I Love It When You Talk Dirt To Me: My Gardening Passion By Carol Raabe


ne of my favorite spring/summer/fall activities is gardening. I know a few Bay Ranchers share that passion. When we were growing up, landscaping was not a thing in our family. I don't even remember having foundation plantings around the house. We did have some big trees and a second lot that was our vegetable garden.

My dad mostly did the gardening, and he was fastidious. And also, I guess, adventurous. In addition to the annual veggies, we grew perennials: one bed of asparagus started from seed and one from roots; rhubarb; a huge raspberry patch; horseradish—I remember tears covering his face as he used a meat grinder on the root. He was Dane and it showed in the neatness of his garden and his commitment to organic gardening. In fact, the only magazine he subscribed to was **Rodale's Organic Gardening.** That commitment, though, meant that we kids spent hours weeding and using sticks to push potato bugs into tin cans of kerosene.



So I blame my dad for my passion for gardening. My passion has spread to landscaping, too, but that's another story. I think his interest in organic gardening, because it wasn't a "thing" back then, led to my experimentation with about any new kind of garden that came along. For

example, when Jan and I were first married, our garden soil was really worn out. Yes, the answer was probably to renew it with





wait until the plant is a little tall, add more dirt, repeat. Both experiments were pretty much failures. It's ok, though, because the new owners turned the garden into a parking lot.

In Minnesota, we rented a community gardening plot. To accommodate my dislike of hauling hoses, we used an irrigation system. We wove flat soaker hoses through short, white metal fences installed the length of the plot so the water would spray horizontally. It was a brilliant system and we harvested lot of produce that summer.





A couple of years later we planted a 3 sisters garden--squash, beans and corn interplanted to support each other-- in the peat on our "beach." Also on the beach: tomatoes, peppers and cucumbers. This was a great, lush garden, especially for squash, beans and tomatoes. Later still, we tried a square foot garden that really needed more water than I gave it. I can't remember why we quit the beach.

When we moved the western bank of the Missouri River, the soil was so bad—clay and shale-- we created a terrace on a hill using landscape timbers and hauled-in dirt. That garden has continued to flourish, but it is small and gradually turned over to asparagus and garlic. So I decided to try gardening in straw bales. By conditioning the bales over nearly 2 weeks before you plant, the bales become a rich growing medium needing little water and having few weeds. I really like this kind of garden. Unfortunately, where we live straw bales are hard to come by—we had to drive 50 miles to buy bales that had apparently been treated



with an herbicide. Only 2 of 12 bales yielded anything of note, but did they produce!



We moved on—to rain gutter gardening. You plant in large buckets or 5 gallon pails with little cups protruding through the bottom to sit in the rain gutter soaking up water. Ideal for an area averaging 10 inches of rain a year on poor soil! There are even ingenious ways to automatically keep the rain gutter filled with water. The rain gutter worked ok, better at my sister's in town, where the weather conditions are not quite so harsh. So this year, I moved my rain gutter to a more hospitable site on our lot, and Jan and I added 6 new wooden raised beds filled with black dirt. Next step, irrigation.

So far, so good.



Vacation trends: Money and more

If you're making vacation plans for the rest of the year, you might be interested in some of these trends reported by the TripAdvisor website:

Seventy-eight percent of U.S. travelers plan to spend the same amount of money or more when they vacation this year, for an average of \$8,400—the third-largest budget of travelers in any country worldwide. Baby Boomers will likely spend an average of \$10,600 for the entire year, but millennials will be more budget-conscious, shelling out an average of \$5,300.

The most important factors in choosing accommodations: price (94 percent cited that as the leading factor), followed by ratings (90 percent), close availability to attractions (89 percent), and dining options (79 percent). Other amenities are crucial as well: Seventy percent of those surveyed said they wouldn't stay at a hotel without air conditioning, and 42 percent won't sign in anyplace that doesn't have Wi-fi.

High IQ = fewer friends?

Psychology looked at data from a long-term survey of 15,000 people ages 18–28 to find out. The study found that happiness tends to increase with the number of social interactions people have.

Not too surprising so far, but researchers noticed an interesting fact: People with high IQs seem to be less happy the more they spend time with friends. The researchers theorize that people with higher IQs are more likely to find satisfaction in long-term endeavors than socializing with friends.

Diners willing to pay more for meals

Eating out can be expensive, but many consumers are more than willing to spend the money for a meal they don't have to cook themselves. The consulting firm Alix Partners, which surveys restaurant-goers, reports that diners expect to pay 1.9 percent more for their meals in 2016, for an average of \$14.25, up from \$13.99 last year.

It's the first time expectations have risen since Alix Partners began their surveys in 2007. In other findings, the survey found that consumers are nervous about food-borne illnesses, with 28 percent saying they'd never eat at a restaurant that had experienced an outbreak, and 34 percent indicating they'd wait until the restaurant had been cleared by health authorities. And just because they plan to spend more money doesn't mean they're not on the lookout for

deals—56 percent say they're going to look for more coupons and other discounts this year.


