
RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE



KNOW YOUR NEIGHBOR

Maureen Bartlett #542

A sureen was born in Toronto Canada in 1937 to parents Ivy and Bill McDowell. Bill was raised just outside Belfast, Ireland and came to Canada as a young man on an assisted passage to work as a farmer. Her mother was one of 12 children. She was born and raised in the far North of Scotland on the remote Orkney Islands. These islands have a long history going back to Neolithic times, and recently archeological sites have been discovered. In fact, the oldest stone house still standing anywhere and dating back to 3600 -3200BC has been discovered on one of the islands.

From Wikipedia:

Dating back to around 3600 BCE, the Knap of Howar is the oldest building in the world and is most likely the oldest house still standing. The Knap of Howar consists of two stonebuilt houses that were discovered in the 1930s when erosion revealed parts of the stone walls. Soon after, the site was excavated, and archaeologists discovered that the two structures were linked by a passage through the joint walls.

Maureen's mother and 8 of her siblings eventually migrated to Canada.

First, Ivy moved to Edinburgh in Scotland to work as a nanny. From there she moved to Canada where she also worked as a nanny and then a seamstress working at Eatons. Bill and Ivy met when they were introduced by a mutual friend who was living in the boarding house like Bill. They married in 1935 Bill served in the Royal Canadian Army during WW2 in France where he worked in the Canadian Army Post Office. After returning home when the war ended, he went to work for the Canadian Department of Immigration. Maureen was an only child; however, she was never alone. Her mother was a foster mum and for many years fostered children whose ages ranged from newborn to 5-6 years old. In addition, her mother always encouraged her to invite friends to their home and even taking them on holidays with the family. After she completed school Maureen attended college and gained her teachers degree. She taught for just 2 years before marriage. When her children were young Maureen went back to teaching on a casual basis. She was later offered a full-time teaching position in Brampton teaching grades 6,7 and 8. She also managed to fit in a university degree which she started at 35 years old and completed 12 years later when she was 47. This took so much time as she was not only a wife and mother, she was teaching full time and attending the university when she could She retired in 1996 after 30 years of teaching.

Bill had retired 10 years before Maureen and as he loved to cook, he took over cooking their evening meals. He retired from this position as head cook as soon as Maureen retired. Maureen and Bill began dating when she was just sixteen. Around this time, she and her parents returned to the UK on a 3-month extended holiday to visit relatives. She was hoping Bill would wait for her, and he did.



They dated for 6 years and then married. They were married for 61 years before Bill passed away in July 2019, after suffering ill health for 3 years. His family made a touching video of Bills musical career after he passed away. It's posting on YouTube as a lasting tribute to his life.


Maureen and Bill have 2 children. Paul now 57 and Lisa 60. Both live in Ontario. Maureen has 3 grandchildren. One grandson has just returned to live in Canada after living in Panama and Paraguay for the past 10 years. Bill, a well known and popular Doral snowbird was born on September 24, 1934 in Toronto. He worked as a salesman. Bill was also a talented musician, he played drums and loved country music. His band was regularly asked to be the backup band for artists such as Johnny Cash, Conway Twitty, Loretta Lynne and many others. They were regular guest artists at the famous Horseshoe Tavern in Toronto, many times backing Loretta Lynne. The Horseshoe was featured on Live on MTV in September 1997, when The Rolling Stones began their Bridges to Babylon Tour with a thundering 75-minute show. Bill also loved to play in Big Bands when the opportunity arose. Bill and Maureen began snow birding in Doral Village from 1997 – 2010, and then bought their current home from well know resident Bill Norwood. They stayed in Doral for 5 months every winter. This past winter is Maureen's' first without Bill. When Bill and Maureen married, they lived in Brampton, a suburb of Toronto for 27 years, then Hastings on the Trent River for the 17 years. Maureen now lives in Port Dover on the shores of Lake Erie.

While in Doral Village Maureen conducts the pool aerobic classes, she runs the military whist evenings, plays bridge and euchre and enjoys catching up with friends.
