Boca Ciega's Kitchen

7 Layer Jello Mold Recipe

Ginny Tracy

Ingredients

4 (3 oz. pkgs) jello. Red, Yellow, Green, and Orange

2 cups milk

1 cup sugar

2 tsp. vanilla

2 envelopes Knox gelatin

2 cups sour cream (1 pint)

Directions

Dissolve green jello in 1 cup of boiling water.

Add 1/2 cup of cold water.

Pour into a greased 9 x 13 glass dish and put in refrigerator to set.

Put milk in pan, bring to a boil, add sugar, mix together until sugar is dissolved.

Dissolve Knox gelatin in 1/2 cup of cold water

Add to milk and sugar mixture.

Add sour cream and vanilla to this mixture;

Beat with beater until just blended.

When sour cream, milk, and etc. is fairly cool, put about 1 1/2 cups on set green jello.

Continue in this manner until the last layer of jello is added.

Note * It takes each layer about 1/2 to 3/4 of an hour to harden.

Time for making mold can be shortened by making jello and setting it aside to cool so that it is ready to put on top of white layers as soon as white layer is hard. Also it is best to place the white mixture in hot water to keep it from setting while waiting for layers to harden. The white layers and jello take about the same time to set in refrgerator.

*** This recipe sounds complicated, but it is really fairly simple.







New moon discovered around distant dwarf
