

HOA NOMINATIONS, ELECTIONS and 2018 DUES

Details for the upcoming nominations and elections for the HOA Executive Board were discussed at the November 6th meeting. Here are the basic details in case you missed the meeting. Our Fiscal year is March to February. Below is the process we use to The qualifications to run for Homeowner's Association Board are few but firm:

- 1. You must have lived in the park for 2 years
- 2. You must have been an Active HOA member for 1 year.

At the January HOA meeting, announcements will be made concerning the elections and the qualifications will be reiterated. At that time, nominations will be opened.

At the February meeting, nominations will be presented. All nominees must be present to accept or reject and then the nominations will be closed. Anyone accepting a nomination will have 1 month to campaign throughout the park.

Elections will be held at the March meeting.

If you are an HOA member, you are qualified to vote. One ballot (one vote) per <u>household</u> will be given for you to vote your choice.

Dues will remain at \$12 for the year for each home. You will see that this is a tremendous bargain considering the savings per event. Dues must be paid to vote at the March 2018 meeting. You can help avoid the lines in March by paying early. \odot

Anyone wishing to renew or to become a new member, may pay their dues at any of the monthly meetings starting in January. This 2018 membership will be good through February 2019.



olunteers spend countless hours working on your behalf; this is why we are always requesting more help. And, this is why we need you.


When everybody does a little, it keeps others from having to do a lot. Spreading out our responsibilities makes things easier and a lot more fun for all.

RECIPES



- 5 cups all-purpose flour
- 5 tsp. baking powder
- 5 tsp. baking soda
- Pinch salt (optional)
- 5 Tb sugar
- Directions:

In a large bowl, whisk together the eggs, milk, butter and buttermilk. Combine the flour, baking powder, baking soda and sugar; stir into the wet ingredients just until blended. Adjust the thickness of the batter to your liking by adding more flour or buttermilk if necessary.

Heat a large skillet over medium heat, and coat with cooking spray. Pour 1/4 cupful of batter onto the skillet, and cook until bubbles appear on the surface. Flip with a spatula, and cook until browned on the other side. Continue with remaining batter.
