Keep in mind these top four fraud prevention tips to ensure you aren't the next victim:

1. Be vigilant - ask questions!

The more questions you ask, the more likely scammers will not have the answers, and you can catch them in their lies before they take advantage of you.

2. Don't give money to get money.

Legitimate sweepstakes companies do not require you to pay anything - fees, shipping, or prepaid taxes - to receive the prize you "won." If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is.

3. Research, research, and more research.

The Internet is a valuable tool. If you aren't the first person a scammer has tried to swindle, others have likely shared their experiences online. If the scammer claims to be from a legitimate company, hang up, and directly call the company to determine legitimacy.

4. Don't provide credit card information via telephone.

And be wary if someone demands you transfer funds via a prepaid debit card (e.g., Green Dot, Pay Pal, Visa Vanilla, etc.) - because they aren't traceable, they are a scammer's best friend.

When in doubt, call law enforcement!


