

Wayne Redshaw Honored at Home

Wayne Redshaw, Bay Ranch winter resident, Coach 1392, was recently featured in an article by Bernd Franke in **The Tribune** out of Welland, Ontario. Wayne contributes a column about a Bay Ranch resident or couple to the **Bay Ranch Review** each month during the winter. This time, the table was turned. Here is the article as it was printed:

Retired Tribune Sports Editor Wayne Redshaw Leads Skate Down Memory Lane

When Wayne Redshaw talks about the heyday of hockey in Port Colborne, much of it is from first-hand knowledge.

Long before he joined the newspaper in 1962, the former Tribune sports editor knew all about the fierce

rivalry between Port Colborne and Welland from a fan's perspective that dates back to the late 1940s. Redshaw can remember boarding the trolley at Stop 17 on Quaker Road and getting off at Elm Street in Port Colborne.

"Back then, the fare was something like 15 cents, but it was worth it. You got to see good hockey," the 72-year-old Buffalo Sabres Hall of Famer said.

Battles for bragging rights in intermediate hockey weren't limited to the Port Sailors, the Crowland Bisons and that team's successor, the Welland Com-bines. "Dunnville was a big draw, too. You could always count on a mudcat get-ting thrown on the ice," he recalled with a chuckle. Thrown in celebration or in consternation? "Sometimes, it was both."

Those storied rivalries will be among the headlines ripped from local sports history next Monday when Redshaw leads a skate down memory lane at Portal Retirement Village. Port Colborne Historical Society has invited him to give a talk beginning at 7:15 p.m., and the theme of his 30-minute presentation is Port Colborne's Golden Years in Hockey.

An era that began in the late '40s, just after Teeder Kennedy left Port Col-borne on his way to a hall of fame career with the Toronto Maple Leafs, lasted well into the 1970s. Over that time Port Colborne won seven intermediate cham-pionships and twice travelled to compete in the eastern Canadian finals. "They also hosted the finals from time to time."

While the players, many of whom stayed close to home, weren't profes-sionals, it was nonetheless good hockey. "You have to remember for a long time it was only a six-team NHL, and the American Hockey League wasn't paying crap," Redshaw said. "Don't kid yourself, it was very good hockey."



LET'S EAT

Summer is almost here and summer is salad time. Cold salads are usually easy to put together and refreshing to eat. Many salads call for broccoli, a healthy vegetable some people can't to eat because it interferes with their medication. I have had very good results substituting cauliflower for broccoli in salad recipes. Cauliflower is stashed with nutrients. It is low in fat and carbohydrates and high in dietary fiber, water, and vitamin C. Vegetarians. vegans, and people watching their carb intake tend to choose cauliflower as a reasonable substitute for carbohydrates instead of potatoes and rice.

Broccoli Apple Salad **Ingredients** 4 cups fresh broccoli florets, (about 2 medium heads) ½ cup shredded carrots 1/4 cup diced red onion 2 large apples, finely chopped (gala apples are a good choice) ½ cup pecans, coarsely chopped ½ cup dried cranberries **Creamy dressing ingredients:** ½ cup lite mayonnaise ½ cup low fat Greek yogurt 2 Tablespoons lemon juice 1 Tablespoon sugar ½ teaspoon salt 1/8 teaspoon pepper Instructions 1. In a large bowl combine broccoli, carrots, red onion, apples, pecans, and dried I cranberries 2. To make the dressing: Whisk together mayonnaise, Greek yogurt, lemon juice, sugar, salt and pepper. 3. Add the dressing to the salad and toss to coat. Chill until ready to serve.

Broccoli Cashew Salad

Ingredients

- 1 pound bacon
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 2 teaspoons cider vinegar
- ½ cup white sugar (you may substitute an artificial sweeter)
- 2 pounds fresh broccoli, cut into florets
- 1 cup roasted cashews
- 1/4 red onion, finely chopped

Instructions

- 1. Cook and crumble the bacon. Set aside. In a large mixing bowl, combine mayonnaise, cider vinegar, and sugar. Whisk together until sugar is dissolved.
- 2. Add the broccoli, bacon, and cashews. Mix together until the salad is coated well in the mayonnaise mixture. Chill for 2 hours and let stand for 15 minutes before serving.

Apple Cranberry and Almond Coleslaw

Ingredients

Dressing

3/4 cup fat free Greek Yogurt (I recommend using Age, other brands may will be too thin)

1/4 cup mayonnaise

1/4 cup honey

2 Tbsp apple cider vinegar

Salt and freshly ground black pepper

Coleslaw

1 small cabbage, shredded (6 - 7 cups packed)

1 1/2 cups matchstick carrots

2 large gala apples, sliced into matchsticks (about 3 cups)

1/2 cup sliced green onions

3/4 cup sliced almonds or 1 cup slivered almonds

3/4 cup dried cranberries

Directions

- 1. In a mixing bowl whisk together Greek yogurt, mayonnaise, honey and apple cider I vinegar until smooth, while seasoning with salt and pepper to taste.
- 2. In a large bowl toss together cabbage, carrots, apples, green onions, almonds and cranberries. Pour dressing over cabbage mixture and toss to evenly coat. Serve immediately for best results.



Apple Pecan Rosemary Greek Yogurt Chicken Salad

Ingredients

1 lb boneless skinless chicken breasts, cooked, cooled and dice into small cubes

1 1/4 cups chopped golden delicious, gala or Fuji apple (chop small)

1/3 cup chopped pecans

1/3 cup dried cranberries, roughly chopped

Dressing

1 (5.3 oz) container fat-free plain Greek yogurt (heaping 1/2 cup)

2 Tbsp mayonnaise

1 Tbsp red wine vinegar

2 1/2 tsp finely chopped rosemary

1 tsp Dijon mustard

1/2 tsp honey

1/2 tsp onion powder

Salt and freshly ground black pepper

Lettuce or whole grain bread, for serving


Directions








The winning argument?

mericans tend to be an impatient bunch. A study by fulfillment software vendor Temando found that 80 percent of U.S. consumers want same-day shipping from retailers, and 61 percent want their purchases shipped out even faster, within three hours.

Retailers haven't responded, at least not yet. The study noted that only 53 percent offer same-day shipping even though 55 percent of buyers indicated they'd be willing to pay for it, and only 20 percent send products within three hours, although 31 percent said they'd be ready to pay for that.

Watch your words when talking to doctors

ommunicating with your doctor is important, but you can overdo it. From the Prevention.com website comes this lists of things doctors don't want to hear from their patients:

- "You're supposed to be the expert." Again, doctors are human, and they sometimes miss things. Have realistic expectations, and talk openly about your needs so the doctor can make an informed decision.
