Boost your creativity when social distancing

The stress of dealing with the COVID-19 pandemic can make it hard to stay creative, especially when you're social distancing. Working from home means you don't have your co-workers to bounce ideas off. The Entrepreneur website shares some exercises for keeping your mind and imagination fresh and active:



- Freewriting. Sit down at your keyboard and just write whatever comes into your head. Don't stop, don't edit, don't worry about punctuation or grammar, just let the words flow. If you're lucky, you'll generate ideas. Even if you don't, you'll loosen up your brain so you can go back to work with an open mind.
- **Time tracking.** Turn your everyday tasks into a game. How quickly can you finish that report? Challenge yourself to do something in less time than you usually use. Use a timer to stay focused.
- **Mindstorming.** When you've got a problem to solve, write it down and then quickly generate 20 possible solutions. The first four or five will probably come easily, but don't stop until you've hit 20. This will stretch your mind and force you to be more creative. You'll also gain confidence when you succeed.
- **Sketchnoting.** Don't limit yourself to words. When searching for ideas or trying to solve a problem, try drawing pictures. This can put you in touch with the other side of your brain and lead to different solutions.

Charity in the time of the coronavirus

The *Reader's Digest* website shares the story of Andrea Pien, a 33-year-old college counselor at a high school in San Francisco. As a salaried worker, she doesn't expect to be missing paychecks. And as someone who enjoys inherited wealth from her father's successes in the biotech industry, she believes it's important to give back—especially when times are tough. One Sunday, she posted this message on Nextdoor:



If money is short, message me. Hi neighbors, if you will be missing a paycheck/contract work, or if money is tight for food and supplies, message me your Venmo @ and I will send you 20 dollars, no questions asked. She included a picture of her "very large dog," Gus.

"Part of being a good ally is supporting my neighbors who maybe don't have the same privilege I do," she told Reader's Digest. "I added a picture of my dog for the algorithm [to ensure people see the post in their feeds], and because a lot of neighbors recognize my dog because it's large."

So far, she has given away about \$400 to her neighbors and anticipates more to come.

How the outbreak affects spending

The COVID-19 outbreak has changed how we spend money, according to PR Newswire. A survey of 4,859 consumers across the United States, the United Kingdom, Canada, France, and Germany, conducted by the EY Future Consumer Index, has identified four distinct groups of shoppers during the time of the pandemic:




- Save and stockpile. In the largest category, 35.1% feel pessimistic about the future and are conserving funds and stocking up on supplies.
- Cut deep. In this group, 27.3% are spending less across all categories as the pandemic affects employment.
- Stay calm, carry on. This is 26.2%—people who are continuing to spend as they normally have.
- Hibernate and spend. This group—11.4%—are actually spending more in every expense category.

Forty-two percent expect their shopping and spending habits to change fundamentally due to the outbreak. Still, 34% say they would pay more for local products, 25% for trusted brands, and 23% for ethical products.





Ancient footprints point to ancient lives

Scientists have discovered more than 400 ancient footprints in hardened volcanic sediment in east Africa. As the Science News website reports, the footprints may provide a look into the social of lives of hunter-gatherers who lived some 10,000–12,000 years ago in the region.





The footprints were found in northern Tanzania and are the largest collection of ancient human footprints ever found in Africa. One set of tracks was made by a group of 17 people walking southwest—14 women, two men and one young boy. Researchers speculate that the women were foraging for food as the males visited them. Some present-day hunter-gatherers form largely female food-gathering groups, scientists say. It's unknown whether they were gathering plants or hunting prey.

Another set of footprints show six tracks heading northeast. Instead of people traveling in a group, they were probably one man and two women walking slowly together, a woman and a man walking briskly, and another woman running—presumably at different times.

Moon rocks created by high impact

giant meteor may have wiped out the dinosaurs on Earth, but another one may have formed the crust of the moon.


According to the Science Daily website, recent analysis of the rock brought back from the lunar surface by Apollo 17 in 1972 found that it was formed at very



high temperatures—higher than 4,300 degrees Fahrenheit—that happens only when an object melts the outer layer of a planet in a large impact. This suggests that large impacts more than 4 billion years ago could have created the wide, complex range of rocks on the surface of the moon today.



"Rocks on Earth are constantly being recycled, but the moon doesn't exhibit plate tectonics or volcanism, allowing older rocks to be preserved," says one scientist. "By studying the moon, we can better understand the earliest history of our planet. If large, super-heated impacts were creating rocks on the moon, the same process was probably happening here on Earth."
