Weather Emergency Management

That do we do in case of a storm? We've been told El Niño means more storms, including tornadoes, like the ones we've had recently. Unfortunately, there's too much storm management information out there to print in one article. The main things we need to know are:



- 1. Every household needs a plan.
- 2. No one should stay in a mobile home during violent weather.

Pinellas County has a comprehensive Web site about managing a weather emergency at http://www.pinellascounty.org/emergency/. This screen print of the home page gives some idea of the content:

One thing you will probably find is a long brochure containing all of this information. Unfortunately, there was no evidence of a printed version of the brochure.

The skillful person will be able to access this information online and, with considerable time commitment, ferret out what s/he needs to know to develop a usable weather emergency management plan for the household. For people who have fewer







"So I said okay and invited them. But when I got to him I never said a word and he never answered so I walked off. My parents kidded me all afternoon that I was afraid but that he might show up."

Ruth to this day said she can't explain the back of Lloyd's neck but it caught her eye that Sunday morning in church. "There was something about the back of his neck. I haven't figured out what yet all these years."

All these years represents 72 plus as on January 7th Lloyd and Ruth celebrated their 72nd Wedding Anniversary.

When asked what is the secret to longevity Ruth replied, "Having a lot of faith, hope and trust. Those are the three main things. Our faith in God really helped us a lot."

Lloyd added, "I agree 100 percent. I am the master of this house and whatever my wife says shall be done." He went on to say another main

The courtship of Lloyd, now 94, and Ruth, three years younger, was only three weeks and after making all the arrangements they were married with a large church wedding less than four weeks later. Their first year of marriage was a little hectic and with Lloyd being in the military police, his Company was moved around quite a bit. In fact in a six month span they moved nine times.

Being an M.P., Lloyd did not leave the States for World War II. However, when the Korean War broke out, his outfit went to Texas to train recruits. As one group shipped out, another took their place. Lloyd was one of two officers in his unit that was assigned to go Korea; and while he didn't see action, he was close to it. He earned a bronze star in Korea for taking a gun away from a soldier who was acting up.

In the meantime Ruth along with their two children--Bob born Sept. 5th, 1946; and Louise, May 1st 1949—lived with her parents for about a year while Lloyd was in Korea.

Lloyd and Ruth say the greatest gifts they have are their family. Besides two children, they have been blessed with five granddaughters, 13 great-grandchildren and three great, great grandchildren.

The French's have been coming to Bay Ranch dating back to 1971 and purchased their current coach in the mid 80's, making them the longest standing residents in the park. They normally go north about four months in the summer to stay with their daughter, then return.

At one time Lloyd was active in the park. He served on the Residents' Association board, including one year as president plus one year in charge of all dances. For years he was

active in shuffleboard, playing at all three levels over the years and has many awards to show for it. He was also a member of the choir for many years and sang with the church choir.

Ruth wasn't as active but did sing with the choir for many years She also participated in line dancing and weaving.

They have also done extensive traveling starting in 1970 when they went to London, England for a long weekend. It was only the beginning. They have visited several countries in Europe plus stops in Hawaii twice, New Zealand, Australia, Figi, Bermuda, Canada, Alaska and the Caribbean. They have gone to Disney World almost every year since it opened in 1971. "We've watched it grow," said Ruth. "We didn't go on any rides but we met our daughter and took in the attractions. There were 11 in our party but the staff catered to us." Add all the cruises, as many as three in one year, the French's certainly can be ranked as World Travelers

They are a charming couple and a perfect match. Congratulations, Lloyd and Ruth, on your 72nd anniversary.



Fortunately, I expect to need a couple of appetizers for the Super Bowl potluck. Here are a few possibilities. Mary Lou Foos brought over some Freezer Cucumbers and Onions before Christmas, and my housemates say they were delicious. I always like those meatballs made with grape jelly, so here is a recipe for that. But I have to admit, the Broccoli Dip is one of my favorites.

Cocktail Meatballs

1 lb ground beef

½ cup dry bread crumbs

1/3 cup minced onion

½ cup milk

1 egg

1 tablespoon snipped parsley

1 tsp salt

1/8 tsp pepper

½ tsp worcestershire sauce

½ cup shortening

1 bottle (12 oz) chili or barbeque sauce

1 jar (10 oz) grape jelly

Mix ground beef, bread crumbs, onion, milk, egg and next 4 ingredients. Gently shape into 1 inch balls. Melt shortening in a large skillet and brown meatballs. Remove meatballs from skillet; pour off any fat. Heat the sauce and jelly in the skillet, stirring constantly until jelly is melted. Add meatballs and stir until thoroughly coated. Simmer uncovered for 30 minutes or place in a slowcooker.

Freezer cucumbers and onions

From Mary Lou Foos

- 7 cups sliced pickles (cucumbers)
- 1 large sliced onion (more or less to taste)
- 1 cup green pepper sliced (optional)
- 1 can red pimento (optional)
- favorite vegetables

Combine

- 2 cups white sugar
- 3 teaspoons salt
- 1 cup white vinegar
- 1 teaspoon celery seed

Stir combined ingredients until the sugar is dissolved. Add the sliced ingredients and stir well. You can add any favorite vegetable. I blanch cauliflower and carrots for about 2 minutes in the microwave. Cool them in ice water before adding. Refrigerate for 5 days, stirring every day. After the 5th day put them in containers and freeze.

Broccoli Dip

From Ione Iones

- 1 bunch broccoli chopped
- ½ c onion
- 1-2 pkg veg soup mix
- 2 cups miracle whip
- 2 c sour cream
- 1 pkg cheddar cheese shredded

Chop the broccoli into small pieces. A food processor works well to do this. Mix together the miracle whip and sour cream and then add other ingredients except cheese. Chill and then add the cheese. I like to add garlic salt for added flavor.


















