owners wanted to stay on county water. Back to the question, "when was everyone put on the well?" I said, "oh my goodness let me think about this." Um, I went searching and found all of Jim's little notes and papers about connecting residents to the well along with all his original timer sheets and revised timer sheets.

In early 1999 they had talked about putting all sprinkler systems on the well water, but needed to drill a 3rd well which was done. At a Board of Directors meeting in the fall of 1999, Jim ask, "we have the 3rd well when are you going to start changing everyone over from county water to the well water". The Board of Directors reply, "Jim, anytime you want to start the project go ahead and start it." In a couple days Jim had "crews" digging, laying pipe, etc. He did all the connecting at first. Then he showed a few men how to do the final connection. He would always go back to check and make sure everything was ok.

Residents who still had the valve system wanted theirs put on timers, so again that was accomplished. This whole project only cost the residents the price of materials, labor was "FREE" thanks to the many volunteers that worked on this cost savings project for Blue Jay.

I have a letter from the Board of Directors President, Domenic Berenato, dated June 6, 2000 to all residents explaining that they may have to change the time on their sprinkler systems so that everyone was not on at once. Jim, Swede Ericson and Don Terrill did a trial on the time, and found out that no more than 24 could be on at the same time, so they set it up so that no more than 18 were on at the same time. I also have a letter dated June 22, 2000 signed by the three of them to the Board of Directors of their findings.

So there you have it folks, and I maintain my position that I am not a "pack rat," just a "Keeper of things."


