
we will pick up items, in good condition, that you would like to donate to the Bazaar.



When you do come to get a sticker, please make certain you have your driver's license and car registration in hand.
- The RO Annual Meeting is scheduled for Monday, February 4th (2019 of course). All Certificate members should receive the First Notice of Election for this meeting in early December. (The mailing date is no later than December 4th.) It announces the election to the membership and allows unit owners the opportunity to run for the Board of Directors. ## **KNOW YOUR NEIGHBOR**

Both Jerry & Sue were born, raised and educated in Saginaw, Michigan and still live in Saginaw County. Jerry on 18th October 1944 and Sue 23rd Dec 1952. If you're wondering

where Saginaw is (as I was), it is in Central Michigan about 100 miles north of Detroit. It is at the base of the thumb 30 miles from Saginaw Bay which is part of Lake Huron

It's a city with a population of around 50,000 and in a county of 200,000.

Jerry's grandparents on his father side were born in Germany, and his mother's parents immigrated from Poland as teenagers, met in Chicago and moved to Michigan for jobs.

Sue's ancestry is multi-generational born in the USA.

A couple years after high school Jerry went to working for GM as many young men in Michigan did. Vietnam was heating up at that time and in 1966 Jerry was drafted into the US Army. Jerry spent a year in Vietnam. He said he was one of the lucky ones; although he lived in a tent city, and has had two open heart surgeries from agent orange, he had good duty as a parts clerk in a motor pool in Nha Trang. Nha Trang, Vietnam, is situated on the China Sea and today, as it was prewar, is a popular seaside resort. Jerry said he hopes it has a better sewage system then it did when he was there.

After returning from Vietnam, he went back to GM. He applied for a job on skilled trades and became a machine repairman. The last 10 of his 36 years with GM he ran a Predictive Maintenance Program in his plant. He retired in 1999 from General Motors. A year later he was asked to sell industrial hydraulic hoses and fittings. He did that for 11 years part time until Sue retired in 2010

Sue worked in three departments at Covenant Healthcare and spent her days in the operating room. She has seen just about every body part you can think of. She worked everything from open heart to eye surgery to knee and hip replacements at Covenant Health Care in Saginaw. Jerry said he has been told many times by local Surgeons how they miss not having Sue in the room.

Both married, divorced and then met through Sue's brother who was a friend of Jerry's.

They have now been married for 24 years.

Sue has 3 daughters and Jerry has 3 boys. This "Brady Bunch" family are close knit and between the children have produced 11 grandchildren.



### **Coldest place in the world**

ou may think it's cold where you live right now—if you're in the northern hemisphere, at least—but scientists have located the absolute coldest spot on Earth. No surprise—it's in Antarctica.



The National Geographic website reports that satellite data have identified an ice sheet in the middle of the southern continent with a temperature of minus 144 degrees Fahrenheit. This breaks the previous record for the chilliest place on the globe—minus 128 degrees, recorded in 1983 at the Russian Vostok Station close to the South Pole. At that low temperature, breathing itself is dangerous—more than a few breaths would make your lungs hemorrhage.

Chances are we won't find any colder places. Increases in greenhouse gases and water vapor in the air have scientists expecting a rise in temperatures across the Antarctic of three to four degrees in the coming years.
