FMO: FEDERATION OF MANUFACTURED HOME OWNERS OF FLORIDA, INC.

That is the difference between the terms "HOA" and "FMO"?

HOA: The HOA is the local "governing body" of the community. It is a homeowners' association, created under Chapter 723, Florida Statutes, for the specific purpose of either purchasing the community on behalf of the residents and/or representing the community on behalf of disputes between management and the residents.

FMO: The **FMO** is the <u>statewide organization</u> that lobbies for and defends your rights as a mobile/manufactured home owner in Florida. We assist in the training, and offer advice, for the HOA officers and directors in a community. The FMO does not assist with or interfere in the governing of the community. That is left up to the community HOA.

FMO needs your help. If FMO is to continue fighting for your rights and protecting your lifestyle, we must keep our membership numbers high. That is what gives FMO clout with legislators and other government officials.


FRIDAY NIGHT SNACK BAR

DIRECTIONS






KETO CLOUD BREAD ("OOPSIE BREAD")

This low carb cloud bread (also called "oopsie bread") has only four ingredients, is ketofriendly and only has less than half a gram of net carbs in it.

Makes 10 pieces

INGREDIENTS

- 3 eggs, room temperature
- 3 tbsp cream cheese, softened
- 1/4 tsp cream of tartar
- 1/4 tsp salt



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 300 degrees and line two baking sheets with parchment paper.
- 2. Carefully separate egg whites from yolks. Place whites in one bowl and yolks in another.
- 3. In the bowl of egg yolks, add cream cheese and mix together with a hand mixer until well-combined.
- 4. In the bowl of egg whites, add cream of tartar and salt. Using a hand mixer, mix together at high speed until stiff peaks form.
- 5. Pouring slowly, add yolk mixture to egg whites and carefully fold in until there are no white streaks.
- 6. Spoon mixture onto prepared baking sheet about ½ to ¾ inches tall and about 5 inches apart.
- 7. Bake in oven on middle rack for 30 minutes, until tops are lightly golden.

Allow to cool (they will likely be too crumbly directly out of the oven) and enjoy!

CRISP BEAN BURRITOS

Makes 5 Burritos

INGREDIENTS

- 5 (6-inch) flour tortillas
- 1 (16 ounce) can refried beans (can use fat free)
- 1 cup sharp cheddar cheese, shredded (can use low fat)
- 1 cup vegetable oil (if you plan to fry them)


Instructions

- 1. Heat the oil in a 12-inch skillet over medium heat. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F.
- 2. Lay tortillas out on a flat surface. Spread 1/3 cup refried beans onto the center of the latortilla. Sprinkle with 2-3 tablespoons of cheese. Roll tortilla up; keeping ends open. Repeat with remaining tortillas, beans and cheese.
- 3. Lay 2 burritos into the skillet and fry for 30 seconds or so until golden brown. Flip onto other side and fry another 30 seconds. Lay fried burritos onto a paper-towel lined plate. Repeat frying process with all burritos.
- 4. Place fried burritos onto a cookie sheet. Place in the preheated oven and bake for 5-10 minutes. Serve burritos with salsa, sour cream and guacamole! Enjoy ♥

Notes

You can skip the frying step if being health conscience. Once you've rolled up the burritos, place on a cookie sheet. Spray the tops of the burritos with cooking spray. Bake burritos for 10-15 minutes, or until golden brown.

OVERNIGHT BLUEBERRY FRENCH TOAST

"This is a very unique breakfast dish. Good for any holiday breakfast or brunch, it's filled with the fresh taste of blueberries, and covered with a rich blueberry sauce to make it a one of a kind."


INGREDIENTS

- 12 slices day-old bread, cut into 1-inch cubes
- 2 (8 ounce) packages cream cheese, cut into 1-inch cubes
- 1 cup fresh blueberries
- 12 eggs, beaten
- 2 cups milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/3 cup maple syrup
- 1 cup white sugar
- 2 tablespoons cornstarch
- 1 cup water
- 1 cup fresh blueberries
- 1 tablespoon butter

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Lightly grease a 9x13 inch baking dish. Arrange half the bread cubes in the dish, and top with cream cheese cubes. Sprinkle 1 cup blueberries over the cream cheese, and top with remaining bread cubes.
- 2. In a large bowl, mix the eggs, milk, vanilla extract, and syrup. Pour over the bread cubes. Cover, and refrigerate overnight.
- 3. Remove the bread cube mixture from the refrigerator about 30 minutes before baking. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
- 4. Cover, and bake 30 minutes. Uncover, and continue baking 25 to 30 minutes, until center is firm, and surface is lightly browned.
- 5. In a medium saucepan, mix the sugar, cornstarch, and water. Bring to a boil. Stirring constantly, cook 3 to 4 minutes. Mix in the remaining 1 cup blueberries. Reduce heat, and simmer 10 minutes, until the blueberries burst. Stir in the butter, and pour over the baked French toast



RECIPES

Best Sweet Potato Casserole

Ingredients

- 4 cups sweet potato peeled & cubed
- 1/2 cup white sugar
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 4 tablespoons butter softened
- 1/2 cup milk

Directions

- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/3 cup all-purpose flour
- 3 tablespoons butter softened
- 1/2 cup chopped pecans
- 1. Preheat oven to 325 degrees F (165 degrees C). Put sweet potatoes in a medium saucepan with water to cover. Cook over medium high heat until tender; drain and mash.
- 2. In a large bowl, mix together the sweet potatoes, white sugar, eggs, salt, butter, milk and vanilla extract. Mix until smooth. Transfer to a 9x13 inch baking dish.
- 3. In medium bowl, mix the brown sugar and flour. Cut in the butter until the mixture is coarse. Stir in the pecans. Sprinkle the mixture over the sweet potato mixture.
- 4. Bake in the preheated oven 30 minutes, or until the topping is lightly brown.

3-INGREDIENT SHORTBREAD COOKIES

Ingredients

- 1 cup butter
- 1 cup sugar (best if very fine)
- 1 ³/₄ cup all -purpose flour


Instructions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 180°C. Line 2 baking trays with baking paper and set aside.
- 2. In a bowl, using a mixer, cream the butter and sugar.
- 3. Add a little of the flour at a time with the mixer running until it is all combined.
- 4. Roll teaspoon-sized balls and place on the baking tray. Use a fork to push them down gently. Make sure that they are spaced out well on the tray as the biscuit will spread during baking.
- 5. Bake for 15-17 minutes. Leave to cool on a tray and store in an airtight container when cooled.

Notes: These biscuits are very buttery and delicate. If you want a sturdier biscuit, add an additional ½ cup of flour to make them heavier.

This mixture makes a LOT of biscuits. They really spread out on the tray, so you may need to bake a few batches or even halve the mixture.

BANANA BREAD in a RICE COOKER

Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 cups enriched white flour
- 3/4 cups white sugar
- 2 tsp. baking powder
- 1/2 tsp. baking soda
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1 cup mashed ripe bananas (2 to 3 bananas)
- 1/3 cups softened butter
- 1/4 cups milk
- 1 egg
- Cooking oil

For extra sweetness, substitute a portion of white sugar for an equal amount of packed brown sugar. Or, add 1/2 tsp. of vanilla extract along with the wet ingredients.

Directions:

- 1. In a large mixing bowl, combine the flour, sugar, baking powder, baking soda and salt. Whisk until the ingredients are well mixed.
- 2. Next, add the bananas, butter, milk, and egg. These should be mixed until the batter has a uniform and thick, creamy consistency. If you own an electric mixer, let it do the work (low setting recommended). If not, the bananas and butter may give you some difficulty when hand-mixing it. To make things easier, make sure you let the butter soften long enough beforehand. Also, if you put the bananas into a plastic freezer bag, you can make sure they're well-mashed without making a huge mess.
- 3. At this point, you can stir in any other ingredient you may want, like chopped nuts or a bit of dried fruit. Feel free to try out your own variations on the recipe!
- 4. Before pouring the batter into the rice cooker's pot, remember the most important step! Coat the inside of the pot lightly with cooking oil. Paper towels help to spread it properly. Otherwise, the banana bread will stick to the inside as it cooks.
- 5. Now simply pour the batter evenly into the pot and start the cooker. I use the same settings as when I make rice. On my rice cooker, the bread isn't done after just one cycle, so I let it run twice, though this could vary based on your rice cooker. With mine, I have to allow the cooker to cool down for a few minutes in between cycles, as it won't start again right away.

That's it! After it's done, pop the bread out onto a serving tray or plate and enjoy!
