

Manager's Corner - July 2017 *Jeff Hahn, LCAM*

- My first article in your Monthly Media will be more of an introduction than anything else, though you will find a few items that pertain to some of your Governing Documents as well as relating to some of the projects and work being done in the community. First a little bit of my background. I am a native of western Pennsylvania, a small and getting smaller town, Johnstown that lies approximately 70 miles southeast of Pittsburgh. As such, yes I am a Steeler, Pirates and Penguins (Stanley Cup winners for the second year in a row!!!) fan. After college at Duquesne University in Pittsburgh I ended up moving to northern Virginia and spent a number of years there, primarily in the Banking Industry, was married and had two daughters, Erica and Kris. After too many years in that area, my now ex-wife was transferred by her company to the Clearwater/St Pete area, and with my daughters also leaving, I followed Since being here, I was in Banking again for a number of years before in the late '90s. moving to the Community Association Management industry. In that capacity, I began that career with a Management Company and was responsible for overseeing seven condominium Associations. Keep in mind, there are leash laws that need to be adhered to that are governed by Pinellas County. Thank you all for your cooperation in this matter
- The dumpsters are to be used for recycling of newspapers and cuttings of your plants and bushes, but not for any trash or furniture of any kind, including electrical appliances. There is a gentleman who will pick up these items so just let the Office know when you have anything to be removed and we will get you the information you need.
- Among the areas being looked at currently, include increasing the lighting at the pool to bring this up to code, the replacing of approximately 60 electrical pedestals, reviewing the tree situation in the park and some drainage issues that need to be addressed. Other areas will be addressed as we come across them
- That's it for now. I just want to again tell you that I look forward to meeting and working with all of you. In the meantime, have a safe and enjoyable 4th of July and stop by the office to meet me whenever you have the opportunity. Take care!!
