Here we are, almost summer!! Each of you that stay in Blue Jay during hurricane season should have an emergency plan that includes – where you will stay if there is an evacuation; supplies for 2-5 days; medications; important papers to take as well as medical and pet accommodations. At the end of May a package was given to all those in residence to help you prepare. A reminder, the clubhouse cannot be used as an emergency shelter. Everyone needs to be ready and hope that we don't have to make use of the plan!!

The State Tie Down program is now complete. All certificates have been distributed to those that participated and the final adjustments have been made by the contractor.

The painting of the clubhouse will be done in August/September. Color selections were shown to residents that attended board and coffee hour meetings. The most popular colors were painted up on sample boards and are in the clubhouse for resident comments. Stay tuned...

Some folks that have gone north for the season turned off the electricity to their irrigation systems. We have identified that because the grass is dying. We have attempted to contact you or the person you designated to look after your home. If you have not heard from someone and you turned off the power then please contact a board member.

A few issues continue to crop up that we need your help with -

- 1. Debris is being dumped in the RV lot. If you have old bricks, sod or dirt it is your responsibility to properly dispose of it. Volunteers have cleaned up this area on a number of occasions yet we still find people are dumping.
- 2. Cigarette butts are being tossed in the street. We have talked to our contractors about this but there continues to be some residents and guests that are doing it too. Please take your butts home or put them in your pocket!!
- 3. A county health rule is that you shower before going into the pool. Many of our residents are not doing that. It is unsanitary and could cause an inspector to close our pool down. There are signs posted and the shower has warm water, so no excuses.
- 4. 15 MPH is not that fast...when you drive in Blue Jay it should be just like you are driving in a school zone. None of us are in that much of a hurry. Speeding is still an issue. We don't want to have to consider speed bumps so we need everyone to obey the speed limit.

Once again, thanks to our volunteers – they plant and tend, they fix irrigation, they step up to help with emergency preparedness and many other things that make our community so great – Thanks, you are wonderful!!!



With that I will remind you that we continue to have an operations meeting every Monday morning at 8:30am. I attend via telephone. Residents are welcome to attend. 



Coffee may keep you healthy

s drinking coffee good for you? A recent article on The New York Times website linked to a number of different studies touting the positive effects of caffeine on several different health problems. They include:

- Liver damage. A review of data collected by studies of more than 430,000 people found that coffee may lower the risk of cirrhosis of the liver, a disease associated with overindulgence in alcohol (among other causes).
- Tinnitus. Researchers kept track of more than 65,000 women and found that those who drank more than one 8-ounce cup of coffee a day were less likely to suffer from tinnitus, that persistent ringing or buzzing in your ears.
- Auto crashes. A study of truck drivers who routinely work on long hauls found that coffee drinkers (or consumers of other caffeinated drinks) seem 63 percent less likely to be involved in crashes while driving.
- Melanoma. An analysis of health and dietary data involving more than 400,000 people ages 50-71 found that those who drank four or more cups of coffee a day were 20 percent less likely to develop skin cancer. (The researchers cautioned that avoiding exposure to the sun's ultraviolet rays is still the most important way to avoid melanoma.)
