RECIPES:

Baked Sweet Potato Fries

Ingredients:

- 3 large sweet potatoes
- 2 tablespoons corn meal
- 3 tablespoons olive oil, divided
- 1 tablespoon ground cinnamon
- salt and fresh cracked pepper, to taste


Directions:

- Preheat oven to 425 degrees. Line a large cookie sheet with non-stick aluminum foil.
- Peel sweet potatoes and slice into fries. You want fries to be as even in width as possible for even cooking.
- Place sweet potatoes in one of those giant size zip-locks and drizzle in 2 tablespoons olive
- oil. Shake like crazy to evenly coat. Then sprinkle in the corn meal and shake, shake, shake it!
- Drizzle in the last tablespoon of olive oil, and sprinkle in the cinnamon, salt, and pepper. Again shake it like your life depends on it.
- Lay out the sweet potatoes in a single layer and bake 25-30 minutes, flipping half way through. Serve immediately.

SPEED LIMIT



patties in a Crockpot. They can overlap. Combine soup and mixed gravy. Pour over patties. Cook on low for 4-6 hours until patties are cooked through.

- I just pour the flour onto a plate, lay the patty in it and dredge on each side.
- You could replace the gravy mix with about 1 cup leftover roast gravy.

Soft Chocolate Chip Cookies

2 1/4 cups all-purpose flour

1 (3-4 oz.) package instant vanilla pudding mix

1 tsp. baking soda 1/2 tsp. salt 1 cup butter, softened 3/4 cup brown sugar 1/4 cup white sugar 1 egg 1 egg yolk 1 tsp. vanilla 1 1/2 cups semisweet ch



1 1/2 cups semisweet chocolate chips

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Cream butter and sugars together. Add the eggs and vanilla. Add flour, pudding mix, baking soda and salt.* Whisk lightly. Then beat in with wet ingredients. Fold in chocolate chips. With spoon or cookie scoop, drop on greased cookie sheets. Bake about 10-12 minutes or until the edges are just set and light brown. The middles will still be puffy. Let cool on a baking sheet a couple of minutes before removing.

• To save time and an extra bowl, I place all the dry ingredients, starting with the flour, on top of the beaten wet ingredients. I take a fork or whisk and lightly fluff the dry ingredients right there in the same bowl. Then I take the mixer and continue beating wet and dry together. I do this often when a recipe says to whisk dry ingredients in a separate bowl.

KITCHEN TIPS

How long should you keep frozen foods?

Whether you're buying meat in bulk or freezing leftovers for later, check out these guide lines to maintain the best taste, texture and freshness.

- Ground Beef 3-4 months
- Uncooked roasts 8-12 months
- Uncooked poultry 9-12 months
- Soups or Stews 2-3 months
- Casseroles 2-3 months
- Meatballs or Meatloaf 2-3 months
- Bread 1-2 months
- Hot Dogs/Lunch Meat opened or unopened 1-2 months
- Bacon/sausage opened or unopened 1-2 months
- Ice cream opened 1-2 months
- Fresh Vegetables or Fruits 5-6 months

DON'T EVER MIX THESE CHEMICALS TOGETHER

ou probably have some of these household cleaners under you sink right now. Mixing certain ones together can cause toxic fumes that are very dangerous.

- Bleach with Acid-based toilet bowl cleaner. When mixed they create toxic fumes.
- Bleach and vinegar together they create a toxic chlorine vapor.
- Bleach with ammonia lethal vapors which can irritate the eyes and can be dangerous when inhaled.
- Bleach and rubbing alcohol
- Window cleaner and all-purpose cleaner
- Two types of drain cleaner if one doesn't work don't try using another. Mixing different products can create the chemical chlorine gas.

Here's an example of what can happen if you combine any of these chemicals. My mother was cleaning the garage floor and without realizing it mixed some volatile chemicals. Even though the garage was well ventilated, the fumes were immediate; she lost consciousness and fell to the floor breaking her jaw and eye socket. If a neighbor hadn't come by to visit, we could have lost her that day. It's best to be safe and never combine household cleaners.



Water and Swimming Safety

From the Red Cross

A recent Red Cross survey found that eight out of ten Americans are planning water activities such as going to the beach, pool, water park or boating or fishing this summer. A third (32 percent) of all Americans plan to swim at a place without a lifeguard. The Red Cross has launched an anti-drowning campaign this summer that promotes swim lessons and safe swimming. If a trip to the beach is part of someone's plans, the Red Cross has ten tips that will help beachgoers stay out of harm's way:

- 1. If someone plans to swim in the ocean, they should always check weather conditions before going in the water.
- 2. Swim only at a lifeguard protected beach, within the designated swimming area and listen to all lifeguard instructions.
- 3. Always swim with a buddy and always swim sober.
- 4. Young children and inexperienced swimmers should wear a Coast Guard-approved life jacket.
- 5. Everyone should enter the water feet first if they can't see the bottom or don't know how deep the water is.
