n March 16th at 10:00 AM, a representative from the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office, Deputy Webb, made a presentation to the residents of Caribbean Isles about neighborhood safety and the role of the Sheriff's Office.

He suggested that any concerns regarding people or activities in our area be reported to the Sheriff's Office. He offered stickers and brochures with a special phone number. The number 727-582-6200 is for non-emergency calls.

There was open discussion about some of the concerns of the residents and the general level of safety in the park. Deputy Webb suggested that if you have any doubts to contact the Sheriff's Office and do not confront a person or situation. Also, if an enforcement helicopter is flying in the neighborhood or overhead, please turn on your exterior lighting because the light helps locate people.

The Committee for the 4th Annual Charity Golf Outing to benefit the Wounded Warriors Project would like to thank all the residents of Caribbean Isles, Boca Ciega, their families, friends, and acquaintances for contributing to the activities of the Outing, which was held April 3rd, 2016 at Largo Golf Course. We had 10 4-person teams participating and combining the proceeds from the outing, the 50/50, and the wine and liquor basket raffles, we were able to raise \$1100.00 for the project. The winners of the baskets were: Wine Basket #1 – Jim Pietrocarlo from Lot 331, Wine & Liquor Basket #2 – Richard & Linda Hickson from Lot 122, and Liquor Basket #3- Henry Sbrogliaenrico from unit 179. Once again all basket winners were from Caribbean Isles. In the 4 years of this tournament's existence, we have contributed \$4,000 to the project. This year, the Committee decided to award the contribution to a local Wounded Warrior endeavor, the Wounded Warrior Abilities Ranch located in Pinellas Park. This project was started by a wounded warrior from that city, a Sgt. Mike DeLancey who was wounded by sniper fire in Iraq and lost both his legs. The project is taking a different tack in rehabilitation by stressing physical and mental activities to get these warriors back into normal life. Scheduled to open in 2017, it will feature fishing ponds, kayaking, wheelchair sports, a memorial garden, and private areas for meditation and visitation. 




