of course your follow through at the polls was very flattering. I will do my best to keep you informed of significant activities related to my direct responsibilities. Respectful comments and/or suggestions on keeping our Community as lovely as it is are always welcome.

Sole lawn service for February is scheduled for the 2nd. I'm anxiously awaiting the complete 2018 schedule and I'll post in the clubhouse, forward through Betty's email service and provide reminders within the Monthly Media.

Please remember that residential inspections begin early February and your efforts in keeping your perimeter weeds in check, planters dressed and trees/bushes trimmed will all go a long way with each group of inspectors.

Remaining paperwork for an open Beatification Grant should be finalized with the City of Safety Harbor within the next few weeks and we should see a check covering 25% of our internal costs. Projections initially had us slated for as much as 50% cost sharing, but our percentage, like all others, was adjusted because the City was inundated with worthy proposals. I'll be monitoring possible support for 2018 and keep you informed.

Lastly, I for one owe Barbara Pesic an apology. Like many of you I'm guilty of taking things for granted and assuming that the lawns and beautiful landscaping character of our Community just happen on their own. In an effort to make the transition of responsibility as seamless as possible, Barbara handed me a 3" binder full of pertinent data, contact information and friendly do's/don't regarding my new job as your Director. Then she spent FIVE HOURS with me going over everything in detail. Barbara's time with me covering the job summary was priceless, but my greatest takeaway was the sincere passion and love of horticulture that she so humbly provided our Community during her four year term. #### **Report from the Board of Directors**

At the January 3, 2017 Board meeting, the following items were presented, discussed and approved.

1. A recommendation to cancel our existing contract with the vending company caring for our laundry equipment and to purchase two clothes washers and two clothes dryers to replace the current leased equipment. A locked drop box will be installed for patrons to pay \$1.50 per load per machine on the honor system. A review will be conducted at 6 to 12 months to measure the use of the equipment. If there is no money in the box, it will appear the equipment is not necessary and other plans will be discussed. A lock has been placed on the door which requires the same key as our clubhouse for entrance as this equipment is for Briar Creek Phase 1 residents. This was presented as a motion, seconded and approved. The lock has already been installed on the door.



2. The Articles of Declaration of BC1 states that the Board of Directors may adjust the number of rentals available to homeowners. A motion made to lower the rental percentage from the current 10 percent (which is 31 rentals) to 8 percent (which is 25 rentals). Everyone who has a rental currently will be grandfathered in and their rental remains available, following the guidelines of the Rental Policy of 2017. The number will decrease by attrition stating that 'when a property has a deed change or name change by any means, the property is no longer available for rental'. After a second to the motion and discussion was held, the motion was approved.





s of this writing, our Big 10 League B Team is currently tied for first place with our arch nemesis, Embassy. Our players had two outstanding wins in December, scoring 28 to 4 against Lake Tarpon Village on our home courts, followed by 27 to 5 against Cedar Creek on



their courts. This may be the year we grab the Championship for the B Team!

In late December, we also had a fun doubles tournament open to all Briar Creek residents. All 24 spots were taken, including 9 non-league players. Our advanced players were matched with beginners, giving everyone a shot at the win. The winners of the Main Bracket were Flo Bombardier and Gary Hoad; and the winners of the Consolation Bracket were Rocky Gaetan (first time player!) and I. Another fun doubles tournament is tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, March 28th – open to all residents of Phase I and Phase II.

We will also be running a Winter Doubles League just for residents (Phase I and Phase II). Play starts on Saturday, January 27th and will run thru March 3rd, each Saturday, 10:30am to 1:00pm. Advance reservations are available, which will guarantee your spot in the league. If you don't want to commit to the six weeks, you can register as an Alternate, to be first in line for any open spots the days you want to play. If you haven't registered in advance, you can still show up at game time to see if there are any openings. Partners will be drawn randomly each Saturday. Matches will be 3 games, played to 12 frames or 75 points, whichever comes first. Players will individually earn points for each game won, and the league standings will be based on each player's win/loss average






