t is hard to believe it is August already and we hope everyone has been enjoying the pool to help stay cool. Please remember to have your pool passes with you each time you go to the pool! You may have up to 4 guests at one time per the prospectus.

Also, there are to be NO dogs/animals in the pool or surrounding areas. There is no alcohol allowed at the pool. Please do not enter the clubhouse if you are wet. Also, we appreciate the residents helping out to insure the pool rules are being followed however, if you yourself are not complying please do confront someone else who is not following the rules. This does nothing to fix the situation and creates a hostile atmosphere which is not what we want at Down Yonder.

Every day I complete a check of the property on my daily Rise and Shine check list. We make sure the clubhouse is clean, the flags look fresh, there is no trash at the front of the park and just make sure the overall appearance is pleasing and that everything is in proper order.

At the request of some residents we have now implemented a compliment form. This form can be used to pay someone a compliment. Please use as many as you like!!!! It is nice to hear a well done instead of a complaint. We recently had a resident pay the office a compliment and it was so appreciated.

A big part of my Assistant Kim's day is spent answering phone calls or being paid visits regarding complaints. Before calling, please utilize the resident objection forms to file a complaint. The forms can be found at the office or in the library/billiards room at the clubhouse. They need to be completed in full and dropped off at the office or the drop box located to the right of the office door. Please allow 2 weeks for actions to be taken. The form must be completed in its entirety and signed or it will not be reviewed.

Complaints or objections will not be accepted by phone. If you have a dispute with your neighbor please try to settle this sensibly. If the issue is still not resolved and you feel threatened or criminal activity is taking place, CONTACT THE LARGO POLICE. I can attend to issues that break the rules listed in the prospectus, rules and regulations, Florida Statutes and Fair Housing Laws. I can do nothing for a dispute with your neighbor.

There is ABSOLUTELY no parking or driving on the grass in the park. Thank you.

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Please remember that you must have prior approval before doing any improvements to the outside of your home. We ask that you submit a drawing and a written description of what upgrades you want to do and bring it to the office. I will have to look at the property and then make my decision. I recently had my Regional officers drive through the community, they have seen some items that are not in line with the Community rules and regulations.

Remember that you must keep the outside of your lot in a clean and tidy manner. Make sure your homes are pressured washed and painted if needed. Keep the flower beds weeded and trees and bushes trimmed. If you are unsure, please check the prospectus. We will be picking random lots for our July inspections.

Thank you to the majority of the residents who are respectful of the prospectus, rule and regulations.

I know there is also chatter about larger animals in the community. I do know about them, they have submitted the appropriate paperwork and have also been reviewed by the attorney's.

Another bit of information about lawn watering. I have been in touch with Pinellas County and have found out that the community is under the water restrictions of the community address (7001), not your lot #. There are also special instructions for new lawns in which they give you extra watering days for a specific period of time.

More chatter, about street paving, new storage fence and the clubhouse kitchen flooring. They are all in the works and have been since 1-1-15. It takes time (more time than is acceptable to some) to receive estimates, certification of the vendors, reviews, codes, etcetera but they are coming. I am excited about seeing the upgrades as you are. I have worked very hard pushing these things through. There will be many more for 2016 and 2017 (which I have been working on as well). When Kim, my assistant, says that I am on a call or busy, believe her I am very busy.

Thank you for taking the time to read this letter from the Manager's desk. I hope everyone has an enjoyable and safe August.

Every shoping that all of our northern friends are enjoying their summer, where the weather is comfortable and the fun is even more enjoyable. As for us in Down Yonder, the weather is unbelievably hot and muggy. Can't wait to see what August brings.



The state FMO (Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida, Inc.) along with State Senator Chris Latvala has gotten passed many changes to Florida Statute 723 (which is what our community goes by), which not only affects the owners of our property, but also the HOA's throughout the state. This new laws are in effect as of July 1, 2015. Our By-Laws are in the mist of being rewritten and the new laws of the Statute will be incorporated into them, but as of July 1st the new rules will automatically be in effect.

The new laws will be read at our October and November meetings so everyone is fully aware of the changes.

#### Some of the important changes are:

- 1. Board Members will need to be certified-We will know more on this by our October meeting.
- 2. Floor nominations must be a month prior to the election. There will be no nominations on the night of elections.
- 3. We may reduce the number of a quorum from 50% + 1 to 30% (this will have to be voted on by members).
- 4. Electronic Communications for meetings will be allowed.

These and other additions will be read as written from the State.

Our November meeting will be an OPEN meeting for all unit <u>owners</u> (this does not include renters). We also hope to have a member from the FMO as a speaker.

#### Membership In The HOA

Membership is important in a community like ours. We need to stand united in an effort to be effective towards the corporation that owns us.

The Homeowners Association is the major group in the community that is the liaison with management and problems within the park according to Florida Statute 723. <u>The HOA is key in negotiating you rent increases</u>. It is in your best interest to become a member and let your voices be heard. A committee will be selected in in the spring of 2016 to prepare for negotiations that will be in the fall. It is important to show Equity Lifestyle Properties that we all are united.

Remember the HOA Board, and any other association/club in our community does not get involved with neighbor to neighbor disputes. A problem such as this should be brought to the attention of the office.

The Largo Police Dept. has suggested that we mark under the seats of both the bikes and golf carts "Down Yonder and your lot number". This way if they are found they can return it to you.

<u>NEW RESIDENTS</u> –We are a community that is governed by a Prospectus which contains the rules and regulations of what is allowed and not allowed, what is expected of the corporation that owns the property and what is expected of us as residents. Please take the time to read your Prospectus and know the rules set forth many years ago. Please remember when you signed your lease assumption you agreed to abide by these rules and regulations.
