

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH IS - YOU

OU AND I are Neighborhood Watch! That's just how it is and the way it should be. Neighbors looking out for neighbors. This means taking responsibility for ourselves and doing what we can to protect what we have. Sometimes that's easier said than done.

We like to have pretty things in our yards but unfortunately others seem to like our things too and are brazen enough to just walk up and take them away; sometimes even digging them out of the ground. I've known of bikes being stolen from carports, fishing poles taken off of porches, sheds opened and things removed and other things that I can't think of at the moment.

After reading Police Reports and talking to some of the Police Officers, I know that this is not specific to our park and not just to Pinellas Park. It happens everywhere. If it's not locked up, chained to something unmovable or cemented into the ground there is the potential of it being stolen.

That's why we all need to be vigilant. That's why we need to watch out for our neighbors and they need to watch out for us! We all have different schedules. Some of us are up late; some of us are up super early. There's always someone who can be watching. We need each other and we need to be ready to report anything that we see that looks out of place or someone acting strangely.

Don't worry that a suspicious person or vehicle will be long gone by the time the Police arrive: If you give a good description and a possible direction that they were going, they may still be located outside of the park. Either way, there will be something on record to show why the Police were called.

If there is a speeder that drives through at a regular time each day, report that information. The Police will be waiting for them when the speeder goes through the next time.

The new catch-phrase is: If you see something...Do Something. Don't just question it in your head: Is that Meat Truck supposed to be in the park? CALL! Why is that person using a flashlight in my neighbor's carport? CALL! Why do I keep seeing those 3 men walking through the park wearing back packs? CALL! My neighbor isn't home but someone is on her porch? CALL! Why is that person looking into my neighbor's car? CALL!

PICK UP YOUR PHONE and call the Police. (727-369-7864) They want you to do this! They need to be reminded that they are needed here, even to patrol unexpectedly, at any time day or night. In this way, we will have an ongoing Police presence and awareness.

Get in the habit of locking up your bike as soon as you get off of it.

Lock your car when you get out of it. Remove your purse, keys, and your GPS and clean any suction cup marks off of the windshield.

When you walk out of your house, even to walk your dog, grab your little poo bag for the dog and your keys and lock up your house.





RECIPES

Polenta in the Microwave

If you like grits, you'll love this.

Ingredients

1 cup water

1/4 cup coarse ground cornmeal

Pinch salt

1 teaspoon olive oil, optional

Milk, optional


Instructions

- 1. Mix the water, cornmeal, salt, and olive oil, if using. Put the bowl, uncovered, in the microwave, and set the microwave for 5 minutes on HIGH.
- 2. Halfway through cooking, take the polenta out of the microwave and stir thoroughly. Add a drizzle of milk, if desired. Put the bowl back in the microwave and finish the cooking time. Check at 5 minutes; it should be getting rather thick. (It will thicken even more as it cools.)
- 3. Eat with a little more milk, plus brown sugar and walnuts or topped with a poached egg!

Additional Notes:

• Microwaves range in power, of course. My polenta was perfectly done after 5 minutes, but check it halfway through cooking. If it is already thickening rapidly you may want to only cook it for a minute more.





Pesto Tortellini Pasta Salad

Serves 8 to 10 as a side

- 2 (9-ounce) packages fresh cheese tortellini
- 2 pints cherry tomatoes (about 4 cups), halved
- 1 (12-ounce) jar fire-roasted red peppers, drained and chopped (1 heaping cup)
- 1/3 cup basil pesto
- 1. Bring a large pot of salted water to a boil and cook the tortellini according to package instructions. Drain and run briefly under cool water to cool the tortellini down. Drain well.
- 2. Place the cooked tortellini, tomatoes, and peppers in a large bowl and toss to combine. Add the pesto and toss to combine.

<u>Notes</u> - Storage: Store the salad in an airtight container in the refrigerator for up to 3 days. Let sit at room temperature 30 minutes to take the chill off before serving.

3 Ingredient Shortbread

Ingredients

- 1 cup butter
- 1 cup sugar (best if very fine)
- 1 ³/₄ cup all -purpose flour
- 1. Preheat oven to 180°C. Line 2 baking trays with baking paper and set aside.
- 2. In a bowl, using a mixer, cream the butter and sugar.
- 3. Add a little of the flour at a time with the mixer running until it is all combined.
- 4. Roll teaspoon-sized balls and place on the baking tray. Use a fork to push them down gently. Make sure that they are spaced out well on the tray as the biscuit will spread during baking.
- 5. Bake for 15-17 minutes. Leave to cool on a tray and store in an airtight container when cooled.


Notes:

These biscuits are very buttery and delicate. If you want a sturdier biscuit, add an additional ¼ cup of flour to make them heavier.

This mixture makes a LOT of biscuits. They really spread out on the tray so you may need to bake a few batches or even halve the mixture.



New moon discovered around distant dwarf

The solar system is a little bit larger these days. Makemake is slightly smaller than Pluto, another dwarf planet, and is covered by a layer of frozen methane.

According to the Sci-News website, the moon, nicknamed MK2, is approximately 100 miles around and orbits close to 13,000 miles above Makemake. Astronomers discovered it after examining observations from the Hubble made in 2015. Astronomers believe that it is the product of a collision between Makemake and another celestial object or was captured by Makemake billions of years ago.




