I am currently the Company Commander of an Infantry One Station Unit Training (OSUT) Company stationed at Ft. Benning, GA. Our missions is to turn civilians into Infantrymen over the course of a 14 week cycle that is both mentally and physically grueling. Our classes range from 170 to 240 trainees depending on a variety of factors we have no control over and we generally send close to 10% home because they can't make the cut. I have 12 Drill Sergeants and another five cadre, including my First Sergeant and Executive Officer, that I am responsible for and who I in turn handed out your letters to. Over the course of the last year we have trained over 550 Infantrymen who will form the bedrock of this nations fighting force. I am extremely proud of my cadre for all they have done and all they do, they are truly heroes and I appreciate your support of them.



Once again, thank you so very much for your letters of support and encouragement! They mean so much more to my Cadre than I could ever convey through words. It is encouraging to know there are still Americans out there who will take the time and effort to show our Troops that they are truly appreciated!


