TA great teacher for Bill Gates

hen Microsoft founder Bill Gates attended Seattle's View Ridge Elementary, he was a typical nerdy 4th-grade introvert who kept to himself. However, a kindly librarian named Blanche Caffiere helped him into his own in a way that would one day change the world forever. Gates tells the tale on his blog:



"When I first met Mrs. Caffiere, she was the elegant and engaging school librarian at Seattle's View Ridge Elementary, and I was a timid 4th-grader. I was desperately trying to go unnoticed, because I had some big deficits, like atrocious handwriting ... and I was trying to hide the fact that I liked to read—something that was cool for girls but not for boys ... Mrs. Caffiere took me under her wing and helped make it okay for me to be a messy, nerdy boy who was reading lots of books."

Mrs. Caffiere encouraged Gates' passion for reading by helping him explore it through introspective questions, such as what he liked to read and why. She went out of her way to find books that were progressively more interesting and challenging for him. Once he'd read them, she would ask him if he liked what he had read, and more importantly, what he'd learned and why. "She genuinely listened to what I had to say," Gates recalls.

Blanche Caffiere passed away in 2006, shortly after reaching her 100th birthday—but not before Gates was able to thank her personally for the lasting impact her love and curiosity had on his life.

Problem

wo parents came to a counselor because they were having trouble with their 25-year-old son. The son had refused come to the counseling session with them. "He doesn't think he has a problem," the father said.

"Maybe he's right," the counselor said. "Tell me about it."

The son was having trouble staying in school and finding a job. He was using drugs, keeping question- able company, and avoiding responsibility in general.

The parents said they'd tried everything: Always making sure he had everything he needed, giving him plenty of money at college so he wouldn't have to work and he'd have plenty of time for study and a social life, and helping him find another college when he flunked out of his first one.

Finally, the counselor said, "I think your son is right. He doesn't have a problem."

The parents stared at him in shock. The father said, "Did I hear you right? You don't think he has a problem?"

"That's correct," the counselor said. "He doesn't have a problem. You do. He can do whatever he wants. You pay, you plan, you exert energy to keep him going. He doesn't have a problem because you have taken it from him. Those things should be his problem, but as it now stands, they are yours."

Lights began to go on in the parents' heads.

The counselor said to them, "Would you like for me to help you help him to have some problems?"





Stay cool during those hot August days and nights

he dog days of August can be hot. Other than huddling in front of an air conditioner 24/7, which isn't very practical, how you can stay cool? The Yahoo website offers these tips for beating the heat:



- Stay hydrated. Drink lots of water to keep your body temperature in balance and avoid getting overheated.

- Don't refrigerate blankets, pajamas, or anything else. They'll warm up quickly, and the moisture they pick up can create mold in your mattress.
- Push out hot air. Place a box fan facing an open window to blow hot air outside, allowing the cool inside air to predominate.
- Sleep with the right sheets. Breathable cotton linens can keep you cool through the night. Choose sheets with a low thread count for better breathability.


