We Respect Our Home

n the last few months, our swimming pool area, as well as other park locations, has been violated by non-respectful users.

The picture below shows damage to the hot tub caused by someone throwing in a bottle of "hair and body wash." The pool company fished out the bottle and had to correct the damage which caused not only inconvenience to the residents who wanted to use the hot tub and



pool but also increased our pool maintenance costs.

Several comments were made at a recent Wednesday Social Club meeting that illustrated the need for firm, decisive action in response to those who either cannot or will not abide by our guidelines. These policies were put into place so our property will be protected and maintained in an orderly manner. No more than you would let someone into your home and damage items, than you should allow a person or persons (whether known or unknown) to wreak

havoc on Briar Creek property.

If you see someone doing something unacceptable in or around the pool, clubhouse, shuffleboard court, parking areas, laundry buildings, and so on, please don't hesitate to call someone immediately. You can call the appropriate Board of Director member, or if you are not sure where your call should be directed, pick up the phone and call the non-emergency number of the Pinellas County Sheriff's Department, 727-582-6200. If you don't have that number handy, you can always call 911 and say "This is not an emergency" and they will connect you with the proper person.

As a resident here, you have an obligation to follow the bylaws, guidelines, and obey our other park restrictions, as well as applicable legal restrictions, while in Briar Creek. Naturally, these regulations also apply to your visitors. Please note when you have a visitor 16 years or younger, and they are riding a bicycle in our community, a bicycle helmet is a legal requirement. As the title says, We Respect Our Home, and we hope others will also.

As a reminder, the following are the published guidelines in conjunction with using the

swimming pool, as well as the spa. Naturally, even with the absence of written rules, using common sense is always a number one priority.

Pool & Spa Rules

Gene Arend, President

The Board of Directors is responsible for issuing rules for the use of the Pool and Spa. These rules cover both behavior and conduct, as well as safety issues. The following are the rules established:

Smoking of any type of cigarette, cigar or device is permitted only on the patio area where the two ceiling fans are located. No Smoking is permitted in the immediate area surrounding the Pool or Spa.

No Food or Drinks in glass containers, nor are animals permitted on the pool decking or in the pool or spa.

No Life Guard is provided at any time.

Showering to remove excess sun tan lotion or oils is required prior to entry to the pool or spa. No foreign substance is permitted in the pool or spa.

Adults swimming hours are 9 AM to 10 PM. Children under 18 are permitted from 10 AM to 2 PM and again from 5PM to 7 PM. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult. The hours for children during some holiday periods are altered to the adult hours and a sign is posted at those periods.

Children under 3 years old must wear a swim diaper at all times.

Maximum water temperature in the spa is maintained at an average of 104 degrees. Children under 14 years old are not permitted to use the spa by rule of the Pinellas Health Department.

Maximum use of the spa is recommended to not exceed 15 minutes by rule of the Pinellas Health Department.

Pregnant women should not use the spa. Persons using alcohol, narcotics or other drugs that cause drowsiness or dizziness should not use the spa or pool.

An approved pool tag should be carried as a passive form of identification at the pool and spa by owners or guest. If someone is not familiar to an owner, it is recommended they politely ask the other person to present the pool tag prior to using the pool or spa.

The temperature in the pool is maintained by heaters or chillers to be at an average of 84 degrees year round. Excessive rain or sun can cause these temperatures to vary several degrees before the equipment can adjust the temperature. The volume of water in the pool may take several hours to adjust to the desired temperature. Therefore 2 - 4 degrees in either direction is not unusual. The access door to the temperature gauge has been sealed to reduce the number of phone calls reporting the temperature is 82 degrees or 86 degrees. The pool is monitored and inspected by a licensed company on a regular basis.

IRS Calling You? No Way!

learwater police are warning residents about scammers who are using the department's name. Police say the scammers are calling residents and claiming they owe the IRS money, then telling the residents the Clearwater Police Department will arrest them if they don't pay up. The callers make the scam sound legitimate, by using the name of Capt. Harris and a real phone number for Clearwater police, officials said.

Police say the scammer tells the people they will be held in contempt of court if they don't get a prepaid debit card, and they are threatened with arrest within 24 hours if the person does not do as they are told. Some victims have been told that police are watching their house and monitoring their phone calls. Additionally, the callers sometimes insist that you provide them your Social Security Number. **NEVER** give out that information over the telephone, even if the caller sounds legitimate!

The department has received several complaints to its fraud hotline about these calls. Officials say if you receive a call like this, hang up and call the fraud hotline at <u>727-562-4424</u>.

Betty's Household Hints

aring for your kitchen knives means keeping them clean and sharp. A few simple guidelines can make a real difference in how long your knives will remain useful tools in food preparation.

Wipe the blade with a clean non-abrasive cloth as soon as you've finished using the knife; then rinse the knife with warm to hot water. Put a few drops of dish soap onto a wet non-abrasive cloth and scrub the blade with the soapy cloth. There are non-scratching scrubbers that will work well, especially if there is heavy debris on the knife. Rinse the knife once more with warm to hot water and dry the knife with a clean cloth, taking extreme care not to dry across the sharp edge of the blade.

To maintain a sharp edge on your kitchen knives, NEVER put your knives into the dishwasher. The combination of very hot water and the type of detergents used in electric dishwashers will dull almost every knife blade, and if this occurs, there is usually no way to keep the original sharp edge.

A chef told me that using a wooden knife block is a safe and easy way to store your knives. He also mentioned that if one stores knives in a wooden block, that the knife blade should be inserted into the appropriate slot with the "sharp edge side up." He said if a knife is slid into the slot with the sharpened edge downward, the knife will dull fairly quickly because the honed edge rubs against the wood every time the knife is removed and reinserted.

Another convenient way to store your kitchen knives is to use a magnetic strip hanger. These magnetic strips can be mounted on the side of a kitchen cabinet and your knives will always be within arm's reach. Most hardware stores carry these magnetic strips, as well as stores like Walmart, and are reasonably priced.



ALTERATIONS/RENOVATIONS

If you are making changes to the exterior of your property, you are required to complete a Alteration/Renovation Form for approval by the Board of directors. The forms to be completed are outside the Condo Office in the Clubhouse. Please date the form, filling in your name and address and a detailed description of the change. You will also be required to include the name of the Company doing the work and their License number. Submit the completed form to the President of the Board.

DO NOT do any work until the form is approved by the Board and you receive a letter stating the approval. Give yourself enough time for the project as it has to be brought before the Board at the next Board Meeting. Between May and August, there are no Board Meetings, however, the procedure is the same - complete the form and submit to President - four(4) Board Members have to sign off on the form *before any work is to begin*. Again, give yourself enough time for the change as four(4) members may not be readily available. Once you receive the letter of approval, you may start the work.

Also, be advised, any work requiring a permit from the City/County will not be approved until the permit is attached to the Alteration/Renovation Form. For example, removing trees, pouring concrete to widen driveways or make walkways.

Rains come pouring down in torrents Streets turn into mighty rivers Winds are blowing, trees are swaying A mighty punch the storm delivers





Ancient bones offer clues to evolution

S cientists may have discovered a new human ancestor to go along with "Lucy," the 3.2 million-year-old Australopithecus afarensis female from eastern Africa. Dubbed "Little Foot" because of his small bones, this specimen was unearthed in South Africa in the early 1990s. His skeleton was almost completely preserved after falling down a narrow cave shaft and dying there. Whether Little Foot was a relative of Lucy's or a different pre-human species has been a subject of debate among anthropologists, but a new dating process suggests that Little Foot lived and died some 3.67 million years ago, close to the same time as Lucy.

Although some scientists dispute the accuracy of the dating technique, if it holds up it suggests an evolutionary link between different species of Australopithecus in ancient Africa, as well as evidence of where in Africa modern humans began to develop.

Birds do it, bees do it, and so do amorous mice

From time immemorial, men have wooed their lady loves with romantic (if sometimes off-key) music. Now scientists from Duke University believe that love songs aren't just for humans. Mice also sing to females they hope to attract, although they aren't likely using Barry White.



Instead, mice rely on high-pitched sounds outside the range of human hearing, using specific tunes when they smell a potential mate and different ones when they finally set eyes on her. The songs are louder and composed of more complex sounds when they smell a female scent, and get simpler—but longer—when they finally meet face to face. The complex songs seem to attract females, although what specifically draws them close is still uncertain.


