place is on your way to Honeymoon and Caladesi Island out the end of Curlew Rd. It is part of the Frenchy's Restaurant group out of Clearwater Beach. It is a nice open air place with shade and a breeze, which keeps it comfortable even in the summer. The menu is mostly from Frenchy's, so Grouper Sandwiches and peel-n-eat shrimp are staples. Awesome even here. A few items are specific to here, like Outpost Stuffed Avocados. Think tuna salad stuffed tomatoes, but grilled avocados instead; Tropical Chicken Walnut Salad; great flat-breads; and my favorite, Frenchy's Garlic Crab Fries, mmmmmm. It is a fun place to be when you are out and about or at the beach.

Last is a southern specialty place, Johnny Grits at 857 East Klosterman Rd, Tarpon Springs. It is a Southern fresh breakfast and lunch spot that puts a southern staple right out front. Grits. Yellow grits not cheap white grits. These little things seem simple but are hard to get perfect. These folks use real grits, cook slow, fold in the right additions as asked and deliver perfection. Everything here is fresh made. Corned Beef Hash mad from Corned Beef, not a can. Sweet potato waffles start sweet before you do anything to them. Crab Cake Benedict that is wonderful. And my faves, Johnny's Three Cheese Grits or the Shrimp and Grits. Smooth and creamy with a wonderful flavor. They arrive in a small cast iron skillet. Lunch is just as tasty. If you are up near Tarpon and want something different, try them out.

There you go. 3 places from near to far away. I hope you try them out and enjoy. Let me know what you think. Give me a suggestion of a place you tried, I will try to make it. But above all, Bon' Apetit!
