Be ready to rescue

pring is around the corner and lots of new life will be coming into the world. Unfortunately, well-meaning people with the best of intentions often "rescue" young animals when, in fact, these baby birds and mammals are perfectly fine and their parents are probably foraging for food nearby. In most cases, young wild animals should be left alone. However, when in doubt, please use the following guidelines as to how you can best determine whether a young animal needs help and, if so, what to do.

If you see a wild animal in distress, it is important to resist the temptation to interfere unless the animal is clearly sick, hurt, orphaned, or in immediate danger. In particular, people often mistakenly "rescue" baby animals when their best chance of survival is staying in the care of their parents. Wild animals need help if one or more of the following are true:

- They are clearly injured (e.g, they have a broken wing or leg, they are bleeding, they are unconscious).
- They are caught by a cat, dog, or other predator.
- They are weak and shivering or emaciated.
- They are in immediate danger.

It is not true that parent birds will reject or kill their babies because a human has touched them. Birds have a poor sense of smell and are more bothered by human noises and presence. If fallen nestlings—babies with no feathers, a little fuzz, or pinfeathers—aren't injured, shaking, or weak, cover their heads with a small towel and use clean or gloved hands to quickly place them back into their nest.

If you either can't see or can't reach the original nest, you can make a surrogate home for nestlings out of a small basket, kitchen strainer, or small plastic container with holes punched in the bottom. Line it with shredded tissue paper; don't use cotton, grass, hay, straw (they can cause respiratory problems), or old birds' nests (which can contain parasites). Hang it in a sheltered place that is not accessible to cats or dogs and is close to the original location. Watch quietly from a distance for several hours to make sure a parent returns. If a nestling is injured, weak, and shaking or if his or her parents do not return, do not offer the animal food or water and please do not attempt to care for the animal yourself. Contact a wildlife rehabilitator and arrange transport to a licensed facility immediately—every second counts! Here's how: http://www.fwra.org/injuredwildlife.html

Let's Recycle Smart

ddendum to Recycling Issues: People are putting obvious GARBAGE in the recycling bin, including piles of broken ceiling tiles, hoses, garden clippings, clothing, sheets, pillows, Styrofoam "popcorn" and egg cartons, etc, and most of all, plastic bags. I had to stop a guy from attempting to jam in a mattress the other day! Use the large dumpster for garbage, debris, construction materials, garden clippings, etc.

Plastic bags of any kind - garbage, grocery, sandwich - contaminate the load and get caught in the sorting gears. Please do not put plastic bags in the recycling bin - empty your things and take the bag with you.

You CAN recycle:

- Aluminum, steel and tin cans.
- Flattened, clean cardboard including boxes and boxboard (cereal, rice, dried good boxes).
- Milk, cream, soy milk, half-and-half cartons.
- Glass bottles and jars. NO OTHER types of glass, including broken dishes or lightbulbs.
- Newspaper and mixed paper. NO shiny wrapping paper.
- Plastic bottles #1-7 (code is on the bottom). NO OTHER broken plastic. NO straws! NO used coffee pods.

You CANNOT recycle:

• Styrofoam of any kind. Publix has green bins outside their doors for that. Publix also has bins for plastic bags.

- No plastic bags, wrap, packaging or film.
- No paper towels, plates, cups, tissues or wax paper.



TRASH/DUMP AREA SCHEDULE

Dump hours: Monday - Friday 8:00 am - 3:30 pm Pick-up hours: Tuesday and Friday 8:00 am till 12 noon

DO NOT PLACE TRASH OUT THE NIGHT BEFORE TRASH PICK UP

Closed: Saturday and Sunday

Trash pick-up services:

• All garbage MUST be placed into plastic bags and securely tied weighing no more than 25 pounds.

- Please do no place trash into boxes. Boxes must be flattened and tied with string. All broken glass/mirrors must be placed into a box and taped securely.
- Dispose of all medical needles and medicines properly. Do not place in trash bags.
- All newspaper should be bundled and tied securely with string.
- Trees and brush trimmings must be cut into no larger than 4-foot lengths and bundled in no more than an 18-inch diameter to be picked up.
- All weeds, leaves and lawn trimmings must be placed in plastic bags and tied closed for pickup. Bags are to weigh no more than 25 pounds as specified above.
- Furniture and construction debris will not be picked up. Place in open top dumpster.
- NO TVs, ELECTRONICS, TIRES OR PAINT FOR DISPOSAL INSTRUCTIONS, PLEASE CALL PINELLAS COUNTY SOLID WASTE DIVISION 727-464-7500. (Paint must be dried up!)

Uncontained garbage and fluids are a great health risk if inhaled by your neighbors and our staff. These rules are for everyone and not a certain few. People are still putting trash out before Tuesday or Friday mornings. Please try to obey these rules. They are for everyone.






