#### NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH MEETING REPORT

The Fifth Neighborhood Watch meeting was held on Monday, October 19, 2015 celebrating the Third Anniversary of the Crystal Lake Neighborhood Watch. At the meeting we had a guest speaker: Anna Marie Millet, Consumer Fraud Investigator for Pinellas County Justice & Consumer Services.

She specializes in educating consumers in regards to hiring of contractors, investigating crimes against consumers and providing dispute resolutions. She is also a certified Florida Supreme Court mediator.

Ms. Millet gave a full explanation on how to protect yourself from those who prey on unsuspecting people, especially senior citizens. She said to never open your door to anyone you don't know and to speak through the door. Solicitors come through the park every so often to sell magazines or even meat from the back of a truck. If they knock on your door, tell them that soliciting is not allowed in our park and then call the office to report them.

Phone scammers will call to inform you have won a big prize or that someone in your family or someone that you know is in trouble and needs your help. Then they ask for your information and may even show up at your door.

She warned of Foreign Lottery scams – Don't even talk to them. They want your money and your personal information so they can get your money.

There are online scams that are sent through your email and that you should never click on any link if you don't know who it came from... even then be cautious. And never click on a link that appears to be from your own email address. Clicking on any suspicious link

It sure would be nice to see more community interest at these meetings especially for such an important topic. We could do more to protect ourselves and being aware is one of the biggest things.

The Neighborhood Watch consists of the participation of EVERY resident in our park who wants to feel protected and take a part in making Crystal Lake a safer place to live. There are many ways in which you can help. This is a partial list of things you can do:

a) Be a Watch Captain - Collect information from patrols in your designated area, remind people in your area about meetings and encourage them to attend.

b) Be a Street-Patroller - make a note of anything you see that seems suspicious on your daily walks such as unidentified vehicles (We're looking into getting decals for authorized cars), people walking or biking through looking into carports or walking between houses, etc.

c) Be a Window Watcher - Be more observant and take a minute or two to make a note of anything you see on your street that just doesn't look right. Save this information for your Watch Captain to deliver to the Coordinator for record-keeping or any necessary action.

So you see there's something for everyone to do to have a part in keeping our park safer and always remember: If you see something suspicious, pick up the phone and call the Pinellas Park Police Department at (727) 541-0758.



#### SWISS STEAKS

Prep Time: 20 minutes Total Time: 4 hours, 20 minutes

Cook Time: 4 hours Yield: 5 servings

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 1 can (14 ounce) petite diced tomatoes (double this if you like a lot of sauce)
- 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1 green bell pepper, diced
- 1 large yellow onion, diced
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 teaspoon dried thyme
- 1 + 1/2 pounds round steaks
- Sea salt and fresh black pepper
- Flour

#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

#### **Crockpot Directions:**

1. Mix tomatoes, Worcestershire, peppers, onion, garlic and thyme together in crock pot and season well with salt and pepper. Season each side of the steaks with salt and pepper and prick with a fork all over about an inch apart. {An optional step is to dredge the steaks with flour and sear in a frying pan with a tablespoon or two of oil over medium-high heat on each side.} Add to crock pot. Cook on high 4-5 hours or low 7-8. Serve with cooked rice, potatoes, or pasta.

#### **Oven Directions:**

2. Preheat oven to 325 degrees F. Follow the same directions above using a Dutch oven, roast about 2 hours until steak is tender and falling apart.

#### **ON-THE-GO BREAKFAST MUFFINS**

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 pound bulk Italian sausage
- 7 eggs
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 3 teaspoons baking powder

- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup 2% milk
- 1/2 cup canola oil
- 1 cup (4 ounces) shredded cheddar cheese, divided

#### **Directions**

- 1. Preheat oven to 400°. In a large nonstick skillet, cook sausage over medium heat 6-8 minutes or until no longer pink, breaking into crumbles. Remove with a slotted spoon; drain on paper towels. Wipe skillet clean.
- 2. In a small bowl, whisk five eggs. Pour into same skillet; cook and stir over medium heat until thickened and no liquid egg remains. Remove from heat.
- 3. In a large bowl, whisk flour, sugar, baking powder and salt. In another bowl, whisk remaining eggs, milk and oil until blended. Add to flour mixture; stir just until moistened. Fold in 2/3 cup cheese, sausage and scrambled eggs.
- 4. Fill greased or paper-lined muffin cups three-fourths full. Sprinkle tops with remaining cheese. Bake 12-15 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 5 minutes before removing from pans to wire racks. Serve warm.

Freeze option: Freeze cooled muffins in re-sealable plastic freezer bags. To use, microwave each muffin on high for 45-60 seconds or until heated through. Yield: 1-1/2 dozen.



If you are giving out of a sense of loyalty you are acting from solidarity, not generosity.


