



On Friday, September 25, 2020, Governor DeSantis issued an Executive Order moving Florida into "Phase 3" of the Governor's COVID-19 recovery plan. Recently we have begun to receive calls and visits to our office from our seasonal residents as they begin to return to the community. With these recent changes in mind, we want to remind you of some important things as well as announce a change in our restrictions.

To all – Those with respiratory or other health complications or those that live with someone who has health challenges are discouraged from attending social gatherings. We encourage you to continue to follow CDC guidelines. If you or someone you have been around recently has exhibited any of the symptoms associated with the corona virus, PLEASE STAY HOME except to seek necessary medical attention.

Returning Residents—We are happy you are back and look forward to another great, albeit it different, season with you! We ask that you are considerate of others health and well-being when determining when to return to community facilities or rejoin activities. Please be sure that your recent travels or activities do not bring a greater health risk to your friends and neighbors.

Clubhouse—Anytime you visit the clubhouse, we ask that you wear a mask or face covering in compliance with current Pinellas County orders. Additionally, you are required to maintain a 6 ft distance from anyone not of your own household. The clubhouse remains open for resident only use for activities such as cards, billiards, etc. Residents hosting activities must get approval from management prior to hosting the activity and these events will be approved on a case by case basis until further notice.
