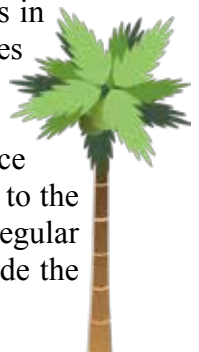

The once monthly service will occur on Friday, February 10th. This is the last month with one service.

**Tree Trimming Reminder**

Given that we are at that time of the year for our annual inspections, it is a good time to inspect the trees on your property. The association provides trimming of trees in all common areas of the park, which occurred in January. The trimming of trees on residential lots is the responsibility of each homeowner. Trees should be trimmed so that their branches are not hanging over the streets and impeding the flow of traffic and large trucks through the park (at least a 12 foot clearance is recommended). Tree growth should not block illumination of street lights to the roads. The dead growth on palms and other trees should be trimmed off on a regular basis, and dead trees should be removed. Please inspect your trees and provide the necessary maintenance.

# SAFETY ON OUR STREETS

---

**A**s a new year begins, we sometimes need to be reminded of some basic rules/by-laws of our community here at Briar Creek 1.

- Parking on the street at night is a definite NO! Emergency vehicles must be able to get where they are going without delay. Someone's life or home may depend upon a fast arrival.
- Parking is NEVER allowed in the grass at your home, adjacent neighbor's or community grounds. This also includes the edge of the grass as well. Many of our utility lines and sprinkler heads are located there. The streets are wide enough for three cars to be side by side. Just park along the edge in the street. If there is a car parked in the street already, park on the same side, not opposite those already parked causing traffic to zigzag through them. Remember emergency vehicles are BIG! (We realize that when an event is going on at the clubhouse, people must park on both sides of the street, but Briar Creek Blvd. is exceptionally wide in front of our clubhouse)
- All vehicles in the park must have a BC sticker posted on or in them. If you have traded vehicles or purchased a new one, pick up a BC sticker at the clubhouse from one of the Directors. If you have overnight guest, pick up a guest paper outside the Office at the Clubhouse, fill it out and lay it on the dash where it can be seen.
- If you are walking our community after dark and before sun up, please carry a flashlight to let vehicle traffic be aware of you. (We recently purchased the small ones at Walmart and they were \$1.00 each and had the batteries with them.)

Our goal is to keep everyone safe and accessible to emergency care if needed.

He and his wife Cathy had to locate near the VA hospital in Richmond for approximately 6 months to qualify to be near the hospital doing the transplants at that time. Terry was admitted to the VA Hospital to wait (hopefully) for a donor while Cathy waited at a shared apartment with the wives of other hopefuls. The VA Shuttle took some of the guys out to eat one evening for Italian food. No one was at the top of the transplant list or they could not have left the hospital. A donor heart had been received and low and behold, Terry was the closest match with blood type and other info. A call was placed to bring the guys back immediately. Later that night, after a pumped stomach, Terry was blessed to receive the heart during a transplant operation which took several hours. Two weeks I traveled to Richmond, VA and spent a few days with Terry and Cathy. He did wonderful and because of one person’s generosity and signature on a ORGAN DONOR card, Terry received a new heart. Terry was given 10+ more years of life because he had a new heart that was disease free.

Most of us will not get the opportunity to receive another heart so we MUST take care of the one we have. The older we become, the greater the risk and the more we need to stay active. Physical activity is a must; walking, jogging, swimming, biking, aerobics, bicycling, etc.. You do not have to be an Olympian, just stay as active and possible and have annual physical checkups.

And now, the rest of the story...

I received a call from Cathy more than 10 years later that Terry had been diagnosed with lung cancer and was at our local VA wanting to see me, so I immediately went to visit him. He asked Cathy and his sister to step outside as he needed to talk with me in private. After they left he told me of his cancer diagnosis and said, “can you believe after all I went through with my heart, I am now dying with lung cancer. Any idea how or why this would happen?” My reply was, “Everyone needs 6 pallbearers to carry the casket and there were not 6 friends to do the job. The good Lord gave you another chance to become a likeable/loveable person who would have many friends to carry you through the rest of your life.”

You see, Terry was not a likeable person the first time I met him. He was negative, always griping, unfriendly, abusive to his family...always demanding HIS way and no other mattered. I am so thankful Terry became a friend to many after his heart transplant and especially to me because I grew to love him like a brother. (True Story)





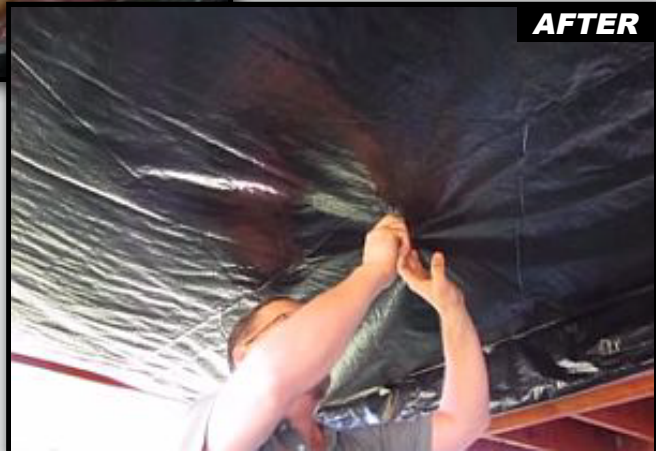

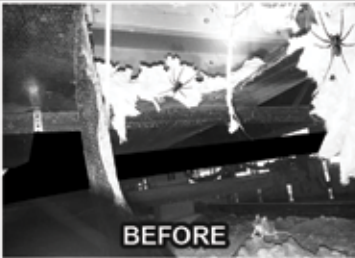

## **PHYSICAL ACTIVITY IN OLDER AMERICANS\* for the Young Ones at BRIAR CREEK**

**I**n a 2010 CDC study, more than 30% of adults aged 65 or older report no leisure-time physical activity. But even older people need regular exercise.

### **The Benefits:**

- It can help prevent bone loss (reducing the risk of fractures) and reduces the risk of many diseases associated with aging.
- It increases muscle strength and may improve balance and coordination, which can reduce the likelihood of falling. It also increases the ability for basic living, making it easier to carry grocery bags, get up from a chair and take care of household chores. Being physically active is a real key in maintaining quality of life and independence.
- Elderly men with high blood pressure can lower their risk of death with even moderate levels of fitness compared to those who were less fit.
- Studies have shown that increased levels of physical activity are associated with a reduced incidence of coronary heart disease, hypertension, non-insulin-dependent type 2 diabetes, colon cancer, depression and anxiety.
- Active people with high blood pressure, high blood cholesterol, diabetes or other chronic diseases are less likely to die prematurely than inactive people with these conditions.
- Fitness can have a positive impact on health regardless of age or the presence of chronic illness.
- 

### **Exercise Tips:**

1. Older adults can work with their health care provider to develop an activity plan to consider chronic conditions, activity limitations, and reducing risk of falls. Fitness professionals can also be a good resource for recommendations on physical activity and injury prevention for healthy, asymptomatic older adults.
2. Focus more on increasing moderate activity and give less emphasis to attaining high levels of activity which can have a risk of injury and lower adherence. Pick activities you enjoy and exercise at an intensity appropriate for you.
3. You may find that you can gradually increase your physical activity over time.
4. Pick activities that are fun, suit your needs and that you can do year-round.
5. Wear comfortable clothing and footwear appropriate for the temperature, humidity and activity.
6. If you decide that walking is a great activity for you, choose a place that has a smooth, soft surface; that does not intersect with traffic; and that's well-lighted and safe. Many people walk at area shopping malls.
7. Find a companion to exercise with you if it will help you stay on a regular schedule and add to your enjoyment.

8. Because muscular adaptation and elasticity generally slows with age, take more time to warm up and cool down while exercising. Make sure you stretch slowly.
9. Start exercising at a low intensity (especially if you've been mostly sedentary), and progress gradually.
10. If you plan to be active more than 30 minutes, then stay hydrated by trying to drink some water every 15 minutes, especially when exercising in hot, humid conditions.
11. As you age, your sense of thirst tends to decrease and you may not be able to completely rely on your internal sense of thirst.

Did you know that there is another lending program within Briar Creek that has nothing to do with books?

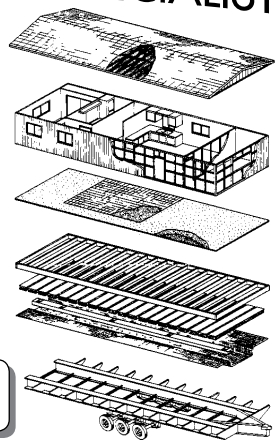

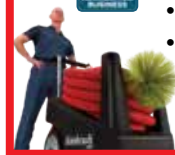

Bunco – Feb. 23 at 6:30 for dessert and 7:00 game start. Tickets are \$3.00 for this dice game.

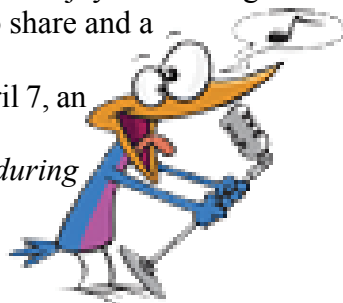

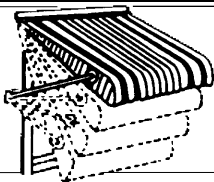

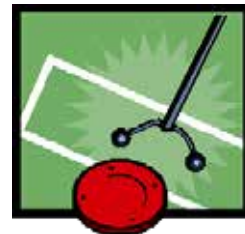
