





Roz Bogoslowski is continuing with her treatments and doing well. We continue to keep her in our thoughts and prayers as she goes through her chemo regimen.


Wonderful news from Flora Turner in Unit#91. Her operation was successful and no further treatment is necessary. This is a definite praise report.



In between visits to the hospital a hundred miles away, Hope was getting sicker. Sitting on our deck by Minden Lake in the sunshine made us feel a little better. But Hope's days were becoming darker, with fears for the future.

As we sat there one day, we heard a beautiful sound – it was a bird singing very close by. I looked up at our birdhouse that had not been used in years. There were two birds perched on it, just 25 feet away. I decided this was an occasion to pour two glasses of wine – things were looking up.

The next day the sound of birdsong was just as beautiful, and it lasted almost all day. Same for the following day, and the next, and the next.

The female was going in and out of the birdhouse, building her nest. But her partner was not helping. He was just sitting on a branch, singing. He was not going to help. I started to lose respect for him. His song did not sound quite so beautiful anymore.

So I was blunt with him. I told him straight up: "Stop your yapping and do some work!"

We named him The Yapper. Sometimes we called him a lazy so-and-so, but he was the Yapper from that point forward.

Mrs. Yapper was still busy. She had completed their first nest and was now sitting on eggs. Days and weeks went by as we watched from our deck. The eggs did not hatch, but Mrs. Yapper did not give up.

Yapper would go to the entrance to the birdhouse and peek in. I am sure he was telling her to stop sitting on the eggs. The birds disappeared for a few days. When they returned, they were busy removing eggshells from the birdhouse. Then they were gone. I like to think they went to Snowbird country in Florida. In about a month or so, we would be going to the same place, if Hope was well enough to travel.

We asked Hope's chemo doctor if Hope could go to Florida. He replied: "Send me a post-card." We were as happy as a pig in you-know-what.

The following spring, Hope's recovery from the side effects of chemo was moving slowly. It was time to return north. We left Florida for our Canadian home at 5 a.m. As we left I told Hope: "If only we could pick up Mr. and Mrs. Yapper we could save them the long flight to Canada. That's how sure I was that they would be back.

Our trip home was better than the previous year. This time we did have our ritual glass of wine on the deck when we arrived. It was early April. My next job was to remove the old nest from the birdhouse. Otherwise, we worried that the birdhouse might be rejected by the Yappers.

One day in late May we heard that beautiful song – the Yappers were back. They started building their nest. This time, we spotted Mr. Yapper helping. In a few weeks, we could see a small head popping out of the entrance hole. A few days later we were in our living room when Hope said: "There's a fluffy ball sitting on our window sill." Sure enough, that fluffy ball was a little Miss or Mister Yapper – the next generation. The fledgling bird sat there for about 10 minutes. We thought maybe its parents had sent it there, to show off.

There are no words to describe the joy we felt. The singing continued as the baby birds left

the nest and did their flight training. Before long the singing stopped and the Yapper family were on their way to snowbird country. And soon we were on our way as well.

The next year the birds were back. Another furry ball sat on our window sill. Things were going well.

Then one day I was working in the garden. Hope said: "Yapper is following you around." This time he sounded different, like he was giving me hell. I must have done something wrong. A couple of days later I thought I knew what it was. I had the ladder out, so I removed the bird nest. Yapper was still not happy, so I put it back. The birds were going crazy.

The following spring, I removed the nest, but the birds did not come back. For two years, the birdhouse sat empty. We had our wine celebration upon our return to Canada two years in a row.

The third year was more exciting. In early May, we could hear that beautiful sound. Hope and I knew one of melody makers was a furry ball from our bird house.

Yapper number 2 did not sound as sweet as Yapper number 1, but he was trying hard. He did not do as much at chores as Yapper number 1, either. The first year for the Yapper number 2 couple, there was no luck. They were off to Florida in the fall without success. Year 2 was better – we saw a tiny bird pop its head out of the small hole. Year 3, we saw a fluffy ball on the ground.

The success of the new couple did not come cheap - a much larger bird was trying to put its head in the birdhouse. Yapper number 2 was fighting this new competition, and I also tried to chase the big bird away.

For two days, there was no sign of Yapper number 2. Hope and I feared the worst had happened. But suddenly we could hear a faint yapping and also a kind of whispering sound.

Yapper was injured – he could hardly fly after fighting off the big bird. But as the days passed, his song became louder.

To our surprise, the Yappers did try a second nesting that year after Mr. Yapper recovered, but it did not work out. Mrs. Yapper sat on the eggs for about a week. We did not see the birds for a couple of days, then they came back and removed eggshells from the bird house.

We are sad to say the birds, and their song and whisper, are gone for now.

Nine years since Hope's treatment and since we first met the Yappers, Hope is doing well. We hope the birds are too, wherever they may be.

Words cannot express how grateful we are. The Yappers - a type of Wren - gave Hope inspiration during some dark days. Inspiration can be found in the day-to-day struggles and successes and beautiful song of a pair of birds. We also believe the big guy up there has everything to do with Hope's recovery.

Our bird house is empty now but we hope the Yappers will return next spring. If the birds do come, we will be happy, but their song will never sound as sweet as the first time we heard the Yapper.

I will always remember his song, his yapping, and his whisper that said: "Everything is going to be okay," and it is.

For all our new neighbors, if you would like to sign up to host a Potluck there are always lots of residents to help.


