

Editor's note: No new notes from Management

ost and Found Dog/Cat: If you have found a dog or cat, you can post on a site called pawboost.com or call Animal Service on Walsingham. If you call, Animal Services will come out, free of charge, to pick up an animal. Any questions, please call Rose Kalp at 459-4808. We have sent quite a few animals to animal services.

PLEASE BE a responsible owner and have your animal fixed. This service is very low cost through animal services.

#### **Snowbirds [and Vacationers]:** Before you leave:

- 1. Please make sure you have someone doing your weeds, trees, etc., and keep mobile clean on the outside during the summer.
- 2. Make sure anything that can be pitched around with the wind is put away.
- 3. If you have a change of address, please make sure you notify the office.

#### All Residents: Rules commonly broken:

- 1. Parking overnight on street and/or every day.
- 2. If you have someone living with you, make sure you have registered in the office.
- 3. Do not pile garbage in front of garbage bins. When you throw garbage, throw it to the back so when you open the door, it doesn't fall out and there is space.
- 4. Check mobile for cleaning, trim, awnings, driveway and/or painting. We will have someone out soon checking your mobile.

#### Still relevant announcements Cliff made this year at Koffee Klatch:

- 1. Keep the dumpster area neat, especially on the weekends. If the dumpster is full, please put extras neatly beside it.
- 2. Parking on the grass or sidewalk is against the rules. If necessary, park on the road.
- 3. Cars parked on the street after midnight will be towed. [Eds. Note: you have to pay the fine even if you run out before the tow truck takes your car away. We have nice neighbors who remind us when we are parked on the street at night.]
- 4. The Office must authorize overnight parking at the Clubhouse.

#### These messages are posted in the Clubhouse and pertain to every month:

Every Friday from 9 to noon: please turn off your hot water tanks. We use this time to fix leaks in the park.

Every Sunday at 5 p.m.: please flush your toilet(s). Our sewers were designed for more pressure than they get with low flow toilets. Flushing simultaneously will increase pressure and help keep the lines clean.











## Help for Severe Aortic Stenosis



Severe aortic stenosis is a narrowed aortic heart valve that doesn't open and close properly, reducing blood flow to the rest of the body.

Morton Plant Hospital is now enrolling eligible patients in the Medtronic Evolut R low-risk trial, which investigates the safety and effectiveness of a transcatheter aortic valve replacement (TAVR) system in patients with severe aortic stenosis who are at a low surgical mortality risk. TAVR is a minimally invasive alternative to open-heart surgery used to treat failing aortic heart valves in patients with severe aortic stenosis. Morton Plant Hospital was chosen as the first hospital in Tampa Bay to offer the TAVR procedure for patients with severe aortic stenosis who were at an intermediate or high surgical mortality risk. Our team has completed more than 700 TAVR procedures over the last five years.

## **Veterans Day**By Carol Raabe

Teterans Day honors all veterans of the United States armed forces.

A traditional observation is a moment of silence at 11 AM remembering those who fought for peace, commenorating the cease-fire in the 1918 armistice which was scheduled for "the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month."

Many cities around the country celebrate Veterans Day with a parade.

An annual Veterans Day parade takes place on 5th Avenue in Manhattan with over 500,000 attendees. A quick internet search found 2017 parades scheduled in Colorado Springs, Phoenix, Atlanta, Detroit, Boston, Dallas, Las Vegas, and many more. In Florida, Jacksonville, St. Augustine, Orlando, and Tampa plan parades in 2017.

Across the country, many restaurants and fast food chains offer free meals to veterans.

President Woodrow Wilson first proclaimed November 11, 1919, a day of recognition for Veterans of the Great War (World War I). In May 1938, the 11th of November in each year was declared a legal holiday and was known as 'Armistice Day'.

In 1953, a shoe store owner named Al King started a campaign that the day should celebrate all veterans, not just those who served in World War 1, suggesting it should be renamed 'All' Veterans Day.

Al's idea was taken up by his local Chamber of Commerce and then by a local congressman, who helped push a bill for the holiday through Congress. President Eisenhower signed it into law and in May 1954, Congress amended the law and officially replaced 'Armistice' with 'Veterans'.




