





Manager's Corner September, 2018 Jeff Hahn, LCAM

• There has been a great deal of interest recently in persons bringing new homes into Doral. The most promising possibility at the time of this article (August 8th) is the lot located at #486. Besides this one, there has been at least initial steps taken to place homes on lots 20, 55, and 408. This is not to say that any of these will end up with coaches on them, as it is too early to make that call. Normally the biggest obstacle seems to be matching the size of the home that the customer wants to purchase versus the size of the lot they want to put it on. I will update you in October's Monthly Media as to the progress (or lack thereof) being made.

- Progress is being made with the installation of the new Gate at the US 19 entrance. The underground wiring is now taking place and this step will conclude long before you receive this information. One more added note, you will receive ample notice prior to the activation of the gate, and there will be a meeting or two to go over exactly when and how the gate will function and what you as residents will need to do to be able to use this entrance. For further details on this installation, read the President's Report that is included in this issue of the Monthly Media.
- The sidewalk replacement and repairs by one of our vendors was to be completed by the time
 you receive this issue, as they were to commence work on this project on Friday, August 10th.
 It was to take approximately a little over a week to complete, but who knows with this Florida
 weather.
- The replacement of the old electric pedestals is still being addressed, as there are one or two
 designated for this change that have not been replaced. This should be finalized soon. Please
 keep in mind that Doral is aware that not all the pedestals that need replaced will be
 completed after this year's project, with more being designated for the summer of 2019.
- Just a reminder...Rule # Vii (1) of your Rules and Regulations states the following: "All guests shall register with the business office upon arrival". Keep in mind it is very important we know who is in the Park. This is for your security and safety. Also, if a guest parks an unregistered vehicle anywhere in the common area, it may very well be towed at the owner's expense. Registering will prevent this from happening.
- Another quick reminder...please make certain you provide the Office with a current cell phone
 number as we are using our Robocall system to inform residents of events that will be or are
 taking place in the Park, such as a power outage, or a water being turned off to some or all of
 the residents.
- A new washing machine has been ordered for the Laundry room by the garage, and a new paper recycling dumpster at the field by the plant has also been ordered.
- A new shed has been placed at the big field. This brings the total to four in this location.
- September brings us the unofficial end of summer (Labor Day) in some areas of the country, and also the official end of summer and beginning of Fall (the 22nd). September also brings us one of the most tragic days in US history (September 11th) and brings us the peak of the hurricane season, as September 12th historically is the day when the most named hurricanes are active. Hopefully this September will bring all of you nothing but the best. Take care

GET TO KNOW YOUR NEIGHBOR

MAVIS AGUINAGA # 152

avis was born in Chesterfield, England, on September 23, 1935. Her father was a coal miner who contracted tuberculosis and sadly died at just 31 years old. Her mother, who lived to be almost 82, was left to raise Mavis, her three sisters, and two brothers. Mavis was just four years old when WWII broke out; she vividly remembers the bombings, the fires, and the sirens going off each night as the German bombers came to bomb the shipbuilding areas of Sheffield and Nottingham. She remembers having to take their gas masks to school, having to hide in the bomb shelters, and so on. In fact, one bomb landed just one mile from her home. Mavis also remembers the years of rationing, even into the 1950s as England rebuilt. Sheffield, a major industrial city, was razed to the ground.

Mavis was educated locally and went on to study Early Childhood Education at College.

Her first job was as a Nursery School Teacher at a children's home. These children's parents were in prison. She became engaged to a soldier, so after 2 ½ years at the children's home, she moved to London and secured a job as Head Nursery School Warden in Chelsea, London; she was the youngest to hold this position at the time.

The engagement, unfortunately, did not work, and Mavis later met her first husband Derek. They married in 1957 and later in that year, Derek was offered a position at Avro Arrow in Toronto, Canada. Not long after they arrived, the Prime Minister canceled the project putting 30,000 people out of work. Mavis and Derek were left without jobs and after 16 months, they returned to England in 1959. Their daughter Lynne was born in Canada. Seven years after their return to England, they had another child, a son. Derek was transferred to Dorval in Quebec with his work at Rolls Royce. They went on to adopt a son and fostered many other babies. When their son, Daryl, was 4 years old Mavis went back to teaching. She taught preschool at the same school for the next 23 years and retired at age 57.

Mavis divorced in 1970 and remarried again in 1984 to Robert. This marriage lasted 23 years until they divorced in 2002. Shortly before they divorced Mavis and Robert came to Doral as snowbirds.

Having enjoyed her time in Doral, and once the divorce was final, Mavis again "snow birded" and rented No 153. As fate would have it her neighbour was Bob Aguinaga. When Mavis returned to Canada Bob wooed her with phone calls, cards and letters. Again, Mavis rented No 153 and she and Bob fell in love. They were engaged on Valentine's Day 2003.

Bob came from a large family in Michigan, of Mexican descent. He was the eldest of 15 children. Today a number of his family continues to live in the park.

Mavis and Bob were the first couple to be married in the Doral Clubhouse on July 11, 2003, surrounded by their family and friends. Mavis became an American citizen in 2010. They renewed their wedding vows 10 years later in Mavis' church and sadly Bob passed away 6

Harriet Israel. #445

arriet and her husband Milton moved to Doral village just three years ago in August 2015. They bought a home in the pet section, on the main road to the Belcher Rd exit. One of their sons lives diagonally opposite and is a great support for Harriet these days. So, who is Harriet?

She was born in November 1927 in the Bronx, New York City. Her mother was Anna Smith and her dad was Julius Smith. These were not their Russian names. Their Russian surnames were Javnelis. In the USA in the early 1900s Russian immigrants were looked upon with suspicion particularly the ones who were Jewish, and for this reason, or maybe because no one could spell Javnelis when they entered the country, their surname became Smith.

Both her parents were born in Minsk, Russia. They fled the country when the Russian Empire was overthrown and the revolution, led by Josef Stalin, happened in 1914-1917. They, as did thousands of Russian immigrants first went to China. Estimates say between 900,000 and two million "White Russians" made the incredible 12,000-mile journey to escape Russia. When the Chinese Communist Party formed, and the first revolution happened in 1921, they immigrated to USA. They settled in New York City. Many of these Russians also settled in San Francisco where there is now a museum dedicated to their story.

They arrived by boat and those of us who remember scenes of refugees and settlers arriving at Ellis Island In those days can just imagine what they faced; a new country, a different language and having to start their lives over again. As with all immigrants, in those times, her parents worked hard to establish themselves in a new country. Her father opened a furniture store in Harlem and her mother was a seamstress in lower New York. Her mother also went to

night school to learn English. They had five children. One died in infancy. Harriet had two older brothers and an older sister; she was the baby of the family.

Harriet attended school in the Bronx and before she finished her schooling World War II had started. Both her brothers were in the US Army and served in Egypt. Both survived the War.

Milton was from Chicago, and served his country, too. He signed up, when he was just 17, in the merchant Marines, under the Coast Guard, which meant the ships were armed. As he had Scarlett fever as a child, and had impaired hearing, he was ineligible to join the regular service. He served part of his time in Papua New Guinea, which was invaded by the Japanese Army. The war campaign in this area was fierce and fought by both the USA and Australian troops.

Harriet met Milton when she was just 18 and he was 21, at a dance hall in Manhattan. They married a couple of years later at a Jewish Synagogue in the Bronx.
