From the Board of Directors

ith the summer heat upon us, it is important that as we go to the pool to get a little relief from the heat we comply with the rules that allow us to keep our pool open. These rules are in your Blue Book, and you should take a few minutes to



review them before your guests arrive. Of the rules that are there, the one that will cost us all the most money in the long run is the wearing of tanning lotions and oils, which are prohibited from being used inside the pool. These substances will destroy our pool filters and require a very costly replacement. We ask that you please remind your guests.

The Blue Jay Board was recently notified by a Homeowners Association legal blog that a longstanding Florida law on gambling was suddenly being strictly enforced by local authorities. The blog suggested that many fundraisers commonly used by associations to raise money were in fact not legal in Florida and come with significant legal liabilities to principals on Boards and Social Clubs. After consulting and meeting with our attorneys the Board was informed that while most of the games we play at Blue Jay are fine, the law specifically defines "games of chance" as illegal, and lists 50/50 raffles as a game of chance. As a result, one of the Social Club's main sources of revenue is no longer available to them. The Social Club has considered a number of alternatives, and will discuss their plans in the Social Club section of this Monthly Media.

Each of you that stay in Blue Jay during hurricane season should have an emergency plan that includes: 1.where you will stay if there is an evacuation; 2. supplies for 2-5 days; 3. medications; 4. important papers to take; 5. medical and pet accommodations. A reminder, the clubhouse cannot be used as an emergency shelter. Keep this in mind as hurricane season approaches.

We have been asked by our trash collectors to ask residents to place larger items out for disposal on Fridays rather than Tuesdays. We are being told that the truck is emptier when they get to Blue Jay on Fridays. Please remember also that there are guidelines in the Blue Book that reference putting trash on the sidewalk. Trash in cans can be put out after 6 PM the night before, but trash in bags or bound by string or rope cannot be in the sidewalk before the morning of pickup. There have been recent occurrences of trash on a sidewalk days before pick up. Please help us keep Blue Jay looking beautiful.

The pool will be closed starting August 5th (weather permitting) to replace the coping and refinish and refill the pavers. It will be closed for approximately 2 weeks. While we agree the timing could be better, there is really nothing we can do. There are few companies that do this type of work, and they do not allow us to decide when they will be here.

Issues are developing relative to homeowners starting projects on their home without Architectural Committee approval. The purpose of approval is to ensure that changes conform



to our policies. It is the responsibility of the homeowner to obtain approval. Without approval you could be required to remove all changes and restore the property to its pre-work state. Do not let contractors begin work on your homes before getting approval. Not doing so could prove costly.

Finally, Blue Jay policies, and Pinellas County ordinances, prohibit parking on our sidewalks. We have received complaints from residents who use walkers. They cannot walk on sidewalks because automobiles are there. All motor vehicles, including golf carts, should be parked on the street.
