# From the Board of Directors

As I write this Blue Jay has managed to dodge yet another hurricane, with Dorian skirting the coast rather than coming across the state as was initially forecast. Blue Jay got some rain, but we had no damage as the winds stayed away. After seeing pictures of the destruction in the Bahamas there is no way to imagine what would have happened if the storm had come through our area. We are very fortunate.

Special thanks need to go out from all of us to Rich Williams and his team of volunteers who put away all of our pool equipment, monitored things until we were sure the storm was not going to hit, and then put everything back in place. We always say that we live in the greatest community in all of Florida, but it is at these moments that we truly come to appreciate the efforts of our fellow homeowners. Thanks very much folks. We really do appreciate all you do for Blue Jay.

The pool reopened the Friday before Labor Day after some rather extensive work. We knew that the coping was going to be replaced and the pavers cleaned and resurfaced. We had also recently found that the ladder going into the pool had come loose from its fittings and would need to be repaired. What we were not aware of was that 4 of the 12 scupper drains on the pool were leaking internally. As part of the project we repaired all 12 of the drains, and resurfaced the scuppers. We did not see any reason to repair just 4 and then need additional work later. These were original to the pool so hopefully we will be OK for another 35 years.

Both budget hearings have been completed, and a final budget is being prepared for a vote of approval at our November meeting. All normal park activities continue as planned, although at a much slower summer pace as our Board members continue to cycle in and out to visit friends and families. The biggest upcoming issue is palm tree trimming, planned for mid-October.

Within the next month Board members will begin straggling in from up north, and by November 1st we should have a full Board again in residence. Blue Jay will once again be fully open for business, and we will all have the opportunity to resume our normal winter interactions with our Blue Jay family. It seems like we all just got home. These years are passing much too quickly.

Sue and I will see you all soon. We plan to be back on October 14th.







# Ancient human skulls hint at early European arrival

wo skulls unearthed in Greece suggest that Homo sapiens arrived in Europe from Africa much earlier than previously thought. The Sci-News website reports that the partial skulls were discovered decades ago, in 1978, but a recent re-examination allowed scientists to virtually reconstruct them.

One skull, 170,000 years old, belonged to a Neanderthal, but the other is 210,000 years old and appears to be an early modern human. This means that Homo sapiens spread out to Europe some 150,000 years earlier than believed. Scientists speculate that Neanderthals originally displaced Homo sapiens, but over time they died out as more early modern humans made their way to southern Europe.

# Giant squid sighted off New Orleans coast

Tor the first time, a giant squid has been sighted and captured on video in U.S. waters, the *Popular Mechanics* website reports. A research vessel grabbed video of the squid, *Architeuthis dux*, 100 miles from the New Orleans coast. It's only the second footage of a giant squid in the wild; the first was captured on video in 2012 off Japan's Ogasawara archipelago.

The video was taken with a camera called Medusa, designed to resemble bioluminescent prey in the deep sea and attract predators like the giant squid to obtain a close-up look that can be recorded and studied.

# Three myths about creativity

People have lots of misconceptions about the nature and practice of being creative. Here are some common myths to ignore (from the Livemint website):

• Creativity is serendipitous. Don't wait for the proverbial light bulb to go off inside your head. Enhance your imagination by talking to people, immersing yourself in information, and focusing on the problem you want to solve instead of hoping you'll get an idea out of the blue.

• Creativity is lonely. We imagine the painter alone in a studio, or a poet shivering in a chilly garret. You won't get ideas, though, unless you get out into the world and explore. The more perspectives you can get from other people, the more fuel your imagination has.

• Creativity requires a team. Organizations rely on R&D teams for creative ideas. Although seeking input from others is useful—even essential—many great ideas come from people who weren't actively seeking solutions at the time. Teamwork is great, but don't ignore ideas from offbeat sources. They may be the most innovative.
