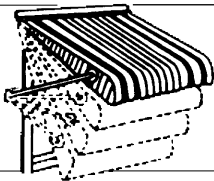

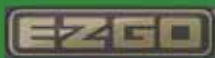

A few owners had to replace their roofs over the summer and the expense is quite hefty. So if you can avoid this by keeping the roof clear of debris to prevent damage, it could be a money-saver.
