### appy St. Patrick's Day

This article will be short and to the point. The office has been bombarded with concerns that are best shared with you, the Residents:

- 1. Overflow parking: The overflow parking is for just that....if you have family, friends, or guests over and parking is needed, they need to park in the overflow. If you're a 1 car family, you can park the car in your carport.
- 2. Dumpsters: The dumpsters are not to be used as a dumping site. TV's, furniture, appliances etc are NOT to be placed in the dumpster or anyplace on Down Yonder property. Just call Goodwill, Salvation Army or other organizations to pick these items up.
- 3. Smokers: Don't throw your "butts" on the lawn. Residents don't want to pick up your "butts" any more than you do. Take your "butts" home with you and dispose of properly.
- 4. Illegal parking per prospectus: Automobiles are parking on the street day and evening hours. It clearly states in the prospectus (Exhibit C, III, 27 a.) "No automobiles will be permitted to be parked on streets. Streets must be kept open for emergency vehicles." Also, Exhibit D, Page 8, VII, 2. States "No street parking is permitted, except temporary parking for delivery purposes."
- 5. STOP signs: We've been placing warnings on vehicles parking within feet of a stop sign. I'm talking 3-4 feet. This is illegal. Florida Statutes TITLE XXIII – Motor Vehicles – Chapter 316 states you cannot park within 30 feet (10 m) of a traffic light, STOP sign or YIELD sign. The police will be called in the future.
- 6. Back Gate: The gate was not unlocked 2 days last week due to Joe and Diane being out of the office. If someone would like to volunteer to be a "fill in" gate key keeper, let the office know.
- 7. 360's: The 360's are not a punishment but a reminder of your responsibility to one another and to the park.

If you're in need of power washing etc., come to the office. We have cards that companies left or look in the Monthly Media. It's published for your benefit.

We're hoping to start a list of volunteers that would be willing to help residents with the clean up. If you can help, call 531-9149 and I'll put your name on it. Once the need arises, I'll call you. No list, no help.

I'm sorry to be such a Regina Downer but it's the only way to get our park back to what it used to be. We have a beautiful area and want it to shine as representation to what mobile home living is all about.

*ur meeting* was held last night (February 13th) and we went over many of the questions that had come up in January's meeting. Other discussions also took place:

**Water/Electric:** Several weeks ago the water was shut-off for repairs.Management knew a few days prior and did their best to get the word out by posting signs in many areas.After discussing with the office that many residents cannot or don't go to the clubhouse everyday to see notices, they have agreed to put the "sandwich boards" at the front of the park both at Royale and Bourbon Streets so that when residents enter they will be

able to see the notice.Signs will also be posted around the clubhouse.This will only happen if they get notice ahead of time.....unfortunately if it is an emergency no notifications will be done.We are

also looking into "robo" calls since everyone doesn't have a computer and this way everyone can be informed.

**Dog Stations:** Management will be stopping supplying our dog stations with plastic bags. It appears that some have become abusive in the fact that they are taking many bags at a time. Management told me that they were going through about 1 case of bags a week, which is 2,000 bags. Once they have stopped supplying the bags we are going to ask residents who have an overflow of plastic bags from stores to recycle them at the dog stations.



## Families growing in size as remarriage rises

The Bloomberg website reports that almost a third of U.S. households headed by adults under 55 have at least one stepchild, and among couples over 55 with adult children, 33 percent have at least one stepchild. Counting stepchildren boosts the size of a family by 55 percent among Americans with grown children.

## Beat sleeplessness through awareness of the risks

Insomnia is becoming a problem in our society, and it's attributable to complex interactions among dozens of factors. One in three American adults don't get enough sleep every night, and that number may rise if we don't work collectively to try and improve our sleep patterns. As health care writer Anna Johansson points out, the effects of sleep deprivation are dangerous, both in the short and long term:

- Lack of focus and memory. As both a short-term and long-term effect, losing sleep can interfere with your ability to create new memories, and may make it more difficult to focus during the day. This makes it difficult to perform in most professional roles.
- Declining cognitive abilities. Sleep loss also hinders your cognitive capacity, making it more difficult to think critically or solve problems. This gets more intense with more sleeplessness over time.



• Obesity and diabetes. There's evidence to show that chronic sleeplessness can lead to obesity, as well as diabetes, which in turn can lead to even more serious health complications.

• Heart disease and mortality. Chronic lack of sleep may even increase the likelihood and severity of heart disease, and decrease your lifespan.

## Coffee may cut risk of death, studies say

tarting the day with a cup of coffee helps many of us wake up. New evidence suggests it may help us live a longer life, too.

In one study written up in the journal Annals of Internal Medicine, researchers at the University of Southern California's Keck School of Medicine surveyed more than 185,000 Americans for 16 years. Their results: People who drank one cup of java a day were 12 percent less likely to die than those who didn't, and people who drank two to three cups were less likely to die by 18 percent—regardless of whether the coffee was caffeinated or not.

In another study reported in the same journal, researchers analyzed data from more than half a million people across Europe, and found that higher levels of coffee drinking were associated with a decrease in the risk of death from many causes, including circulatory and digestive tract diseases.

So enjoy your cup of coffee. It may add years to your life.

## Keep your muscles strong at any age

s we grow older, we often lose muscle mass. Muscle mass decline typically starts in the 40s but increases after age 50. One study of about 200 men and women ages 64-93 found that it affected 22.6 percent of the women and 26.8 percent of the men.

Take these steps to keep your muscles intact:

- Strength training. Lifting weights has been shown to increase muscle mass and may even reverse the most debilitating effects of muscle loss.
- Aerobic exercise. Healthy muscle tissue needs capillaries to infuse it with blood. Regular exercise, like a brisk half-hour walk every day, can provide this.
- Protein. Inadequate protein in the diet, or difficulties digesting and absorbing protein, may be a factor in susceptibility to lost muscle mass. Older adults may need to increase their consumption of protein to maintain their lean body mass.
