#### **BOARD BUSINESS and UPDATES**

#### From the Desk of

Jeff Clark, President

y entire working career has been in retail sales, where we have a universal saying: "No matter what we do, 2-3 percent of our customers will NEVER be satisfied." The remaining 98% or so are happy, or at least reasonable enough to work with in "wronging the right." Many times, this occurs when the business properly explains their policies to the customer, allowing both parties to come to a satisfactory solution.

What applies to the retail sales industry also seems to apply here in Briar Creek. You'll find that the vast majority of us are happy "customers," or good neighbors. Some occasionally stray and break a few of the rules, but once a director explains the "policy," they understand and the problem is solved. But, coincidentally enough, about 2 percent of our residents refuse to be good neighbors; I can literally count them all on one hand. They couldn't care less what our rules are, because they believe the rules don't apply to them. They're selfish and unreasonable, which inevitably leads to some unhappy experiences for their neighbors.

The Board does its best to deal with this tiny minority, but they're "special handling" requires the cooperation of everyone. If the "2 percent" has a mess in their yard, an overly noisy exhaust on their vehicle, or an illegal tenant, then you should be contacting a Board member. But we're not a police agency, and can't be expected to act as such. If this same



neighbor is disturbing the peace (especially at the pool), breaking local laws or threatening/intimidating other residents, then you need to call the **Pinellas County Sheriff's Office**. In almost every case, use their non-emergency phone number at **727-582-6200**; 9-1-1 is for true emergencies only.

And finally, remember that hurricane season starts June 1st, and lasts through November. While none of us wants to repeat what we went through last September with "Ms. Irma," we still must be prepared to do just that. Take the time to read all the information on our website under "Disaster Management," and look for updates in the local newspapers.

Now is the time to stock up on all the items you might need before and after a hurricane, as well as during an evacuation period. Do you REALLY want to face those crowds at the store, fighting for anything on a shelf, as the hurricane approaches? Stock up now on non-perishables. If you get through hurricane season with no need for them, they'll still be good for everyday use for a long time after. Another option is to donate them to the local food bank.

atering of lawns should be done with consideration for the whole community as there is only a single water meter that monitors the water usage in both Briar Creek Phase I & II. The water bill reflects the water usage in both communities. When lawns and other outdoor plants are watered, to the point that water is running down the street into the storm drain, this is a waste of a precious natural resource as well as a lack of concern for fellow residents who pay through their monthly condo fee for the water used in the communities.

There are water restrictions in place by Pinellas County. Usually this time of the year and other times when rain is in short supply residents required to follow county restrictions concerning the use of water, to ensure that there is a sufficient supply for everyone in the County.

Residents need to follow the restrictions, and if water is running down the street, it indicates that the ground can no longer absorb it and the water should be turned off. It is better to water several times than try to get it done all at once and waste water. I have been called out several times with what residents believe is a water line break only to find that someone's lawn or plants are being over watered and I have to request them to stop. I ask all residents to show respect for their fellow residents and our precious natural resources and use water responsibly.

Te're selling off some of the power tools at the garage, and we're starting with the power saws. The table saw is \$20.00, and the radial arm saw is \$50.00. If they aren't sold by June 15th, then they'll be donated to a local charity.

We know this decision will disappoint some, but it's necessary for two reasons:

- 1. Many of the tools have been disappearing from the garage at a rapid rate, and most of them have not been returned. We could buy new replacements, but should the Board be subsidizing those residents who take them out on "permanent loan"?
- 2. We've witnessed residents using these power tools in a very unsafe manner. No eye protection, no second adult to supervise (despite the sign on the radial arm saw that's been there for years), letting fingers and limbs get too close to the moving blade. They're also leaving a mess (sawdust and other scraps) to be cleaned up by others.

There's no doubt that the same residents using these tools irresponsibly won't hesitate to call one of the hundreds of "personal-injury" attorneys in this area once they've injured themselves. We can assure you that our liability insurance company will cancel our coverage or dramatically increase our premiums once they find out we've allowed open access to these tools.







### **Briar Creek 1 and Briar Creek 2 Website Changes**

ssociations such as ours (BC1,BC2) <u>must have a website</u> with protected information such as minutes, financials, and contracts.

This is extract from the law

- 1. By July 1, 2018, an association with 150 or more units which does not manage timeshare units shall post digital copies of the documents specified in subparagraph 2. on its website.
  - a. The association's website must be:
- (I) An independent website or web portal wholly owned and operated by the association; or (II) A website or web portal operated by a third-party provider with whom the association owns, leases, rents, or otherwise obtains the right to operate a web page, subpage, web portal, or collection of subpages or web portals dedicated to the association's activities and on which required notices, records, and documents may be posted by the association.
- b. The association's website must be accessible through the Internet and must contain a subpage, web portal, or other protected electronic location that is inaccessible to the general public and accessible only to unit owners and employees of the association.
- c. Upon a unit owner's written request, the association must provide the unit owner with a username and password and access to the protected sections of the association's website that contain any notices, records, or documents that must be electronically provided.



To view the <u>Board of Directors Minutes-Financial-Contracts</u> link on the website, you now have to be authorized. Everything else on website is the same (can be viewed by anyone).

You must be a Briar Creek owner to be authorized.

To become authorized do the following from the website:

- 1. click on the Board of Directors Minutes-Financial-Contracts link
- 2. click on Request Access Click Here
- 3. You will see a form appear on your screen
- 4. Complete the form and click on Submit Form

When you are approved, you will receive an email message containing username and password. You must fill in these fields before logging on. You have to re-enter the username and password if you leave and come back.

Approvals are usually returned in 1 day.

You only need to be authorized one time!

For any problems, send email to 'webmaster' or 'webmaster2' (on the website). Thank you for your cooperation.
