#### **Mailbox Numbers – Gene Arend**

#### Comfort Pets - Board

Some residents have completed all of the necessary paperwork and medical declaration required by the Board of Directors to have a "comfort pet" registered within the Briar Creek Community. The Board has issued a business-card size identification card so the owners who have met the Association requirements can walk their pets with freedom. This card is issued once a resident has provided the Board of Directors with the appropriate documents to identify the animal has been registered as a Service or Comfort animal. The board will process the documents and medical letter covering the animal and issue the registration card in a timely manner. If the person with a pet has this card, please respect their rights to go about the community in peace.

We have asked the owners to carry this card with them in order to provide any resident questioning the presence of such an animal in the community with proof the animal is officially registered. If you have such an animal and have not registered the animal please do so immediately. Merely stating there is such a law does not excuse anyone from not providing

the proper registration of the animal. We ask all residents to respect the "Americans with Disability Act", and the owners of such animals to register the animal with the Association. We also ask owners of animals, regardless of its registry to respect the Pinellas county ordinances with regards to picking up after your animal and maintaining the animal on a leash at all times. There is no standard definition of a comfort animal and many people have different names for animals that aid in the medical treatment of humans.

There are three major groups, Service, Emotional and Therapy. Whatever their name, their purpose is simple: to improve the mental or physical health of a patient.

#### **Pool Rules and Enforcement – Board**

The Board of Directors have, under Florida Statute 810.09(3), authorized the Pinellas County Sheriff Department to deal with any issue at the pool regarding persons suspected of trespassing or whom have elected not to comply with the pool rules. The pool is under camera surveillance and by calling the Sheriff non-emergency line 727-582-6200 or 911, depending on the gravity of the situation; the Sheriff will handle the problem. We would prefer the pool participants not become involved or escalate any situation beyond politely informing the person(s) of the pool rules or if the person(s) are not able to provide the appropriate pool tags that identify the owner or guest(s) at the pool. The rules of the pool are clearly posted and have been developed to accommodate our owners based on the fact that this is a 55+ community. We ask our owners and their guest(s) to respect the rules established by the Board of Directors.
