



# Thank you from Ray & Julie (#564) from Australia


y the time this is printed hopefully our "disaster" is over as far as and 1 territory. To put it in perspective Queensland is twice the size





ohn and Lois's home is the newest at the date of writing in Doral Village. It's always a topic of conversation and conjecture when a new house



arrives in the park. Their home sits almost on the opposite side of the creek from the cottage. It's higher than most other houses due to council regulations because it's in a flood zone. So, who are the new residents?






