President's Corner

The park looks great and everyone has been enjoying social activities and some great camaraderie. January started with lots of excitement at the pool from the heater, the pump and a leak. with much diligence the pool has been restored and all have been enjoying it ever since.



It is important to be mindful of our rules and regulations. As a reminder, please follow the outlined details below when sub-leasing or having overnight guests.

Ten (10) days in advance for overnight guests;

Occupancy by guests of the unit owner shall be for a period of time not exceeding fifteen (15) consecutive days and thirty (30) days total per year, unless a longer period is approved in writing by the Board of Directors, but no guests may occupy the unit unless one or more of the permitted unit owners are then in occupancy or unless consented to in writing by the Board of Directors.

Thirty (30) days in advance for sub-lease;

to sub-lease your unit, the owner shall have all sub-lessees approved by the majority of the Board of Directors prior to them moving into your unit. No unit shall be sub-leased more than one (1) time per calendar year and the minimum sub-lease is two (2) months with a maximum sub-lease of one (1) year.

Following these guidelines keeps our park united as an owner's park. It is not the intention of the board to "knock on doors" to enforce the rules but rather to maintain and keep this park united as a resident owned and occupied community. However, when a complaint has been received we as the Board of Directors must investigate the facts and respond accordingly.

Another important point to highlight is that no mobile home may be bought or sold for investment or for use by business associates or for the sole purpose of leasing the unit.

With the above average highs in temperature I wish you all the great enjoyment of the sunshine state.






I made it home to Scotland last September into October. The main reason was for the wedding of my life long girlfriend's granddaughters wedding.
