





She was born in Lawrence, Massachusetts, in December 1950 to John and Elizabeth Murphy. Karen was the third child to this couple; she has two older brothers and a younger sister. Her oldest brother passed away at an early age.

Her mother, Bette, is someone many residents of Doral Village know.

Bette was a school teacher. In the later part of her career, she was an elementary school principal. She graduated from Salem Teacher's college in 1947. Her heritage was a mixture of French and Yankee. Karen's father, John served in the Navy in WW2 and worked as a machinist afterwards at the NE Power Company.

His heritage was Irish as the name suggests. Sadly, he passed away at just 55. Bette never remarried.



Karen went to St Mary's Catholic School in Lawrence. Back in those days, as most of us remember, kids walked to school. Karen and her siblings did this most days of the year, unless the weather made it impossible.

In those days, it was also safe to play in the street, this is just what Karen, her brothers, and sister and their friends did. When the street lights came on it was time to go inside. They enjoyed their childhood.

Karen's parents bought their home in North Andover from Bette's parents who built it. Karen and Mike bought this same house when Bette moved.

In 1990 Karen completed a master's Degree in Child Development from Wheelock College in Boston after that she studied to become a Literacy Coach at Lesley University also in Boston. She enjoyed a long and enriching career as a Kindergarten Teacher working with over 1000 students. In 2007, after 34 years, she retired for the first time.

The Brown's decided to move to Florida for the same reason many do a hatred of the cold northern winters. Along with the fact that her Mom, Bette, lived here in Doral.


