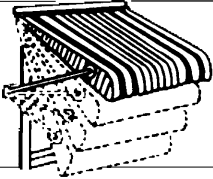

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH IS – YOU

Repeated from the August Courier

YOU AND I are Neighborhood Watch! That's just how it is and the way it should be. Neighbors looking out for neighbors. This means taking responsibility for ourselves and doing what we can to protect what we have. Sometimes that's easier said than done.

We like to have pretty things in our yards but unfortunately others seem to like our things too and are brazen enough to just walk up and take them away; sometimes even digging them out of the ground. I've known of bikes being stolen from carports, fishing poles taken off of porches, sheds opened and things removed and other things that I can't think of at the moment.

After reading Police Reports and talking to some of the Police Officers, I know that this is not specific to our park and not just to Pinellas Park. It happens everywhere. If it's not locked up, chained to something unmovable or cemented into the ground there is the potential of it being stolen.

That's why we all need to be vigilant. That's why we need to watch out for our neighbors and they need to watch out for us! We all have different schedules. Some of us are up late; some of us are up super early. There's always someone who can be watching. We need each other and we need to be ready to report anything that we see that looks out of place or someone acting strangely.

Don't worry that a suspicious person or vehicle will be long gone by the time the Police arrive: If you give a good description and a possible direction that they were going, they may still be located outside of the park. Either way, there will be something on record to show why the Police were called.

If there is a speeder that drives through at a regular time each day, report that information. The Police will be waiting for them when the speeder goes through the next time.

The new catch-phrase is: If you see something...Do Something. Don't just question it in your head: Is that Meat Truck supposed to be in the park? **CALL!** Why is that person using a flashlight in my neighbor's carport? **CALL!** Why do I keep seeing those 3 men walking through the park wearing back packs? **CALL!** My neighbor isn't home but someone is on her porch? **CALL!** Why is that person looking into my neighbor's car? **CALL!**

PICK UP YOUR PHONE and call the Police. **(727-369-7864) They want you to do this!** They need to be reminded that they are needed here, even to patrol unexpectedly, at any time day or night. In this way, we will have an ongoing Police presence and awareness.

Get in the habit of locking up your bike as soon as you get off of it.

Lock your car when you get out of it. Remove your purse, keys, and your GPS and clean any suction cup marks off of the windshield.

When you walk out of your house, even to walk your dog, grab your little poo bag for the dog and your keys and lock up your house.

Be Alert! Be Responsible! Be a good neighbor! Be safe!

Remember that your neighbors are the people who you can hope will be watching out for you, too.

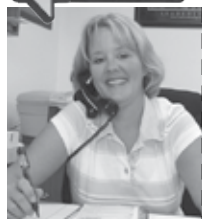

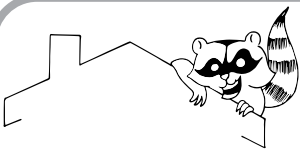

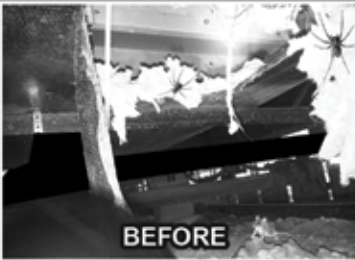

THE AMERICAN FLAG

The American flag is a symbol of freedom, liberty and human rights. It is a symbol of our home and all that we believe in.

The flag is one of the most visible and important symbols of our country, so we should treat it with respect. Here are some things you may or may not know:

The colors of the pales (the vertical stripes) are those used in the **flag** of the United States of **America**; White signifies purity and innocence, Red, hardiness & valour, and Blue, the color of the Chief (the broad band above the stripes) signifies vigilance, perseverance & justice.

The star is a symbol of the heavens and the divine goal to which man has aspired from time immemorial; the stripe is symbolic of the rays of light emanating from the sun.

The American flag does not have to be lowered at sunset as long as it is properly illuminated during the hours of darkness.

The flag should never be used as wearing apparel, bedding, or drapery.

The flag should never touch anything beneath it, such as the ground, the floor, water, or merchandise. There's no rule saying that a flag that slips has to immediately be burned.

The American flag is meant to be a flag; don't use it for any other purpose. For example, don't use it as drapery, a ceiling decoration, or as a bed spread or a window covering. And never use it as a receptacle for carrying or holding anything.

The American flag should never be displayed with the union down (the blue rectangle with the stars), except when used as a signal of dire distress.

The American flag should never touch anything beneath it, such as the ground, the floor, water, or merchandise.

The American flag should never be fastened, displayed, used, or stored so that it might be easily torn, soiled, or damaged in any way.

The American flag should never have anything placed on it.

The American flag should never be used for any advertising purpose, nor embroidered on cushions or handkerchiefs, printed on paper napkins or boxes, nor used as any portion of a costume.

When the flag is in such condition that it is no longer a fitting emblem, it should be destroyed in a dignified way, preferably by burning



RECIPES

3 INGREDIENT APPLE JUICE CHICKEN

Serves: 4

INGREDIENTS

1½ c. 100% unfiltered apple juice, preferably organic
1½ lbs. (or 6 medium) chicken thighs, skinless
salt and pepper

INSTRUCTIONS

Heat a deep pan over medium heat.

Add the juice first and bring to a low boil.

Add in the chicken and sprinkle the meat with salt and pepper.

Lower everything to a simmer and cover the pan, cooking for 15 minutes.

Flip the chicken over.

Partially cover the pan and cook for another 15 minutes.

Pop the lid up so that a significant amount of steam can escape, allowing the apple juice to reduce down and thicken.

Cook for another 10-20 minutes until the juice is thick and syrupy, turning the chicken every 10 minutes or so.

Watch it closely for the last 2-3 minutes, as it can burn quickly.

Remove from heat once the chicken is cooked through and the juice resembles honey in consistency.

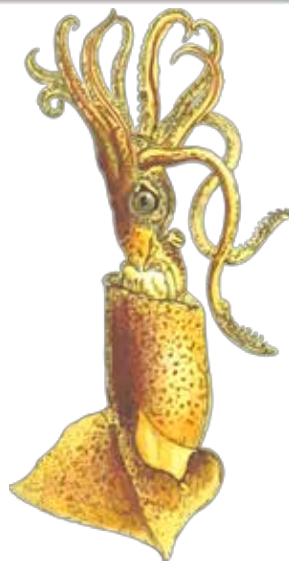

The cephalopods are coming

Don't look now, but cephalopods are on the rise. A team of scientists have determined that cephalopods—sea-dwellers including mollusks, squid, cuttlefish, and octopuses—are increasing their numbers below the waves.

As reported on the Sci-News website, scientists at the University of Adelaide created a database of catch rates for 35 species of cephalopods from 1953 to 2013. They found that cephalopod populations have increased across three distinct groups since the 1950s.

The sea creatures are able to adapt to environmental changes quickly due to their short lifespans, rapid growth, and life-history plasticity. Their growing numbers could have both positive and negative effects: increased pressure on the undersea species they hunt for prey, but also benefits for marine predators who in turn hunt them, as well as humans who harvest them from the sea for food.



Chinese brewed beer in ancient times

Crafts beers are thriving these days, but beer has been around for a long time, scientists say. Researchers in the United States and China have revealed that the Chinese brewed their own beer some 5,000 years ago, much earlier than previously believed.

As reported on the Voice of America website, archaeologists have uncovered brewing equipment in underground rooms in China's central plain region. Traces of ingredients found on the equipment suggests that the ancient brewmasters used a recipe of broomcorn millet, barley, a grain called Job's tears or Chinese pearl barley, and a form of tuber to brew their beverage. The presence of barley 1,000 years before it was believed to have been grown in China suggests that it might have been brought in from other regions, making beer an ingredient in early trade.

Researchers describe the possible taste of the beer as “a bit sour and a bit sweet.”

Do and don't say these to people with depression

Clinical depression is part of life for 16 million adults in the United States, according to the National Institute for Mental Health. People with depression often feel isolated and alone, so support is as much a part of treatment as therapy and medication. Here's what to say—and not to say—if someone you know suffers from depression:

Do:

- “I’m here for you.” Let people know you’re available to listen when they need to talk. Check in regularly to show that you care.
- “Let’s do something.” Help them get out of the house. Suggest activities like taking a walk, going to a movie, or getting some coffee.
- “I know this is difficult.” Recognize the other person’s struggle. Just knowing that someone understands the challenges of depression can help.

Don't:

- “You just need ____.” Minimizing the person’s pain doesn’t help. Don’t offer a quick-fix solution to a long-term problem.
- “I get depressed, too.” Yes, everyone feels down from time to time, but clinical depression can feel like a never-ending battle. Don’t compare your occasional blue days to another person’s serious condition.
- “Other people have worse problems.” Comparing your friend’s problem to other people rarely helps—and may make the person feel worse. Show compassion for the situation and help as much as

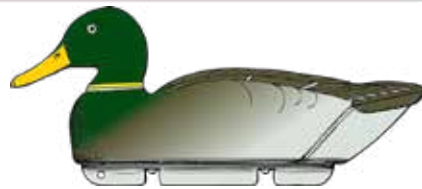

Libraries still important to most Americans

Most Americans believe that libraries still do a good job of serving their communities' learning needs. A Pew Research Center survey found that 76 percent of adults agree that their local library is fulfilling its educational function, with 37 percent saying it does so "very well" and 39 percent saying "pretty well."



About 78 percent of survey respondents indicated they've visited a library at least one time in their lives, and 44 percent said they'd been to their library at least once in the past 12 months.

Among the latter group, 97 percent consider themselves "lifelong learners," along with 98 percent who rely on library websites for information and learning.

Say cheese! Most of us rate our photography skills highly

Most of us like to take photographs, and most of us think we're pretty good at it. In a Canon USA survey of 1,000 adults, 80 percent described their photography skills as "good to excellent," and 62 percent said their picture-taking talents had improved over the last two years.

What are people taking pictures of? More than half—55 percent—post photos of recipes they're proud of, and 27 percent have shared pictures of their meals to brag about. The survey also discovered that people tend to take more pics of their pets than themselves (59 percent), although 47 percent admit they take selfies regularly.

Mostly we take pictures of our friends and family on special occasions (64 percent). Holidays and family gatherings are popular occasions for snapping images, with 80 percent taking photos on Christmas, Hanukkah, Memorial Day, and the like.

Video is popular, too: Seventeen percent of people in the survey say they shoot videos for online posts, with 50 percent taking videos of themselves to share on Facebook and other platforms.

Home is where the children are staying these days

Children used to grow up and move away, but that's no longer a guarantee. A study reported on the NPR website has found that for the first time in 130 years, young adults 18–34 are more likely to live with their parents than on their own:

- Living in parents' home 32.1 percent
- Married or cohabitating 31.6 percent
- Living alone 14 percent
- Other 22 percent

The “Other” category takes in such possibilities as living with a sibling or other family member, sharing housing with a roommate, or group situations like a college dorm—or prison.

Self-driving cars not tops on wish lists

Driverless cars are coming whether we like it or not—and many Americans don't. Despite claims from the government, car manufacturers, insurance companies, and tech enthusiasts about how driverless cars will be safer and more efficient, the public is skeptical.



A University of Michigan Survey has found that 46 percent of U.S. drivers prefer a vehicle with no self-driving capacity. Thirty-nine percent would opt for a car with some self-driving capability, and only 15 percent really want cars that can drive themselves. The numbers are consistent with those of a similar survey conducted 10 months earlier.

One reason for the reluctance may be plain old-fashioned fear: One study by the AAA found three-quarters of respondents simply feel to scared to trust a car without a human driver.

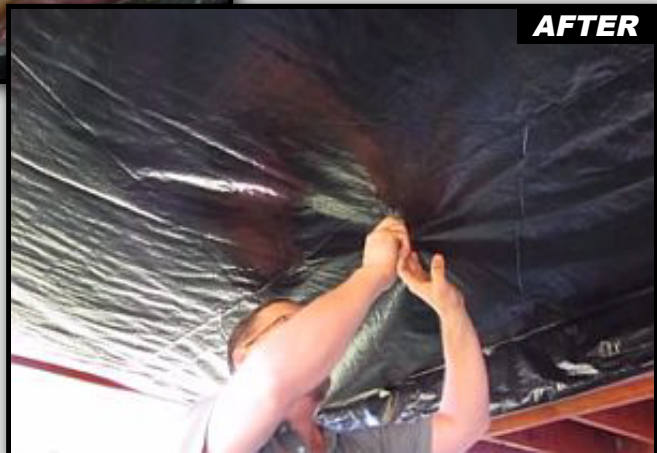

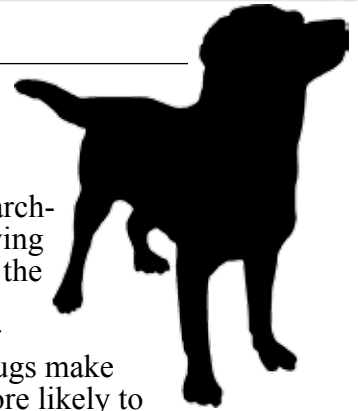

Give Fido a belly rub, not a hug

They've wanted to tell you for a long time, but they didn't have the words: Dogs hate being hugged.

An article in *Psychology Today* describes how a group of researchers analyzed the body language in a series of photos of dogs receiving hugs from humans. They found evidence of stress in 82 percent of the photos, leading them to speculate that dogs experience hugs negatively. The reason? Dogs have evolved to be fast runners, and their first line of defense against danger is running away (not biting). Hugs make running difficult, if not impossible, making dogs nervous—and more likely to bite if they feel threatened.



A pat or a belly rub may be a more positive way to appreciate your pet, the researchers say.

- Shamim M. Momim, director, Los Angeles Nomadic Division (LAND): “America is a nation that celebrates its founding on individual freedom and struggle against oppressive systems of belief. It makes sense that, in order to provide each person the opportunity to pull himself or herself up by the bootstraps and succeed on one’s own merits, innovation—literally ‘a new method, idea, or product’—would be the avenue to that success.”

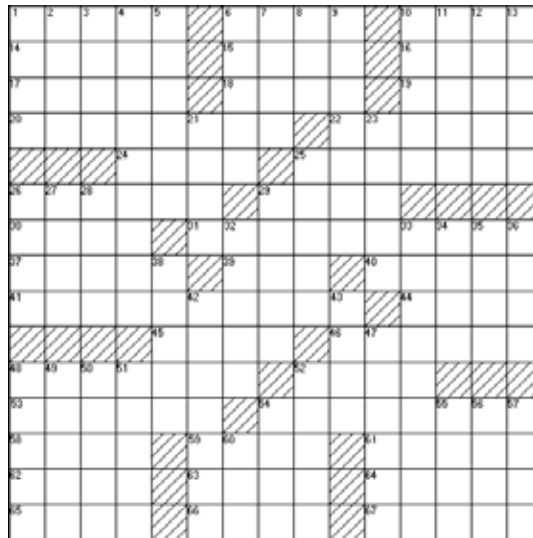

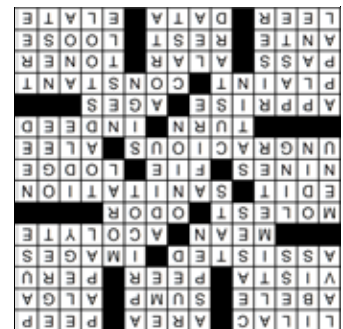
