



Our last meeting took place on November 14th and unfortunately with few in attendance although we held an Open House for all home owners. We would like to thank all of those who came.

Discussions included:

Elections for Board of Directors – There will be four openings in January. A sign-up sheet will be in the library for anyone interested in running. All persons (including those seeking reelection) will need to bring their title (or electronic title receipt) to show proof of ownership. The last day for floor nominations will be at our December 12th meeting. You must be a member of the Homeowner's Association no later than December 26th in order to vote on January 9, 2018.

The meeting for January 9th will commence at exactly 7:00 p.m. and no ballots will be given out after that time. If there are no more than four (4) people who have been nominated or who seek a position on the sign-up sheet, there will be not vote. Although many think that the HOA doesn't do anything, we do. The HOA is there to be sure that management abides by the rules and regulations of their Prospectus. We are also responsible for negotiating our annual rents, which we always go for a Long Term Agreement which seems to be in our best interest. For the new residents your new annual rates are supposed to be discussed when you sign your lease agreement, of which I have heard you are not getting full disclosure at this time and you have received increases amounting to over \$40 a month for 2018. I can assure you that I have been working on this since March and have not received any response from upper management. It is not our local office that sets your new rents. We need everyone's support in an effort to show ELS that we have strength in our community. As I've said before, if they see that we don't care, then why should they. With the housing market (and especially in Florida) going up, mobile home housing is still one of the cheapest ways of living.

Children's Pool Hours still seem to be a problem with many grandparents taking the children to the pool during off hours for children and getting upset that they are either reminded or asked to leave. What is missing here is that fact that this is an adult community and with the children's hours set at 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. and then again from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. that only gives the adults of the community only 3 hours of daylight time to be able to enjoy the pool without children. You are being unfair to the other adult residents and to your grandchildren (by telling them they have to leave). The only person you can be upset with is yourself. You moved here knowing the rules on children and it is posted at the pool.

It has been put on record that the HOA WILL NOT recognize a special committee that was suggested in our October meeting due to an incident that occurred in the park.

Management has asked us not to over fill the courtesy dumpsters in the parking lot. We have garbage pick-up two times a week which should be more than sufficient for all of us. If the dumpsters are filled, please take your bags home and put them out on the next trash pick-up day. I have been told that they will be removed if people don't use common sense and see that the dumpster is at its capacity and continue to put their garbage all around them. Please understand that the waste company that picks the cans up will not get out of their vehicles and pick-up what is left lying on the ground. Also no furniture or extremely large items should be put by the dumpsters. There is a roll off at the maintenance yard for these items. Also, if you have problems getting non-garbage items to the roll off, please contact the office for assistance.

The annual Christmas Golf Cart Parade will be taking place on Saturday December 16th. For all of those who have golf carts, this gives you a chance to decorate and show them off. All golf carts will line up at around 6:30 and the parade will begin right around 7 p.m. We need volunteers to supply stops along the way for snacks or whatever. After the parade all residents

Name, lot# and street, Phone #, location of incident, incident in progress, description of vehicle and tag number.



Be safe on your bicycle

Bicyclist deaths have risen significantly in recent years, and adult men, not kids, are most often the victims, according to the Medline Plus website. In 2015, the most recent year figures are available, biking deaths rose 12 percent. Of the 818 fatalities in 2015, a hefty 85 percent were men, with an average age of 45.

A report by the Governors Highway Safety Association noted that bikers often believe they have the right of way and are unable stop in time to avoid a collision. Drivers also often don't see bikers until it's too late.

Intersections aren't the most dangerous area. Seventy-two percent of bicycle fatalities occur away from intersections. More than half take place between 6 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Alcohol, whether consumed by the biker or the driver, is also a factor in 37 percent of collision deaths.

If we are creating ourselves all the time, then it is never too late to begin creating the bodies we want instead of the ones we mistakenly assume we are stuck with.

Book Recommendation:

Here Vultures Fly

by Rudy Rodrigues

This is the narration of the personal experiences of the author, Rudy Rodrigues, during his ten years of service with the United Nations in Afghanistan, where he was engaged in emergency relief and later rehabilitation programs in close collaboration with the Communist government, the mujahideen, the Taliban, and the post-Taliban government.

The author was responsible for opening the first UNICEF office in Kyrgyzstan soon after the collapse of the Soviet Union in a unique environment and culture. During this time, he was working with a government unfamiliar with the United Nations and its goals and objectives. In addition, the Kyrgyz population was traumatized by this sudden period of transition and uncertainty. A major focus of the author's work was gaining the



confidence of the government in Uzbekistan and to ensure the building of meaningful partnership programs for women and children.

This book also covers the adventures, romance, and thrill of being born and raised in Kenya; serving as an officer in the army; the challenges of working in Papua New Guinea; and having the glorious opportunity of working in the UN in different parts of the world with a multiethnic/multicultural community.

About the Author

Rudy Rodrigues was born and raised in Kenya. He graduated from the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst and the British Army Staff College. He was commissioned and served as an officer in the Kenya Army in both command and staff appointments. Resigning after sixteen years of active service, he then immigrated to Canada with his wife and three children.

Later, Rodrigues was appointed country director of a Canadian NGO in the Sudan, with a mandate to provide leadership, strategic planning and the delivery of UN (WFP) emergency relief supplies to the more than three million starving people displaced by the famine of 1985. He did so using a fleet of 350 cargo vehicles and a staff of over 3,000 people. This trucking operation was later taken over by the UN, and Rodrigues served as its Director.

In 2006 Rodrigues ended his career, and moved from Afghanistan, where he was last working with the United Nations. He retired to Winter Park, Florida where he lives today, and enjoys traveling, writing and spending time with his family, children and grandchildren.
