





AUGUST RECIPE

UNSTUFFED CABBAGE ROLLS an easy and healthy recipe.

Ingredients:

11/2 to 2 pounds of lean ground beef or turkey

1 tablespoon olive oil

1 large onion, chopped

1 glove garlic, minced

1 small cabbage, chopped

2 cans (14.5 ounces each) diced tomatoes

1 can (8 ounces) tomato sauce

½ cup water

1 teaspoon sea salt

1 teaspoon ground black pepper

Preparation:

In a large skillet, heat olive oil over medium heat. Add the ground beef and onion and cook, stirring, until ground beef is no longer pink, and onion is tender. Add the garlic and continue cooking for 1 minute. Add the chopped cabbage, tomatoes, tomato sauce, salt, and pepper. Bring to a boil. Cover and simmer for 20 to 30 minutes, or until cabbage is tender. Enjoy!





KNOW YOUR NEIGHBOR

BETTY GEORGE #642

Betty and her husband Mike bought their home in Doral Village in 1990, 30 years ago. They rented out their home for the first 2 years and then they began snowboarding. Betty was born Helen Elizabeth Peters in Port Hope, Ontario, Canada to parents



Herman and Pearl (née Vesta McKenzie). Herman's first wife died in her 30s and left him and a 3-year-old son called Arthur. When he was widowed, he went to work in a resort in Muskoka where he met his future wife when she was just 18. They lived 150 miles apart making it a long commute for herself and later her parents. Betty's father was a reluctant farmer. The farm was a mixed farm. One night a hobo came and slept in their barn and accidentally set it alight. The barn burnt to the ground and the family lost everything. This happened in the days before the Great Depression. This event affected her Dad until the day he died. Betty was the third child of 7. Her mother not only raised 7 children but worked on the farm milking cows etc. She would travel to town on her horse and buggy to sell products the farm produced. Betty went to the local village school and the local High School. She had been at high school for 2 years and the family moved. Betty went to live with an aunt until she graduated from school. During WW2 her father worked in a ammunitions factory along with many others who, for one reason or another were not able to serve. Her mother moved back to Muskoka, with the children, to be close to her family. Her dream was to own a tourist home and she bought a home on the river to fulfill this dream. Sadly though, not long after, at just 41 she died of breast cancer. This left the children to virtually raise themselves. The oldest girl was about 18 and Betty was just 14. These teenagers were left to run the home and business. They decided it wasn't viable, so they sold the property and moved back to Port Hope. At 18, Betty had another big change in her life when she moved to Oshawa, 30 miles east of Toronto to begin training as a nurse. By now her sister had fallen in love and wanted to marry but had to wait for Betty to complete her training, graduate and move back to Port Hope. When Betty was 22 her father suffered a cerebral hemorrhage and was in a coma for 2 weeks. He survived but was never the same. This left the children raising themselves. Bettys brother, Blake, who was 2 years younger took over the male patriarch role in the family and did an admirable job. The siblings all chipped in their salaries to support the household. Betty worked as a nurse, and then Joined Trans Canada Airlines (now Air Canada) as a stewardess. In those days' airlines preferred to employ nurses. She was there for 3 years. She met her husband, Mike in 1954, he worked in Toronto for Gulf Oil, but his parents lived in Port Hope. They owned the local funeral home, where Bettys brother Blake worked. He introduced the pair, at the Officers Mess in Port Hope. Mike was an only child and had no interest in working in the business so eventually his parents sold it. Mike joined the Air Force in WW2, he served in London as an Adjutant in the Medical



Field. Betty and Mike had a long engagement as Betty wanted to do an extended trip to Europe before settling into married life. When they married, they lived in Toronto as Mike was still working for Gulf Oil. They had 3 children, 2 sons and one daughter. Once the children were in school Betty returned to work in the Public Health Department for the next 14 years. Her son, Paul now lives in Denver, Colorado and works in the oil business, her other son Brian lives in Pembroke and has an optical business. Daughter, Elizabeth now married, and lives in St Petersburg. She and her husband own the American Freedom Distillery. Paul, her son, had a career in the oil business and was posted to countries all over the world. This gave Betty and Mike the perfect excuse to travel and visit him wherever he was at the time. In the mid-1980s, Bettys older sister and her husband bought a manufactured house near Oldsmar. One trip while visiting Mike and Betty decided to buy in Florida. They saw an ad in Toronto from a real estate agent selling properties in Doral Village. They bought their home and "snow birded" from then on. At the same time, they travelled extensively overseas. In 2013 Mike became ill and eventually passed away. Betty still enjoys spending 6 months each year in Doral Village. She loves to bake and makes excellent preserves. She loves to socialize and spend time with her family. She also loves to play bridge. Her brother Blake followed her to Doral Village with his wife Nancy. The rented for a few years and then bought. Nancy and Betty spend time together when in Doral.




