What's the Harm?

I often get this question when someone wants one of us Board members to “bend the rules a little bit,” you know- just for them. I won't bore you with all the numerous examples, but I will give you two clear-cut reasons for not subverting the rules:

1. When each of us purchased our home and lot here in Briar Creek, we signed our name to a form that stated we would follow the rules that have been enacted over the years. Every one of us was given the opportunity to read all these rules BEFORE we finalized said purchase. For better or worse, condominiums are formed around and operate under a set of rules. It's these rules that have allowed us to maintain the standards that Briar Creek is well-known for. If you want to know the basis for our high quality of life, our high home values, then you need to look to our rules.

2. It's the old adage: “if I let you do it, then I have to let everyone do it.” Allowing one person to park their car in the street overnight, in the grand scheme of things, probably causes no harm. But if we let EVERYONE do it... cars will be damaged, the mail and other delivery services won't be able to get through, fire and other emergency services will be curtailed: you get the idea.



I see so many examples everyday where residents don't care to follow our rules (or by-laws, or restrictions), and each one of these infractions detracts from our quality of life. Each individual example might be slight, but when added up the sum affects us all. If we all curbed our pet (and cleaned up after them), cleared the clutter from our carports and porches, and made sure our vehicles are properly parked (to offer just three examples), then life for all residents would be better. Going forward, you'll see more enforcement of our rules by the Board; just tonight, I wrote the first of three parking tickets for illegally-parked vehicles. But such enforcement won't work without the cooperation of all residents. Please help us to maintain our standards and keep Briar Creek the special place we've all worked so hard to create and maintain.

On another note: a lot was learned from our experience with Hurricane Irma! An important reminder to our snowbird neighbors; as you prepare to leave Briar Creek for the summer months, which coincide with Hurricane season, please clear/store all of your outdoor furniture, bicycles, etc. anything that could take flight in hurricane force winds. Better to be over prepared and not need to be than under prepared and get clobbered! Thank you!

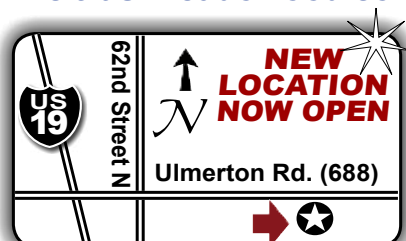

- The pool will be open from 8:00 am - 10:00 pm daily
- Adult swim hours will be 2:00 pm - 5:00 pm with children restrictions
- Swim at your own risk policy remains fully in force
- All current rules will remain as-is EXCEPT for the following requirement:

Diaper-age children & incontinent persons must wear a swim diaper or equivalent at all times for water quality and health reasons.

YARD Sales/MOVING Sales/ESTATE Sales Policy

The Board of Directors voted and approved the following guidelines for sales in our community.

NO Yard Sales - NO Moving Sales

Estate Sale (only following death on homeowner(s)) will be (1) Allowed one day only with prior BOD approval (2) BOD must be given 14 day notice in writing requesting a date for the sale prior to scheduling sale so this does not conflict with other activities being conducted in the park (such as mowing of park) (3) Yard sign will ONLY be at location of sale (4) A sign may be posted on the CH Bulletin board for 7 days prior to the sale and announced at Coffee Hour on Wednesday before the scheduled sale (5) No items will be allowed outside the house except outdoor furniture or vehicle (6)The person conducting the Estate Sale will be responsible for seeing that no driveways are blocked and no one is parked on the grass. The person conducting the sale will accept responsibility for any damage done to the private property or common element of the community.

Almost everyone attended coffee was standing! Of course, successful events also include the residents who purchase tickets and attend each event. We are Briar Creek strong!



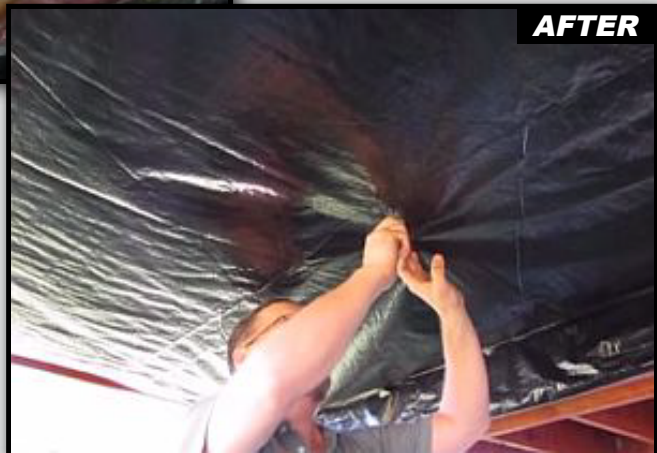

The Briar Creek water committee in Phase II would like to inform you of many ways to prevent you from having any problems in your homes as well as preventing excessive water use.

Do you know where your water shutoff is located outside your home? If not, you can call someone on the water committee and they could help you find it.

This is important for a couple of reasons:

A. If leaving the house for a day or more, it is wise to turn the water off in case a pipe burst (which has personally happened to us while we were at home).

B. To make sure that your outside shutoff functions properly, you can turn it off and then check if any of the faucets in the house still have running water. If they do then the outside shutoff needs repair or replacement.

Other important items that should be checked and repaired are as follows:

Toilets running, faucets dripping, unusual wet areas in your yard or running into the street.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION REMINDERS

Reprinted from City Scope Volume 28/Issue 2

Yard waste is only collected on Wednesday and in 32-gallon cans or bundles at the curb. Yard waste materials, such as grass clippings and leaves must be placed in unlined garbage cans no larger than 32 gallons. Please do not place recyclable yard waste in the recycling containers or various other totes/containers. **Do not use plastic bags.** All yard waste must be in 32-gallon cans/ or bundles.

Yard waste too bulky to be containerized such as branches and other vegetative materials must be cut into sections no longer than 4 feet in length and 6 inches in diameter, then bundles with twine in arm size manageable bundles. Please do not tape bundles or mix paper or plastic in as this will contaminate the recycling process for the entire load and will result in yard waste not being collected. Piles of yard waste in excess of 1 and a half cubic yards can be collected by special arrangement with the sanitation division.

Any bags of leaves must be placed out on your garbage day with the limit of ten total items.
