acation House Checks The Pinellas County Sheriff's Office offers house checks to homeowners within our community if you are going to be away from your home for an extended period of time. To sign up for this service you need to provide the following information:

- The date you will be leaving and the date of your return (if you are a seasonal resident, please estimate your return).
  - The address for the house check.
  - The homeowner's name.
  - The phone number to reach the homeowner while away.
  - The address of your destination.
  - A phone number and address for a local contact (family member, neighbor, etc.)
- Please share whether or not someone else will have access to your home, if you will leave lights or TV on or on a timer, if you have pets on the premises, and if you have lawn maintenance.

Please call (727) 582-6177 to schedule your house checks.

Report A Crime Tip If you have information about a crime, you may submit a Crime tip anonymously 24 hours a day seven days a week by calling the Pinellas County Sherriff's office at (727) 582-6200. Please provide as much information as possible so the it can be processed as quickly as possible. If you have any concerns about child abuse or elder abuse please call 1-800-96-ABUSE (1-800-962-2873) to report it. Thank you.

<u>Feeding Wildlife</u> Many people enjoy feeding wildlife because it allows them to have close contact with the animals, or because they believe they are helping the animals survive. While seeing wild animals up close can be enjoyable, providing these creatures with a steady, human-supplied food source nearly always leads to problems for both the animals and humans. There are many good reasons **NOT** to feed wildlife including:

- When young wild animals are taught to depend on a human-provided food source, they may not fully develop essential foraging skills.
- Wild animals who are used to being fed by humans commonly lose their fear of people. Animals who are unafraid of people will approach them for food, and are sometimes mistaken as rabid, aggressive or mean, then killed for that behavior. An instinctive wariness of people is important to a wild animal's survival.
- A constant, human-provided food source may attract many more wild animals, to the area than would normally be found there. Who doesn't like a free meal? When food is readily available, animals will gather in abnormally large numbers (food meant for ducks quickly becomes food for squirrels, rats, opossum and racoons). This means that if one animal in



the group has an illness or disease, it can spread throughout the group.

• Reproduction rates may also be affected when an artificial food source is readily available. In the wild, the number of animals being born is often directly related to the amount of natural food available. The number of animals surviving will also depend on how much food is available.

- We commonly receive phone calls from people whose neighbors have been feeding wild animals. Often, the wild animals have become an incredible nuisance. Many people do not think about the neighborhood impact when they start feeding wildlife. Wild animals do not usually discriminate between one person and another, and will often start pestering neighbors. The animals may also cause damage to homes and property because they expect to be fed and have lost their fear of people.
- Enjoy the wildlife, but at a safe distance for both you and the animals.

### **DID'JA KNOW??**

To blue eye pigment exists. Rather, blue-eyed people have little melanin in the front layer of their irises, so their eyes appear some shade of blue via a light scattering effect. The degree depends on their surroundings, and the impact of lighting, as it goes through the eye and reflects out, can be great. And as both lighting and mood changes can cause the pupil to change size, more variation may be seen. Brown-eyed people have melanin in the front and back layers of their irises, so little change is noticeable. I guess Sinatra's nickname was a misnomer.



### Search for Earthlike worlds takes a step forward

Cientists searching for Earthlike worlds beyond the solar system have a new tool: NEAR (Near Earths in the Alpha Cen Region), which began operating in May, will scan the Alpha Centauri system for habitable planets.

NEAR is a thermal coronagraph installed in a telescope in Chile that can block the light of stars and look for heat radiating from worlds in orbit. Alpha Centauri is a three-star system located 4.3 light-years away, the closest system to our world. Astronomers have already discovered planets in the system—an Earth-size planet dubbed Proxima b, orbiting the red dwarf star Proxima Centauri, and a planet candidate circling the same star.

NEAR will look at Alpha Centauri AB, a binary star system, using an upgrade to an existing instrument to block out the glare of the two stars and also compensate for the blur of Earth's own atmosphere. It's capable of spotting planets twice the size of Earth or larger.
