

t Bayside Waters we have chosen December as the month to raise awareness and end the stigma surrounding Anxiety Disorders, the most common mental health disorders in the United States.

Many people experience Anxiety at some time in their life. Anxiety is a normal response to stressful events like moving, retirement, changing jobs, or financial troubles. However, when symptoms of anxiety begin to interfere with your life, they could be signs of an anxiety disorder.

There are six common anxiety disorders that include; Phobias, PTSD, OCD, Panic disorder, Social anxiety, and Generalised Anxiety Disorder known as GAD. For the sake of this article we will address Generalized Anxiety Disorder (GAD).

The 11 common symptoms of anxiety disorder are:

Excessive worrying, Feeling agitated, Restlessness, Fatigue, Difficulty concentrating, Irritability, Tense muscles, Trouble falling or staying asleep, Panic attacks, Avoiding social events, or Irrational fears.

From the Anxiety and Depression Association of America (www.adaa.org):

"Generalized Anxiety Disorder (GAD) is characterized by persistent and excessive worry about a number of different things. People with GAD may anticipate disaster and may be overly concerned about money, health, family, work, or other issues. Individuals with GAD find it difficult to control their worry. They may worry more than seems warranted about actual events or may expect the worst even when there is no apparent reason for concern.

GAD is diagnosed when a person finds it difficult to control worry on more days than not for at least six months and has three or more symptoms. This differentiates GAD from worry that may be specific to a set stressor or for a more limited period of time.

GAD affects 6.8 million adults, or 3.1% of the U.S. population, in any given year.

Women are twice as likely to be affected. The disorder comes on gradually and can begin across the life cycle, though the risk is highest between childhood and middle age. Although the exact cause of GAD is unknown, there is evidence that biological factors, family background, and life experiences, particularly stressful ones, play a roll. Sometimes just the thought of getting through the day produces anxiety. People with GAD don't know how to stop the worry cycle and feel it is beyond their control, even though they usually realize that their anxiety is more intense than the situation warrants. All anxiety disorders may relate to a difficulty tolerating uncertainty and therefore many people with GAD try to plan or control situations. Many people believe worry prevents bad things from happening so they view it is risky to give up worry. At times, people can struggle with physical symptoms such as stomachaches and headaches. When their anxiety level is mild to moderate or with treatment, people with GAD can function socially, have full and meaningful lives, and be gainfully employed. Many with GAD may avoid situations because they have the disorder or they may not take advantage of opportunities due to their worry (social situations, travel, promotions, etc). Some people can have difficulty carrying out the simplest daily activities when their anxiety is severe."

The Mayo Clinic Health System staff suggests trying the exercise below the next time your mind is stuck on the worry setting. Sit quietly. Look around you and notice:

- 5 things you can see: Your hands, the sky, a pen, a spot on the wall
- 4 things you can physically feel: Your feet on the ground, a ball, your hair
- 3 things you can hear: The wind blowing, children's laughter, your breath
- 2 things you can smell: Fresh-cut grass, coffee, soap
- 1 thing you can taste: A mint, gum, coffee or tea

This exercise helps you shift your focus to your surroundings in the present moment and away from what is causing you to feel anxious. It can help interrupt unhealthy though patterns.

If you know someone is having an anxiety attack you should stay with them, speak in short simple sentences, be predictable and stable, help slow the person's breathing by breathing with them and counting slowly to 10.

Finally, be a friend, do not criticize or add pressure, anxiety is a disorder that is hard and complicated. Compassion, kindness, and understanding would be a beautiful gift

When it comes to phone appointments, a third of consumers actually prefer receiving health care advice over the phone, compared to 30% who prefer in-person visits, 25% who prefer online advice, 6% who prefer mobile apps, and 5% who prefer AI. Women are more likely to prefer the use of a phone for health care advice than men (36% to 28%).

The AI market for health care is expected to increase at a compound annual growth rate of 50.2% between 2018 and 2025, from \$2.1 billion in 2018 to \$36.1 billion by 2025.


