

ou will be receiving your General/Limited Proxy in the mail from Progressive Management. It is important that all owners submit their Proxy for our Annual Meeting scheduled for 10:00 AM, Monday, December 1, 2014. Your completed Proxy ensures the Board of Directors will be allowed to conduct business during 2015.

Be sure you vote for each issue as explained in the Proxy. A quorum of owners (159 of 317) is required to pass the listed issues. Only one Proxy is valid per property. If you own two properties, submit a proxy for each one. Please show your Unit Number, then date and sign your Proxy before submitting. The signature must be any owner on the title. If you change, or have changed the title or mailing address since purchasing, you need to let Progressive Management know. You must submit your Proxy prior to 10:00 AM on December 1, 2014.

- 1. Drop in mail slot at Clubhouse Directors Office.

Biggest dinosaur ever dug up in South America

ove over, T. Rex, brontosaurus, and other giant dinosaurs—you've just been replaced. Scientists have discovered the largest dinosaur to ever walk the earth. It's been named Dreadnoughtus by paleontologists at Drexel University, who unearthed its skeleton at a dig in Argentina.

The creature was as tall as a two-story building, over 80 feet long, and weighed more than 130,000 pounds, making it the biggest land animal known to date. It lived during the Cretaceous period, 66 million to 84 million years ago. Its name, from Old English, appropriately means "fear nothing."





Tree Cutting Ordinance

Cut Down Your Big Tree, Pay \$5,000 Fine

The City of Safety Harbor has had a tree ordinance in place since 2007 to protect "Grand Trees," which are defined as trees having a minimum trunk diameter of 26 inches (this would be a circumference of 81.6 inches). Anyone wanting to remove or severely prune a Grand Tree must apply for a Tree Permit.

The Safety Harbor City Commission is revising the Grand Tree Ordinance at this time, and



during the revision a moratorium has been placed on issuing Tree Permits. This moratorium is in place until April 1, 2015, or such time as a new ordinance is adopted. Anyone violating this ordinance and illegally removing a Grand Tree during the moratorium faces a fine up to \$5,000. You can view the article about this on the Safety Harbor website:

Do not trust that a tree cutting service knows anything about the Safety Harbor permit requirements. The state of Florida does not require licensing for tree trimming, and so we see a lot of guys in trucks with chain saws and ladders who offer this "service." Your best bet for care of trees or their removal is a professional Certified Arborist. For more information see




