FMO: FEDERATION OF MANUFACTURED HOME OWNERS OF FLORIDA, INC.

What is the difference between the terms "HOA" and "FMO"?

HOA: The HOA is the local "governing body" of the community. It is a homeowners' association, created under Chapter 723, Florida Statutes, for the specific purpose of either purchasing the community on behalf of the residents and/or representing the community on behalf of disputes between management and the residents.

FMO: The FMO is the statewide organization that lobbies for and defends your rights as a mobile/manufactured home owner in Florida. We assist in the training, and offer advice, for the HOA officers and directors in a community. The FMO does not assist with or interfere in the governing of the community. That is left up to the community HOA.

FMO needs your help. If FMO is to continue fighting for your rights and protecting your lifestyle, we must keep our membership numbers high. That is what gives FMO clout with legislators and other government officials.




Roasted Broccoli with Parmesan

Ingredients

- 1 ½ lbs. Broccoli cut into florets
- 3-4 Tbsp of Olive Oil
- 1 Tbsp lemon juice

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 425 degrees
- 2. Lightly oil baking sheet
- 3. Toss Broccoli with Olive Oil, lemon juice, salt & pepper
- 4. Spread in single layer on baking sheet and bake/roast for approximately 16-20 minutes. The browned bits are the best. Test with fork to check for doneness.
- 5. When done, toss in a bowl with lots of black pepper and Parmesan Cheese.

Quiche Lorraine I

Ingredients

- 1 recipe pastry for a 9-inch single crust pie
- 6 slices bacon
- 1 onion, chopped
- 3 eggs, beaten

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 450 degrees F (230 degrees C).
- 2. Line pastry with a double layer of aluminum foil. Bake in preheated oven for 8 minutes. Remove foil and bake for 4 to 5 minutes more, or until crust is set. Reduce oven temperature to 325 degrees F (165 degrees C).
- 3. Place bacon in a large, deep skillet. Cook over medium high heat until evenly brown. Remove bacon from pan, crumble and set aside. Reserve 2 tablespoons bacon grease in skillet. Cook onion in reserved drippings until tender; drain and set aside.
- 4. In a large bowl, mix together eggs, milk and salt. Stir in bacon and onion. In a separate bowl, toss cheese and flour together. Add cheese to egg mixture; stir well. Pour mixture into hot pastry shell.
- 5. Bake in preheated oven for 35 to 40 minutes, or until knife inserted into center comes out clean. If necessary, cover edges of crust with foil to prevent burning. Let quiche cool for 10 minutes before serving.

Date Nut Bread Baked in A Can

Ingredients

- 5 clean, empty 12-ounce cans
- 1 cup (8-ounce pkg) diced dates
- 3/4 cup raisins
- 1 tsp baking soda

- 1 cup boiling water
- 2 Tbsp soft butter
- 1 cup sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla

- 1 1/2 cups milk1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 1/2 cups shredded Swiss cheese
- 1 tablespoon all-purpose flour

- 1 egg
- 1 1/3 cups flour
- 3/4 cup chopped walnuts or pecans

Instructions

- 1. Place dates and raisins in bowl. Add soda and boiling water. Cover and let stand.
- 2. Cream butter and sugar. Add vanilla, then egg, and beat well. Add flour, mix until moistened. Pour in fruit mixture, including liquid, and pecans, and mix gently to prevent crushing the fruits.
- 3. Generously grease cans, being very careful not to cut yourself on top of can.
- 4. Turn dough into prepared cans, filling each 2/3 full of dough, pressing down with spoon. Place cans on a baking sheet and cover tops of cans with inverted, greased baking sheet.
- 5. Bake at 325 degrees for 45 minutes, or until bread tests done.
- 6. Slice thin and serve with whipped cream cheese made by whipping a few tablespoons of milk with cream cheese.





Many of us use our streets to take walks or visit with each other.


Someone could be injured, and it would be a needless tragedy. Please be courteous to everyone, and slow down. There is no reason to use excessive speed inside our community.


