










This data base will be kept with the HOA and is confidential and will not be used in any other way. A speaker from Suncoast PACE spoke for those who may need extra care in an effort to stay in their homes. 

NEW RESIDENTS— Again I will remind you we are a community that is governed by a Prospectus which contains the rules and regulations of what is allowed and not allowed, what is expected of the corporation that owns the property and what is expected of us as residents. Please take the time to read your Prospectus and know the rules set forth many years ago. Please remember when you signed your lease assumption you agreed to abide by these rules and regulations. It is unfortunate that a new resident thought that they were above all the rules set in place and was removed from our community. Please don't let this happen to you.

All pets MUST be kept inside your homes and not roam freely throughout our community. After going on vacation for two weeks, I came home to two (2) cats hanging in my carport. Either someone has decided to drop these cats in our neighborhood or new residents don't realize that cats are not allowed to run freely. Feral cats are a health hazard to our neighborhood. We will be looking into having any cats roaming freely trapped and taken off the property. So if you have a cat, be sure to keep it inside.

The next HOA meeting for members will be October 14, 2014 at 7 p.m. in the Manor House. We look forward to everyone returning and joining our community for a season of functions and fun! For new residents and residents that have never been a member, dues for the final 3 months of the year will be \$10. In January the dues will be \$20 for the year 2015. We also have voting for the Board in January and you must be a member to vote. Three (3) seats will be open for the election. Our November meeting will be an open house for all home owners (no renters).





Water and Swimming Safety

From the Red Cross

A recent Red Cross survey found that eight out of ten Americans are planning water activities such as going to the beach, pool, water park or boating or fishing this summer. A third (32 percent) of all Americans plan to swim at a place without a lifeguard. The Red Cross has launched an anti-drowning campaign this summer that promotes swim lessons and safe swimming. If a trip to the beach is part of someone's plans, the Red Cross has ten tips that will help beachgoers stay out of harm's way:

- 1. If someone plans to swim in the ocean, they should always check weather conditions before going in the water.
- 2. Swim only at a lifeguard protected beach, within the designated swimming area and listen to all lifeguard instructions.
- 3. Always swim with a buddy and always swim sober.
- 4. Young children and inexperienced swimmers should wear a Coast Guard-approved life jacket.
- 5. Everyone should enter the water feet first if they can't see the bottom or don't know how deep the water is.
- 6. Be aware of the danger of rip currents. If caught in one, swim parallel to the shore until out of the current. When free, turn and swim toward shore. If unable to swim to the shore, call out for help, float or tread water until free of the rip current and then head toward shore.
- 7. Limit the amount of direct sunlight received between 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., and wear a broad-spectrum sunscreen with a protection factor of at least 15. Reapply often.
- 8. Stay hydrated. Drink plenty of water regularly, even if not thirsty. Avoid drinks with alcohol or caffeine in them.
- 9. Protect the eyes by wearing sunglasses that will absorb 100 percent of UV sunlight.
- 10. Wear beach shoes. The sand is hot and can burn someone's feet and glass and other sharp objects can cut them.


