Dhone Directory – We expect the new phone directories to arrive this MANAGER month. The Business Office will send out an email blast when they arrive.

Rules Reminder – Item 20(F) the Declaration of Master Occupancy Agreement pertains to alterations to the units. It reads, "The Unit Owner shall not, without first obtaining the written consent of the corporation, alter the unit in any way or add to the mobile home presently located upon the unit or any of its fixtures and appurtenances. The unit owner shall not change the color of the mobile home located on the unit, or substantially alter its outward appearance without first having obtained the approval thereof from the Directors."

Seasonal Residents – Before you leave Florida to return to your summer residence, please ensure you put away all items that are on your carport and patio and turn off your water. If you are unsure about how to turn off your water, call the office and we will have someone assist you. Items left on the carports can become missiles during a hurricane or tornado. Also ensure your home is clean and free of mold and mildew and that your gutters are clean.

Sign Out – When you leave the community for more than a couple of weeks, please, stop in the office and sign out so we can update your record and ensure your mail is delivered to the correct address.

Walkers – Please wear light color clothing when you are walking or bike riding in the community during the evening hours.

One Source Training – We will be conducting training on how to use One Source on Thursday, April 9th at 1:30 PM in the clubhouse. Once you know your way around One Source, you will be able to fill out a Work Order, an Architectural Request Form, an Action Request Form, view Minutes of Board Meetings, review the Financial Report and more.

Board of Directors – There will be a Board of Directors Meeting at 10:30 AM and a Town Hall Meeting at 7:00 PM on April 15th. Both meetings will be held in the clubhouse.

o these three letters mean anything to you other than a barking dog? They used to scare me, but not any more now that I know more about them. They stand for Action Request Form. This is a form that has many purposes and is required if you want any action taken. The Office can't fix or address a problem or complaint if they don't have the request in writing. Some examples are:

- If you see something anywhere around the common areas of the park that requires repair, maintenance, clean-up etc., submit an ARF.
- If you see a speeding car and can identify it, submit an ARF.
- If you see something that violates the rules, i.e., motorcycle, unknown people using the facilities, improper use of facilities etc., submit an ARF
- If you see something praiseworthy, submit an ARF. We like to hear the positives as well.
- DO NOT confront or go after people you don't know. Instead:
- 1. Call the Office 727-544-8111
- 2. Call RPM after hours 727-581-2662 and leave a message
- 3. Call Police Non-Emergency, if appropriate 727-541-0758

The Action Request Form is available from the office, on the Clearwater Cascade website (www.clearwatercascade.com), or on One Source, which can also be accessed from the CCHOA section on the website. Go to the website and click the CCHOA tab on the right. Under FORMS you may select an Action Request Form, a Sign-In form or a Sign-Out Form. When prompted, enter the user name and password. If you call the office, they will give these to you. You may also select One Source and again the office can assist you in setting up a user name and password to use this site. These forms can be filled in online and emailed to cwcadmin@ resourcepropertymgmt.com, or printed and taken to the office. The Office staff will then record it in One Source and ensure it gets to the appropriate person or committee. Due to the sudden cancellation of events and the departure of many of the Snowbirds, this form will be included in the Chronicle at a later time. Thank you for your understanding.

Attention Canadians



Do id you know that if you are present in the U.S. (for approximately 4 months of the calendar year), you are required to file a form with the IRS proving that you have a closer connection to another country, thereby eliminating you from the possibility of paying U.S. income tax. The form required is Form 8840 Closer Connection Exemption Statement for Aliens. They are available at the office. There is a calculation to be done detailing your days in the U.S. over the past 3 years. Each individual is required to fill one out.
